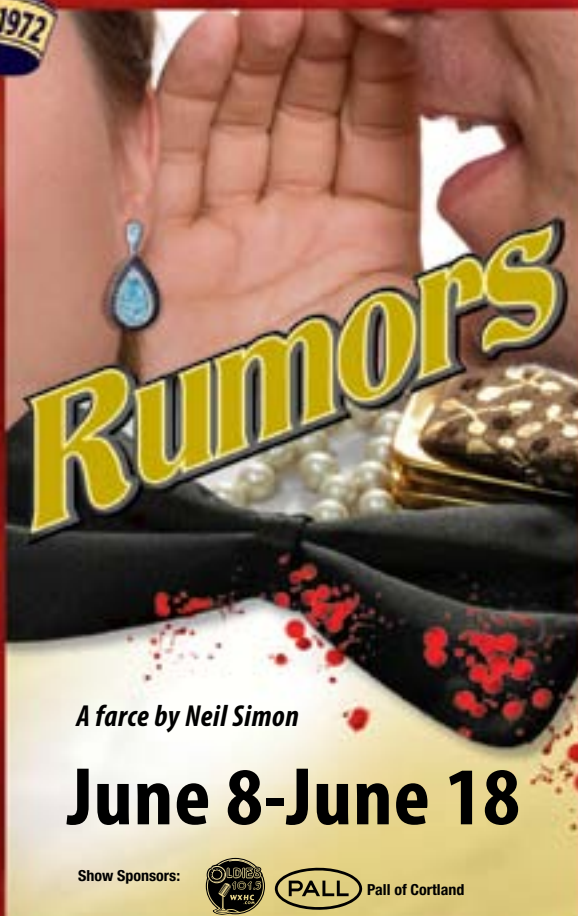

## DON'T UNDERESTIMATE PESKY POTHOLES ALLSTATE OFFERS DRIVER SAFETY TIPS TO AVOID POTHOLE DAMAGE



THE LOWLY POTHOLE CAN CREATE far more than just a bumpy and uncomfortable ride to work, especially in climates like New York's, where cold winter temperatures result in freezing and thawing cycles that put additional stress on cracked spring/summer pavement. It's estimated that motorists collectively end up paying millions of dollars a year in repairs because of damage from close encounters between their cars and potholes.

"Drivers don't always feel the force of the pothole because the car's suspension absorbs the impact," says Allstate NY spokesperson Shirley Eizember, "but some potholes can have as much impact on your car as a 35 mph car crash."

If you live in an area prone to potholes, keep these driving safety tips from [www.vehiclevibes.com](http://www.vehiclevibes.com) in mind:

- Always maintain proper air pressure in your tires.
- Leave plenty of room in front of your vehicle so you can avoid potholes without getting into an accident.
- If you can't avoid a pothole, slow down, but don't break directly over a pothole as this can actually cause more damage.
- When driving over the pothole, hold the steering wheel firmly to avoid losing control.
- Don't drive over a puddle of water, because it might be a particularly deep pothole in hiding.

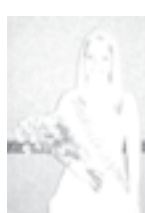
In addition to structural damage to the tire itself, potholes can also cause underinflated tires to blowout, or cause your tires to become unaligned, leading to uneven wear. If you've been running over potholes lately, pay attention this list of symptoms that would indicate a trip to the repair shop to check for damage is in order:

- Reoccurring loss of air pressure
- Noticeable bends/dents in wheels
- Vibration in the wheel or seat
- Steering wheel not aligned straight

## MIKE'S FISH TANK POND SEASON

HEY, POND SEASON IS HERE again. Most of the ponds have heated up enough that they are safe to put goldfish and koi in again. Most of the fish farms keep their water around 60 degrees. That is why you don't want to put pond fish outside too soon. If the pond is only 45 to 50 degrees and you put fish out, it could shock them enough to kill them or make them ill. Pond season usually starts on Memorial Day. We have some nice warm temps coming up so the ponds should be good to go by Monday if not sooner.

Remember, after you purchase your pond fish, only let them float in the bag in your pond or pool for 5 minutes.

Floating longer than that can cause stress for your fish and they could get sick or even die. Just like tropical fish, pond fish can catch ick too. It's a stress related disease and it looks like salt has been sprinkled all over your fish.


It shows up best on their fins and tail. If you should see spots like that on your fish, come buy one of the many parasitic medications. Ick if treated quickly can be gone in 24 to 48 hours.

Remember there are many types of fish that go well in a pond. Koi which come in different grades is one type.

There are also the Shibunkins which are a calico colored pond goldfish. The Sarassa comets, are a vivid colored red and white. Butterfly koi are a type of Koi fish but have long flowing fins. Many people use just plain old comet goldfish, also know as feeder fish. They sometimes do perfectly OK in a pond. Just remember they aren't the best quality goldfish so they may not do as well. They are also the kind of fish you win at the fair.

Other things that work in a pond are tadpoles, crayfish and channel cats. Keep in mind that channel fish get huge and at some point might eat your smaller pond koi or goldfish. Snails can also go in ponds but be careful which ones you use. Some of them are prolific breeders and you'll be

overrun with snails in no time. Too many snails will just make your pond dirty. There are some plain old red fantails that people put in ponds and they usually do just fine outside too. If you are putting in a new pond, keep in mind if you put it in a place with limited sunlight, you'll have less algae problems to worry about. Too much direct sunlight on your pond and you'll be fighting green all summer long.

## BREATHE, SNEEZE AND WHEEZE! ALLERGY SEASON IS HERE!

OH HOW WE HAVE BEEN longing to come out of our winter clothes, open the windows wide and let the fresh air in, or stroll outside take a walk and breathe in deeply to smell the spring air and the flowers. But for some that is misery. This is the beginning of allergy season for them. This year seems to be especially bad with a large amount of pollen. Just look at your car or driveway or sidewalk. did you know that cantaloupe contains some of the same proteins that ragweed has? Dairy products are one of the biggest culprits to avoid if you have seasonal allergies. If you can completely avoid all dairy for two weeks and you notice a difference then that is a simple solution to your problem. But many can't so other options are available. Making sure you have regular bowel movements is important also. A clogged colon is the root of allergy and sinus problems.

Some of the natural alternatives are antioxidants. High doses of antioxidants such as Grapine (grape seed and pine bark) can help stop allergic reactions. They are water soluble so are safe. They stabilize the mast cells to prevent the release of histamines. Bioflavonoids. They also stabilize the mast cells to stop or prevent release of histamines. We know them as a source of vitamin C. Bromelain is an anti-inflammatory found in things like pineapple. This anti-inflammatory effect reduces the swelling of the mucous membranes namely the eyes, throat and nose. Stinging Nettle leaf has been used for decades to control allergic rhinitis for hay fever sufferers. Fructus arantia or immature orange peel contains synephrine that is popular in many over the counter medications as it acts like ephedrine. Cordyceps is a fungus that relaxes the smooth muscles of the lungs to get more air into the lungs reversing the constriction that occurs during allergy attacks.

There are some herbal combinations that my company Nature's Sunshine has that contains some of these ingredients. ALJ, Histablock, Super Antioxidants, Lobelia, Cordyceps, Elderberry Defense, Citrus Bioflavonoid Vitamin C, Pantothenic Acid, MSM and EW. ## MIKE'S FOOD FOR THOUGHT CORKS & MORE

I HAD HEARD A LOT about the wine bar/restaurant called Corks and More. So I went over to check it out and I am glad I did. It's right on the inlet at 708 West Buffalo Street in Ithaca. It's a rather large place filled with comfortable easy chairs, there are tables with stools, a full service bar and there is an outdoor patio right near the water.

They call it the ultimate wine tasting room. When you enter, they give you a card resembling a credit card. They ask you how much you want to spend and they enter that onto your card and you pay them that amount.

Scattered throughout the place are wine stations. Each station holds several bottles of wine. There are wine glasses hanging near each station. You slide your card into the machine and press the button for the wine you want poured. You have a choice of a one ounce, half a glass or full glass pour of that particular wine. The price of each pour depends on the quality of wine you choose. A one ounce pour varied from \$1.25 to as much as \$13.00.

I put \$20.00 on my card and I tried about 9 to 10 one ounce pours. Each time you slide your card into the wine station, it gives you a running tally of what's left on your card. Very cool. I really enjoyed picking out what I wanted to try. They had about 45 wines to choose from. They had wines from Italy, France, USA, Greece, Australia, and New Zealand. They change the wines so when you go back at a later date, you can try all new wines.

They also have a kitchen, which serves Tapas. A tapas is a small plate of food. They had a nice variety of food and all of it was tasty. My friend and I tried the focaccia bread with dipping herbed olive oil, the meatball sliders, and we had a selection of crostinis. A crostini is a piece of toasted bread with a topping. We had the smoked salmon, cucumber with horseradish and caper sauce, the pesto chicken with fontina cheese, the spinach, tomato, with pine nuts and olive oil and the corned beef with swiss cheese and horseradish sauce. Everything was seasoned up nicely. It was very good. Prices ranged from \$2.50 to \$10.00.

They also had many other tapas plates such as: grilled pork with a walnut sage sauce, maple glazed chicken with toasted pecans and sweet potatoes, salmon with almond caper dressing and lots more including cheese and olive plates. I did not have dessert but they had several yummy things on the menu.

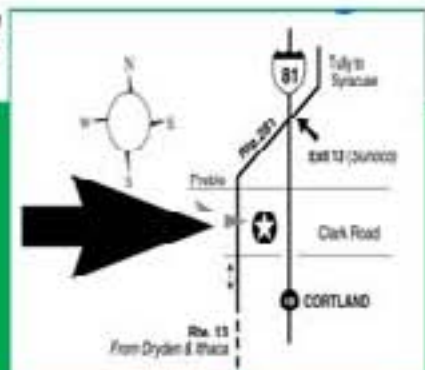
