

evening of two regional premiere one-act plays, aimed to stir up Halloween spirits. From October 12 - 23, CRT will present "*The Receptionist*" an intriguing dark comedy by Adam Bock, and "*The Birds*", a psychological thriller by Conor McPherson, based on a short story by Daphne du Maurier. Both one-acts will be presented in the same evening with a 15 minute intermission. CRT notes that while neither play is bloody or gory, "The *Birds*" contains some adult language.

In "*The Receptionist*", an ordinary day in a nameless Corporate America office is set on its ear. Beverly works at the nondescript Northeast Office, dealing effortlessly with ringing phones, her daughter's dramas and her colleague's romantic troubles. But the appearance of a charming representative from the Central Office disrupts her daily routine. As the true nature of the company's shocking business becomes apparent, the office world of borrowed pens, coffee makers and voicemail becomes dangerous. This play questions the consequences of keeping secrets and who ultimately is held responsible when things go wrong.

In "*The Birds*", the short story that was the basis for Alfred Hitchcock's classic film is boldly adapted into a gripping, edge-of-your-seat play. In an isolated New England farmhouse, Diane has rescued Nat from masses of attacking birds. As the two strangers start to deal with the isolation caused by the birds outside, a trusting relationship begins to form. But when young and beautiful Julia arrives also seeking shelter, a paranoia triangle is formed that becomes an internal threat to match that of the birds outside. The question remains: when the world turns upside down, who do

Directing both plays is Shaun Peknic, who returns to CRT after directing "Sherlock Holmes and the West End *Horror*" in 2015. Peknic was Associate Director for the Tony-Award winning Broadway musical "Once" and continues to work with national tours and overseas productions of that musical. LOT OF PEOPLE WANT to know how to keep crickets 🔼 alive. Use the biggest container you have room

Be sure to put toilet paper tubes or paper towel tubes into the cage so the crickets are not on top of each other.

Feed some type of cricket food. There are many varieties available. Most are a gel, which is their food and water.

You can throw a potato in for them to eat and for moisture but there isn't a lot of nutrition in a potato, so still feed some of the crickets food gel.

Keep crickets away from extreme heat or cold. They don't like it too hot and they hate the cold too. Crickets dehydrate easy so be sure to supply them with a small dish of water. However if you are using the cricket gel, then you won't need a dish of water.

That's pretty much it. Follow those few things and you should have better luck with the crickets surviving.



#### **HALLOWEEN: TOP 10 SAFETY** TIPS FOR PET PARENTS

Attention, animal lovers, it's almost the spookiest night of the

#### Keep your pet safe with these simple tips.

- 1. No tricks, no treats: That bowl of candy is for trick-ortreaters, not for Scruffy and Fluffy. Chocolate in all forms especially dark or baking chocolate—can be very dangerous for dogs and cats. Candies containing the artificial sweetener xylitol can also cause problems. If you do suspect your pet has ingested something toxic, please call your veterinarian or the ASPCA Animal Poison Control Center at (888) 426-4435.
- 2. Popular Halloween plants such as pumpkins and decorative corn are considered to be relatively nontoxic, but they can produce stomach upset in pets who nibble on them.
- 3. Wires and cords from electric lights and other decorations should be kept out of reach of your pets. If chewed, your pet might suffer cuts or burns, or receive a possibly lifethreatening electrical shock.
- 4. A carved pumpkin certainly is festive, but use caution if you choose to add a candle. Pets can easily knock a lit pumpkin over and cause a fire. Curious kittens especially run the risk of getting burned or singed by candle flames.
- 5. Dress-up can be a big mess-up for some pets. Please don't put your dog or cat in a costume UNLESS you know he or she loves it (yup, a few pets are real hams!). For pets who prefer their "birthday suits," however, wearing a costume may cause undue stress.
- 6. If you do dress up your pet, make sure the costume isn't annoying or unsafe. It should not constrict the animal's movement or hearing, or impede his ability to breathe, bark

or meow. Also, be sure to try on costumes before the big night. If your pet seems distressed, allergic or shows abnormal behavior, consider letting him go au naturale or donning a

- 7. Take a closer look at your pet's costume and make sure it does not have small, dangling or easily chewed-off pieces that he could choke on. Also, ill-fitting outfits can get twisted on external objects or your pet, leading to injury.
- 8. All but the most social dogs and cats should be kept in a separate room away from the front door during peak trick-ortreating hours. Too many strangers can be scary and stressful
- 9. When opening the door for trick-or-treaters, take care that your cat or dog doesn't dart outside.
- 10. IDs, please! Always make sure your dog or cat has proper identification. If for any reason your pet escapes and becomes lost, a collar and tags and/or a microchip can be a lifesaver, increasing the chances that he or she will be returned to you.
