





injury requires medical attention, patients can face a difficult choice deciding whether to go to a hospital emergency room, an urgent care center or calling their physician

for an appointment.

Life-threatening emergencies, such as a heart attack or a serious head injury, require the sophisticated diagnostic services and treatment available at a hospital emergency department. Urgent care centers assist patients with illnesses or injuries that do not appear to be life-threatening and do not warrant an emergency room's expensive, high-tech medical

Urgent care centers deliver immediate care when a patient's physician is unavailable. Cayuga Medical Center's Ithaca and Cortland Convenient Care offices offer urgent care daily from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. except Christmas and Thanksgiving when they close at 3 p.m. The cost of the walk-in health services provided by an Urgent care center are usually more expensive than a scheduled appointment with your doctor.

#### What is a medical emergency?

A medical emergency condition is one that can permanently impair or endanger a person's life. Rapid treatment at the nearest hospital emergency department is essential. If you have a medical emergency, do not attempt to drive yourself to the hospital. Seek assistance or call 911 for help.

#### What conditions need emergency care?

Some examples of conditions that require emergency medical care include: Severe chest pain or difficulty breathing. Stroke symptoms such as slurred speech, dizziness and confusion.

Broken bones protruding through the skin. Convulsions, seizures or loss of consciousness. Drug overdoses. Fever in infants less than 3 months old. Profuse bleeding. Moderate to severe burns. Serious head, neck or back injury. Severe abdominal pain. Suicidal or homicidal feelings.

These life-threatening conditions require prompt medical attention. Other patients going to an emergency department with less serious health issues may have longer waits to obtain care. Urgent care centers usually provide faster care for patients with non-emergency medical needs.

#### What is an urgent care condition?

Some of these non-emergency conditions include: Virus and flu. Vomiting, nausea, and diarrhea. Ear, throat and respiratory infections Sprains, strains and simple fractures. Minor burns, cuts, puncture wounds and animal bites. Minor eye injuries. Rashes and allergic reactions. Mild to moderate asthma.

#### What conditions are best handled by your physician?

Regular checkups, physicals and routine health care are most effectively handled by your doctor. Some examples of this care are: Immunizations. Chronic care for high blood pressure, diabetes and congestive heart failure. Medication refills. Removal of skin lesions such as skin tags, warts.

#### How can you reduce urgent care wait time?

is staffed by pediatricians from Buttermilk Falls Pediatrics and Northeast Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine, and by registered nurses who are experienced in the care of sick babies and children.

## MIKE'S FISH TANK SUMMER HEAT

FEW TIPS ON PETS and summer heat. It's perfectly ok to buy Afish when it's hot out but be sure to go right home.

That bag will heat up fast, so you want the fish to get into your tanks as fast as possible. Goldfish do not like heat.

Sometimes pond fish will suffer if the water gets too hot. Always try to put the pond in the shade, it helps.

As far as floating your fish when you get home, only float the bag 5 minutes, max. It only takes a few minutes for the water in the bag to equalize to your tank's temp. The fish farms do not recommend putting ice cubes in your tank to cool the water. If your tank gets too hot, wrap a wet towel around your tank and blow a fan on it. That will help cool it down slowly.

Rabbits do not like the heat at all, and hamsters do not like it either. Guinea pigs handle it a bit better. Just be sure to keep your pets water bottle filled, they get really thirsty when it's

The one pet that probably enjoys the heat are reptiles and snakes, but even they have a limit. If you start going over 90 degrees inside their habitat, it's probably getting too hot even

Also remember do not leave your dog in a car with the window rolled down a little bit and the car turned off. In this heat, the inside temperature of the car goes up very fast and could be deadly to your pet dog. We have seen many people do this and it is not a good idea.

Just remember all your pets need to stay hydrated in this heat. Be sure fresh water is available to all of them 24/7.


















## 10<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL ARTS AND **WINE FESTIVAL**

# TIRE MAINTENANCE TIPS COURTESY OF WILLCOX SERVICE & TIRE CENTER

Your tires are the only part of your vehicle that actually touches the road when you drive. It only takes a couple of minutes of maintenance each month to keep your tires working at their best.

#### Check Your Air Pressure Once a Month

Incorrect air pressure is the leading cause of tire damage. To avoid tire damage you need to check your tire's air pressure once a month.

The correct tire pressure is listed on the vehicle placard & can be found in the following places:

- In the car owner's manual
- Under the gas tank lid
- Along the driver's side door edge
- · Along the door post

The air pressure listed on the side of your tire is NOT the correct air pressure for your vehicle. That number is the maximum air pressure for the tire. Remember to check the air in your spare tire

Don't get stranded or put out costly towing expenses. Check your air pressure on your spare regularly. Note: If you have different rims than came on your vehicle originally, make sure that the bolts on your spare tire are the correct fitting.

Failure to keep your tires properly inflated can increase wear and will have a negative effect on your vehicles handling.

When checking and adjusting tire pressure, the following should be kept in mind:

Check the air pressure when the tire is cold - tires become hot even after driving just a mile. If you must drive to add air, check your air pressure before you leave. Air pressure changes 1-2 pounds for every 10 degrees of temperature change. Air pressure goes up in warm weather and down in cold weather.

Tire pressure must be the same on the tires of each axle, but may be different on the front and rear axle.

Valve caps must be tightly closed to protect the valve from dust and dirt and prevent it from leaking.

Replace missing valve caps without delay.

Take this opportunity to inspect your tires to make sure there is nothing stuck in them or they have no deformities.

#### **Tread Depth**

To prevent hydroplaning and skidding your tires must have proper tread depth. The minimum tread depth is 1/16th of and inch.

Ask anyone, the easiest way to check your tread depth...the penny test. What is the penny test? Take a penny and place it in the tread of your tire. If part of Lincoln's head is covered by the tread your tires have enough tread. If you can see Lincoln's entire head, you should buy a new tire.

You should also check your tire tread for uneven wear. Irregular wear shortens the life of your tires, if you think you have uneven wear you should take you vehicle to your tire dealer.

#### Rotation

The best way to prevent uneven wear is to have your tires rotated every 6,000 - 8,000 miles or as specified in your vehicle's owner manual.

#### **Potential Tire Troubles**

Curbs can prove to be big trouble to your tires. Approach curbs with care, if you drive over them too fast or at the wrong angle the impact may cause the tire to crack.

Avoid potholes or debris in the road when possible.

Avoid fast stops & starts.

Be sure to check your owner's manual for your vehicles maximum load. Overloading your vehicle can shorten your tires life.

#### **Replacing Your Tires**

You should replace your tires with the same type of tires that came on your vehicle original equipment. This includes tire size, type and speed rating.

## CONCERT TO DEBUT NEW ALBUM, 'DREAMS IN MODERN FOLK'

PROM THE MEXICAN BORDER ALL the way into Canada, Ben Phan walked 2,668 miles with a guitar on his back. The result is a debut album, "Dreams in Modern Folk," described by one reviewer as "Django Reinhardt meets Ray Lamontagne." Phan's original music is a blend of gypsy jazz, bluegrass, classical, and folk, a unique synthesis all his own. On July 23, Phan will play one concert only in Ithaca, at 7:30 pm in the Ecovillage Frog Common House, 100 Rachel Carson Way. Tickets are \$10 general admission, \$7 for students and seniors.

The Ithaca concert is part of a multi-state tour for Phan to introduce new audiences to his music. Although his last concert in Asheville, NC, played to a sold-out audience of 250, Phan says he's looking forward to the smaller venues on his tour. "I love the intimacy in smaller rooms and house concerts," he explains. "I can connect more directly with the audience."

Phan began his professional career with Afrobeat, a band playing a blend of jazz, funk and African dance music; he also played with a bluegrass and folk group. But when Phan decided to hike the Pacific Crest Trail in 2014, his music – and his life — changed forever. He brought along a mini-guitar and during five months of travel on foot he began writing songs, drawn from his experiences on the trail as well as his past struggles with depression, addiction, loss and love. The music offered hope and solace, to him and to the audiences he found along the trail.

After Phan returned to North Carolina, he released his first solo EP, "Hold On, Let Go." Earlier this year he released his "Dreams in Modern Folk" with his band, the Soul Symphony, comprised of some of the most indemand musicians in Asheville. "I strive hard for a high level of professionalism, and I think they appreciate that," says Phan.

## **4-H YOUTH FAIR CELEBRATES 45TH** ANNIVERSARY


