# **SMOKE-FREE HOUSING: A**

THROUGHOUT NEW YORK STATE AND across the country, an amenity they can provide for their residents. Why? Smokeproperty, and can safeguard against liability.

Smoke drifting from lit tobacco products and/or exhaled by is a class A carcinogen, like radon and asbestos.

Besides protecting tenants, including children and persons with illnesses made worse by tobacco smoke exposure, property owners can avoid the excess building maintenance

costs caused by smoking. Apartments that have been smoked in often require extensive cleaning, repainting, and repair and replacement of floors and countertops. Additionally, smoking materials are a leading cause of fires in multi-unit buildings and the leading cause of fire deaths in the nation.

Adopting Housing Act. The Centers for Disease Control released a new study that shows nearly \$500 million could be saved every year if smoking were universally banned in subsidized and public housing. No smoking policies would yield huge annual savings to taxpayers, employers, the federal government, state governments and others. The savings would be largest in New York State, where an annual \$125 million would be saved.

Under the Housing and Urban Development proposed rule, public housing authorities would implement a policy prohibiting lit tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars or pipes) in all living units, indoor common areas, administrative offices and all outdoor areas within 25 feet of housing and administrative office buildings. Final rules have yet to come forward. In anticipation of the rule, many New York State public housing authorities have already implemented smokefree policies, including the most recent Syracuse, Buffalo and Saratoga Springs Housing Authorities.

#### **MIKE'S FISH TANK** POND SEASON

T's pond season again. There is a variety of pond fish and Lother creatures available for your pond.

Sarassa comets, shibunkins, red comets, koi, regular and butterfly, crayfish, frogs, newts, tadpoles are a few of the most popular. Remember if you are putting in a pond, go for a shady spot or you will be fighting algae the whole summer. They do make some algicides that will kill algae or help prevent it from growing but if you have live plants, the algicides may kill those

Also, goldfish and koi do not like the heat, so a shady spot will help in that respect also.

If you have a small pond, do not add too many fish at one time. Just like a tropical tank, you need the good bacteria to build up before you put a lot of fish in the pond. Also, remember these pond fish can get really big, so allow room for them to grow. A lot of pond fish will just eat bugs and larvae that fall in the pond, but it's still a good idea to feed them a good quality pond pellet, stick, or flake.

After purchasing your pond fish, remember only float the bag of fish in your pond 5 minutes. That is all it will take to equalize the temperature.

Usually Memorial Day is the official beginning of pond season. We are still getting some cold nights, so you may want to wait another week before adding your pond fish. Although I have had people tell me they put pond fish out into their ponds already and they were fine.




#### 2016 ST. ANTHONY'S FESTIVAL A DOUBLY SPECIAL OCCASION

LL OF CENTRAL NEW YORK is familiar with the St. Anthony's AFestival, a weekend of faith and good times at St. Anthony of Padua Church at 50 Pomeroy Street in Cortland, New York. Dating back to 1905, this traditional celebration commemorating St. Anthony, a favorite Italian saint, always offers a weekend of religious events, aspects of traditional Italian folk celebrations, delicious food, children's games,

shopping opportunities, and live music for all tastes. However, this year's festival, to be held on June 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>, has an even more special meaning. It is part of the kick-off of the centennial celebration of St. Anthony of Padua Church, which was founded as a parish in 1917 by Italian immigrants. The year of celebration, centennial like St. Anthony's parish itself, will focus not only on commemorating its





June 12th is "St. Anthony of Padua Church: Cherishing the Past-Embracing the Future."

St. Anthony's Festival Weekend starts Saturday afternoon with a Spaghetti Supper in St. Anthony's Church Hall from 4:00 to 7 PM, which will satisfy the heartiest appetites for Italian food. At 5:30 PM, Mass will be said in Italian with authentic Italian hymns. English translation leaflets will be provided for St. Anthony's many current parishioners who come from diverse backgrounds and members of the public who wish to attend. At 6:30, the outdoor celebration begins on the festival grounds adjoining the church. There, festival goers can savor St. Anthony's renowned sausage and pepper sandwiches, pizza fritta (fried dough), and Italian sweet treats, including pizzelle (Italian waffle cookies), cannoli (ricotta-filled crispy shells), and homemade Italian cookies, from the Dolci booth until 10 PM. Italian-themed items, including T-shirts and caps, can be purchased at the Italian Novelties Booth. Festival goers can also make Silent Auction bids on themed baskets and other lovely items.

Also on Saturday evening, Tribal Revival will provide great musical entertainment from 7 PM to 9:30 PM. The evening ends with a thrilling fireworks display at 9:30 PM, generously sponsored by McNeil and Company Insurance and Risk

Sunday events begin at 9:30 AM with a traditional Mass celebrating the feast day of St. Anthony. As a tribute to this

> beloved saint, thirteen little boys dressed as St. Anthony and carrying his signature lilies will sing a moving hymn in Italian, which praises St. Anthony for spreading the Gospel and protecting those who are far from their homeland. The boys have been trained by Vivian Colongeli and her daughter Pamela Knickerbocker, who have carried on the tradition begun by mother-in-law Maria Colongeli, Francesca Discenza, Doradea Cerio, and Giuseppina Cerio in the

1930's. Following benediction after Mass, the Old Timers Band will enter the church to play the favorite Italian march, "Caderna," and lead the parishioners in the traditional procession throughout Cortland's East Side.

This year's procession theme highlights St. Anthony's love of its faith and ethnic heritage combined with an energetic, inclusive present and vibrant future. Traditional elements include the ornate St. Anthony's Banner from Italy, the statue  $of St. Anthony \, supported \, on \, the \, shoulders \, of four \, parishioners,$ the thirteen little monks, vivid Italian regional banners by the late Mario Venturini, parish organizations, accordion player Armando Natale, and religious floats. One of this year's floats is a project of St. Anthony's Confirmation Class. Last year's Confirmation Class, under the direction of parish artist Ellen Rahner, designed and painted a beautiful mural adorning the entire length of the church atrium. This year's students are building a float of the Creation, representing the Biblical account and symbolizing the creation of the St. Anthony's Parish in 1917. The procession route includes Elm, Hubbard, Central, Pomeroy, Port Watson, Bartlett, Commando, Hyatt and a return to the church.

Other Sunday festival activities get underway on the church grounds at 12:30 PM. Families and friends can relax under the big tent to enjoy Italian specialty dishes from the ethnic foods booth or sausage and peppers sandwiches, pizza fritta, and other dolci. Youngsters will love the kids' food booth, fun kids games, and the Bounce House. Parish caricature artist, Noel Passeri, will be on hand to draw likenesses of festival goers of all ages. Adults can play the new cake wheel and bid on the Silent Auction, which includes themed baskets and many other items. Besides St. Anthony's Italian Novelties booth, there will be a variety of creative shopping opportunities




#### 2016 ITHACA FESTIVAL JUNE 3-5

in our lives," says Elisheva Glaser, co-president of the club, "whether that be fathers, grandmothers, or even members of the community."


