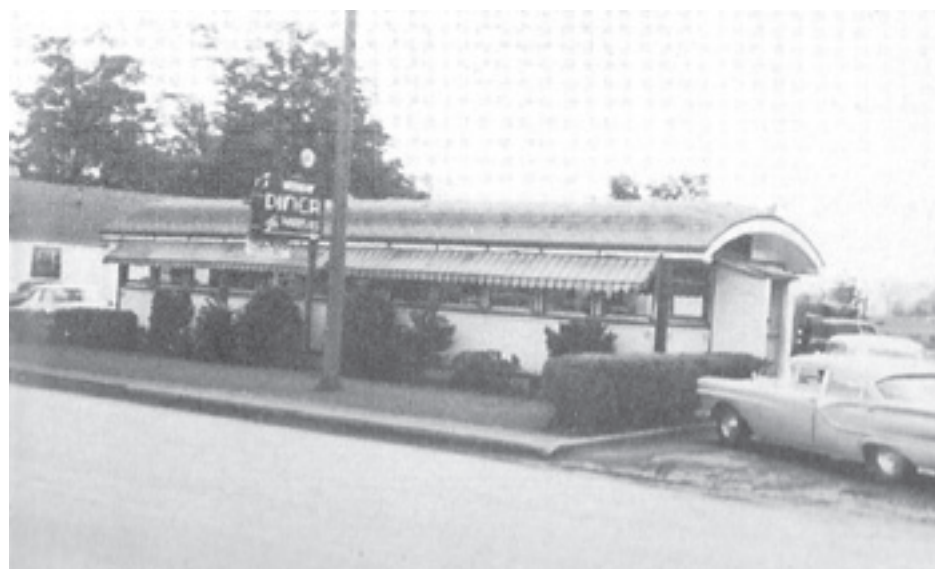
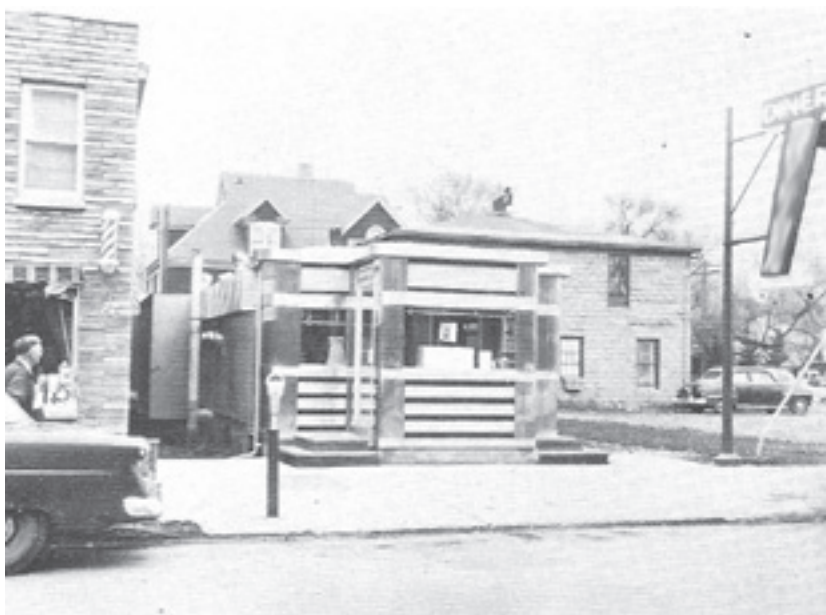

ESPECIALLY CHLOROPHYLL

AFTER A FEW SHOWERS HOW good it is to see my lawn turning green again. Don't you love to see all the shades of green this time of year? Have you ever noticed all the different shades of green in the trees while travelling? What makes that green? It is chlorophyll. What is chlorophyll? It is actually responsible for the green pigmentation in plants. What does it do? It absorbs energy from the sun to facilitate photosynthesis in plants. Chlorophyll is to plants like blood is to humans. It is important in many plant metabolic functions such as growth and respiration.

Chemically it is similar in composition to that of human blood, except that the central atom in chlorophyll is magnesium while iron is central in human blood. This and the fact that chlorophyll is central in plant metabolism had prompted scientists to find out if chlorophyll can offer similar benefits to humans. Studies published in the journals Carcinogenesis and Food and Chemical Toxicology reports that chlorophyll inhibits carcinogenesis. Antioxidant and Anti-inflammatory: containing high levels of the vitamins A,C and E, chlorophyll possibly has strong antioxidant capacity and could possibly also be found to help reduce inflammation. Chelation of heavy metals: chlorophyll is one of the most important chelates in nature. It's ability to bind to and remove toxic heavy metals such as mercury makes it extremely powerful. Antiseptic: while chlorophyll doesn't actually have antiseptic properties of its own, it quite remarkably, does have the ability to aid our body's tissue in destroying germs. By strengthening tissue chlorophyll has a double-action remedy for bad breath. Firstly, as a deodorizer, it will eliminate odors in the mouth and throat, but secondly (and more importantly) it may promote a healthy digestive tract – which is the primary reason for bad breath. Rapid Delivery of Magnesium: this has a highly alkalizing effect on the body and helps to deliver much needed oxygen to cells and tissues. THE NEED TO KNOW WHAT the Latin Name of an herb is important as one can tell when we are talking gravel root. The nick names of this herb are the same as at three other herbs and its first Latin name is the same as boneset but the second name is different and completely different in looks and medicinal value.

NICKNAMES: Joe pye weed, queen of the meadow, sweet joe pye weed.

LATIN NAME: Eupatorium purpureum.

ELEMENT: Earth.

POWERS: Grounding and balancing of Yin and Yang.

MEDICINAL PARTS: Leaves, root and flower.

CONSTITUTES: Glycogen (polysaccharides).

PROPERTIES: Bitter, tonic, cleansing and dissolvent.

MAGICAL USES: Sitting with this herb and asking for its energies will help to increase yin and balance hyper yang.

INTERNAL USES: This herb has an affinity on the genitourinary organs and the uterus. Therefore it helps with any type of stone or gravel in the body, cystitis, urethritis, prostate weakness and impotence, painful menstruation, problems holding a fetus and labor weakness, and a prolapsed uterus, chronic coughs, asthma, gout and rheumatism, being high in glycogens, means great energy for the muscles.

SMOKIN' MULE

STARTED IN 2010, THE SMOKIN' mule was an idea we came up with after I retired from Anheuser Busch. Sitting around was not my idea of fun and I knew I could cook so we decided to renovate the building which used to be Arnold's Florist. Michelle my girlfriend and partner works a full time job and runs the business with me. It took us almost a year to get ready. We opened in April 2011. Little did we know how successful it would become. The community has supported us tremendously. With some of the best BBQ in CNY we're a little different from most. 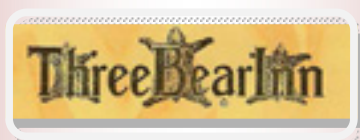


