# **FUNDRAISING FOR RAIN** HARVESTING PAVILION AT FLORAL **AVE COMMUNITY GARDEN**

THE FLORAL AVENUE COMMUNITY GARDEN, located in Ithaca's  $oldsymbol{oldsymbol{\perp}}$  west side, is raising funds to construct a small pavilion for harvesting rainwater for the garden. The community garden is within walking distance of three low-to-moderate income apartment buildings (Cedar Creek, Towerview and West Village Apartments). It was established in 2014 in response to a need for a community garden on the west side of Ithaca. The only other community garden in the city, the Ithaca Community Garden, is several miles away so it's not convenient to residents of the west side. The Floral Avenue Community Garden provides fresh produce for 20 households, including both beginner and experienced gardeners.

The community garden needs a way to provide water to the gardeners' plots. The City of Ithaca will not allow the garden to access city water because the water mains are located under the road. The community gardeners were told that they could pump water out of the nearby flood control channel to use to water their plots, but every summer the inlet is treated with a toxic herbicide to control an aquatic invasive plant called Hydrilla. This means that from late June to the end of September the inlet water cannot be used on food crops. The summer of 2016 was a severe drought in upstate NY and gardeners had to bring water from home for their plots. Some of the gardeners are elderly or have small children, so hauling water to the gardens was difficult for them.

We plan to install a sustainable rainwater harvesting system, consisting of a 12' x 12' wood pavilion with a metal roof, equipped with rain gutters that will direct rain into a 500 gallon water tank. The tank will be located uphill from the garden plots so the water will flow by gravity through the hoses. This system will be very sustainable, using no electricity to catch and deliver water. The pavilion will also be used for social events and as a place for gardeners to rest in the shade when working in their plots.





# **MIKE'S FISH TANK**

PLATIES ARE NATIVE TO THE east coast of Central America and southern Mexico. They are a very popular tropical fish as they come in such a variety of colors. If you want color in your tank, come look at the platies.

Platies are livebearers and have live babies like the mollies, guppies and swordtails. Platies may eat their own young so keep them in a well planted tank so the babies have a place to

Several different color variations have been developed, such as red, yellow, orange, blue, and white. The mickey mouse platy has a spot on their tail that looks just like a mickey mouse head. Wag platies have black tails but the body may be red, orange, blue, white or variations. There is a hi fin platy which is a platy with a big top fin, the new candy cane platy is red and white and very cool looking. Another new platy is the bumblebee platy and is yellow and black like a bee.

Platies like a warm temperature, around 78 to 80 degrees and like freeze dried foods such as blood worms or tubifex worms.

They will also eat flake food. Maximum size for a platy is about 2 and a half inch to 3 inch. Females are generally bigger than the males. Maximum age for a platy is 3 years but have been known to live to 5 years.

# THE CORTLAND COMMUNITY SPCA SENDS WISHES FOR A SAFE AND HAPPY HOLIDAY SEASON!

The holiday season is upon us, and many pet parents plan to include their furry companions in the festivities. As you gear up for the holidays, it is important to try to keep your pet's habits and routines as normal routine as possible. Please be sure to steer pets clear of the following unhealthy treats, toxic plants and dangerous decorations.

 Oh, Christmas Tree: Securely anchor your Christmas tree so it doesn't tip and fall, causing possible injury to your pet. This will also prevent the tree water—which may contain fertilizers that can cause stomach upset—from spilling. Stagnant tree water is

- a breeding ground for bacteria, and your pet could end up with nausea or diarrhea should he imbibe.
- Mistletoe & Holly: Holly, when ingested, can cause pets to suffer nausea, vomiting and diarrhea. Mistletoe can cause gastrointestinal upset and cardiovascular problems. And many varieties of lilies can cause kidney failure in cats if ingested. Opt for just-as-jolly artificial plants made from silk or plastic, or choose a pet-safe bouquet.
- **Tinsel-less Town**: Kitties love this sparkly, light-catching "toy" that's easy to bat around and carry in their mouths. But a nibble can lead to a swallow, which can lead to an obstructed digestive tract, severe vomiting, dehydration and possible surgery. It's best to brighten your boughs with something other than tinsel.
- That Holiday Glow: Don't leave lighted candles unattended. Pets may burn themselves or cause a fire if they knock candles over. Be sure to use appropriate candle holders, placed on a stable surface. And if you leave the room, put the candle out!
- Wired Up: Keep wires, batteries and glass
  or plastic ornaments out of paws' reach.
  A wire can deliver a potentially lethal
  electrical shock and a punctured battery can
  cause burns to the mouth and esophagus,
  while shards of breakable ornaments can
  damage your pet's mouth and digestive tract.
- Skip the Sweets: By now you know not to feed your pets chocolate and anything sweetened with xylitol, but do you know the lengths to which an enterprising pet will go to chomp on something yummy? Make sure to keep your pets away from the table and unattended plates of food, and be sure to secure the lids on garbage cans.
- Leave the Leftovers: Fatty, spicy and human foods, as well as bones, should not be fed to your furry friends. Pets can join the festivities in other fun ways that won't lead to costly medical bills.
- Careful with Cocktails: If your celebration includes adult holiday beverages, be sure to place your unattended alcoholic drinks where pets cannot get to them. If ingested, your pet could become weak, ill and may even go into a coma, possibly resulting in death from respiratory failure.
- Selecting Special Treats: Looking to stuff your pet's stockings? Stick with chew toys that are basically indestructible, Kongs that can be stuffed with healthy foods or chew treats that are designed to be safely digestible. Long, stringy things are a feline's dream, but the most risky toys for cats involve ribbon, yarn and loose little parts that can get stuck in the intestines, often necessitating surgery. Surprise kitty with a new ball that's too big to swallow, a stuffed catnip toy or the interactive cat dancer.
- A Room of Their Own: Give your pet his own quiet space to retreat to—complete with fresh water and a place to snuggle. Shy pups and cats might want to hide out under a piece of furniture, in their carrying case or in a separate room away from the hubbub.
- New Year's Noise: As you count down to the new year, please keep in mind that strings of thrown confetti can get lodged in a cat's intestines, if ingested, perhaps necessitating surgery. Noisy poppers can terrify pets and cause possible damage to sensitive ears. And remember that many pets are also scared of fireworks, so be sure to secure them in a safe, escape-proof area as midnight approaches.






