

ITHACA DIRT RIDERS CLOSED COURSE ENDURO & YOUTH CLOSED COURSE **ENDURO AUGUST 19 -AUGUST 20, 2017**

In the early 1970's, a small group of local off-road motorcycle enthusiasts came together to form the Ithaca Dirt Riders (IDR). It was their vision to provide some local trails and events for their club members and other to enjoy. A year later, the club chartered with the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA). With many of its member interested in the AMA sport of Enduros, the club sanctioned its first event.

This year is the 44th anniversary of The Ithaca Dirt Riders Enduro! It will be held on Sunday, August 20 and starts at 305 Andersen Hill Road, Berkshire, NY 13736, starting at 9:00 am. There are no spectator fees and we have information sheets available to see where the riders will be during the event.



Also this year, the Ithaca Dirt Riders are continuing their effort to involve youth rider. On Saturday, August 19th, at noon, we will be holding a youth closed course enduro for boys and girls, ages 4 to 16 years old and 50 cc to 150cc bikes (shorter than the adult ride and less intense), at the same location, 305 Andersen Hill Road in Berkshire. It consists of a series of "loops" through fields and woods. It is a great experience for young riders with a good deal of challenge for them also. There is something for everyone this year!

For both events spectating is FREE, with many places to watch the riders of all ages make their way through the course! Find out more about these events at www. ithacadirtriders.com or ecea.org on Facebook, look for "AMA District 4 Enduro Championship" or "ECEA Sprint Jr Enduro Series" for the youth event.

SO, WHAT IS A CLOSED-COURSE ENDURO?

Enduros are a cross-country event, which not only requires speed and ability, but also endurance, (hence "Enduro"), with the courses taking at least five hours to complete. The rider must also stay on time. A route is laid out for the riders to follow and a speed is set for them to maintain. Small groups of $% \left\{ 1\right\} =\left\{ 1\right\} =\left\{$ riders, (usually four), are started every minute. The rider must then try to maintain the speed scheduled for any given area. To score the riders, the promoter has secret "check points" along the route. If he/she is not on time, they are given 1 point for every minute they are late. Being early is much worse, with 2 points for the first 2 minutes that you are early and 5 points for every minute earlier than that and disqualification if you are more than 15 minutes early. Like golf, at the end of the event the scores are added up and the rider with the lowest

With the help of many volunteers and supporters the Ithaca Dirt Riders have not only been able to host this local event, but many AMA national events over the years. Those national events have brought rider from all over the USA, Canada, Europe and even Australia. IDR not only promote the sport of off-road riding, but also help the local communities, especially the local volunteer fire departments and emergency squads, who provide great meals and bike washes at the events, along with their services when necessary.

MIKE'S FISH TANK CRICKET HEALTH

THIS IS NOT FISH RELATED but a lot of people ask how to keep crickets alive. A lot of people have lizards and they like to buy a quantity of crickets.

First, put them in a good size container, the more room they have, the better they will do.

Throw in some paper towel or toilet paper tubes, this gives the crickets something to climb on, and they are not all bunched up on top of one another.

Feed cricket food. Crickets are scavengers and will eat practically anything. But the better you feed them the better they will do. Try the cricket bites. It's a gel like substance that is the crickets source of food and water.

A couple companies make them, one type is green and the other is orange, both work fine.

Crickets drink a lot of water, if you are not feeding the gel food, be sure to put a flat dish of some kind in with the crickets for water. Don't use anything too deep or they may drown.

Crickets do not like the extremes of temperature. So be sure it's not too hot or too cold where you put their cage.

Actually dry dog food works well for cricket food, lots of protein. Remember the better you feed your crickets, the better you feed your lizard because they eat the crickets.

OCATED 20 MINUTES NORTH OF Ithaca/Lansing at the intersection of 34B and Route 90. From Ithaca, take Rt 34 (by Stewart Park) to Lansing (by Rogue's Harbor)-follow 34B for 12 miles to King Ferry. From Cortland/Homer area take Rt. 90 and follow straight to King

King Ferry, in the western part of the town of Genoa, was earlier called Northville and in the eastern part of the town is the village of Genoa.

Agriculturally based enterprises have been the mainstays of the town's economy. In its early history various grist mills and saw mills sprang up but exist now only in photographs or in scanty remains at their sites. Both threshing machines and steam tractors were once manufactured at Genoa village and King Ferry briefly had a glove factory. Currently, both hamlets have hotel accommodations and restaurants.

In the western part of town there is a winery and a marina. In the eastern hamlet there is Smith's IGA, established in 1890, which still serves the community today. A golf course to the south in Lansing borders on the town line. Hand-crafting includes upholstering, furniture, pottery, and ceramics production. Last but not least, the famous Ithaca gun was manufactured at King Ferry.

Historian Richard F. Palmer wrote: The ferry most remembered on Cayuga Lake was the Busy Bee which was operated by Captain James

Quick for many years. During the 1880's you could board the Kidders Ferry (at Kidder's Landing) for King's Ferry where you could pick up the train for Auburn.

The Ovid Bee reports that in 1856 "from Kidders Ferry to Ogden (King Ferry) teams crossed the lake on the ice which had never been heard of before. People walked over and back. Iceboats were in use frequently. The 1912 frozen lake conditions attracted people from Auburn who traveled by train to King Ferry and skated or rode on iceboat over the lake.
