

MIKE'S FISH TANKS CORY CATS

ORYDORAS OTHERWISE KNOW AS CORYS is by far the largest genus of Neotropical fishes with almost 142 species. Several hundred corydoras species are not yet classified but are kept by aquarists. Corys are distributed east of the Andes to the Atlantic coast, from Trinidad to the Rio de la Plata in northern Argentina. Corys are also found in South America in a variety of environments. Corys are well known among aquarists and are hugely popular. They are well suited to tropical community aquariums as they get along well with other species and are not aggressive at all. Many types of corys are actually quite timid. Corys are mostly bottom dwellers, so it's a good idea to offer them sinking foods such as shrimp pellets and other tropical pellets. If you do flake foods, just be sure that some gets to the bottom for the slower more shy corvs

Corys can tolerate a wide range of water conditions, including temperatures that are cooler than Tropical. They do not do well in tanks with high Nitrate levels. So be sure that you do your monthly water changes which will get rid of any high nitrates. Corydoras are fairly easy to keep, being peaceful, hardy, active, and entertaining. Occasionally they will dart to the surface, sticking their snout above the water to take a breath of air. This behavior is perfectly normal and is not an indication of anything wrong. The corys longevity in the aquarium is noteworthy.

There are cases of corys living to 27 years in captivity and 20 years are not uncommon. In the wild, corys are generally found in smaller streams and along the margins of larger rivers, in marshes and ponds.

Cory cats are an excellent addition to your freshwater fish tank.

THE MONTGOMERY PARK PLAYGROUND PROJECT

TMOVED TO THE VILLAGE of Dryden in 1976. We owned a house on West Main St., complete with a white picket fence and what, at the time, seemed like a huge backyard. Today, I went back through my childhood home—a complete "Alice in Wonderland" experience if ever there were one and nothing was nearly as big as it seemed to be when I was a child. The huge yard, where my childhood was spent playing with Barbie Dolls, twirling batons, playing kick-the-can and freeze tag was not at all huge! At eight years old, the trip from the back door of the house to the tent which would house my brother, me and friends overnight was a "hike," which had to be navigated carefully— the crab apple trees were a forest we had to battle our way though and the rocks in mom's rock garden were the only safe way we had to cross the imaginary river filled with alligators. Today, standing there at the back door of my old house, a mere twenty feet from where many a tent was pitched throughout my childhood, I marveled at my memories and how incredibly large my small world had seemed.

Life was different in the 70's and 80's. We disappeared for hours on end-leaving the house at 8:00 in the morning and returning after dark. We collected spikes on the railroad tracks, played atop the peat moss bags at Agway and roller skated in the parking lot. We went swimming in the creek with it's snapping turtles and a rope swing. We didn't have computers, Internet or cell phones. We had Big Wheels, POGO sticks, jump ropes and huffy bikes. Cartoons aired on Saturday mornings and Little House on the Prairie was on at 8:00 on Monday nights. We didn't have a tv remote—we had a slider it was attached to the television with a cord which was no longer than four feet. "The Park" was a couple of blocks away and where we connected with friends for baseball, kickball, tag, kick the can, ice skating, basketball and tennis. We played for hours on the small wooden see-saw, the swings and the rusty metal slide. Our parents didn't worry about us hanging

out there- or, if they did, they never mentioned it. Montgomery Park was our childhood home away from home. If parents were looking for a child who failed to show up for dinner at 5:30pm, they started, and often ended, their search at the park.

The Park, like my childhood home, is much different than it is in my childhood memories but, none the less, it is a

huge part of my memories. These days, the park is frequently quiet—the outdated playground, empty. I feel a huge sense of sadness for the inanimate swings and rickety slide that were once an important part of every imaginary game we played. Recently, I've spent a lot of time at Montgomery Park as part of a group dedicated to the Montgomery Park Playground

Project— a revitalization effort, a coordinated effort to breathe life back into a dying park. I am hopeful for The Park's future—encouraged by the commitment to the rebuild project and motivated by the synergy of the group of volunteers.

However, we are far from finished. WE NEED YOUR HELP.



SEPTEMBER IS BABY SAFETY MONTH: DRIVING WITH A NEWBORN



Is your newborn passenger in the right car safety seat?

Every week, about ten babies ages birth to one year old are treated and released from hospital emergency departments because of injuries from motor vehicle crashes in New York State. Each year about fifteen infants in this age group are hospitalized because of injuries from motor vehicle crashes in New York State (NYS).

The good news is that you, as a parent or caregiver, can play a major role in preventing injuries resulting from motor vehicle crashes. Allstate Insurance Company and the New York State Department of Health want to make sure your baby is safely secured in a safety seat during any drive.

What NYS child passenger safety laws are important for me to know?

NYS law requires children under age four be restrained in a federally approved child safety seat.

Why should my infant use a child safety seat?

Using child safety seats reduces the risk of death in a car crash by 71 percent for infants, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. Infants riding unrestrained are four times more likely to be injured in a car crash compared to infants using child safety seats.

Why is riding rear-facing the safest way for infants to travel?

Babies are very fragile. Their bodies and bones are not as strong as an adult or older child. Child safety seats hold infants securely in place and help distribute crash forces over a wide area of their bodies. The back of a rear-facing child safety seat absorbs crash forces protecting your baby's spine and neck from injuries.

What is the best safety seat for my infant?

The best child safety seat is one that fits your child, is correctly installed in your vehicle, and is used properly every time your child rides in the car. Make sure the child safety seat you use is the proper type for your baby. Base your choice on your child's weight and height and on whether or not it can be correctly installed in the back seat of your vehicle. Weight and height limits can be found on the child safety seat and in the seat's instruction manual. Some child safety seats will not work well with some vehicle seats or with certain seat belts. You may have to try many child safety seats to find the one that can be properly installed in your vehicle.

What types of child safety seats are available?

It is important to select a child safety seat based upon your child's age and size. There are two types of rear-facing child safety seats: infant-only child safety seats and convertible child safety seats.

- 1. Infant-only child safety seats are designed for rear-facing use only. They have a carrying handle and are used for infants up to 22 to 32 pounds, depending on the model. This type of seat often comes with a base which can be left in the car after being installed in your vehicle. The infant-only seat can be placed in the base to transport your child in the car.
- 2. <u>Convertible child safety seats</u> can be used rear-facing until your child reaches the highest rear-facing weight or height limit of the seat and then changed or "converted" to use as a forward-facing seat. This type of seat best accommodates the needs of bigger babies and allows your infant to ride rear-facing for a longer period of time.

How long should my baby ride in a rear-facing child safety seat?

For the best possible protection, your baby should ride in a rear-facing child safety seat as long as possible, up to the height or weight limit of the particular seat. At a minimum, infants should be kept rear-facing until they reach at least age one and 20 pounds. Most convertible child safety seats are approved for rear-facing use up to 30 to 35 pounds and should be used for infants whose height or weight has exceeded the limits of the rear-facing infant-only seats.

Where is the safest place for my baby to ride in my vehicle?

The safest place for children of any age to ride is properly restrained in the back seat. The center position is preferred, if the seat can be properly installed in this location. Rear-facing child safety seats should never be placed in the front seat of a vehicle with passenger-side air bags. Serious injuries or death could result to the baby if the air bag inflates in a crash.
