



Inspired by the Vermont Composting Company, which has been using chickens to help generate tremendous amounts of compost, they

have been sourcing local food scraps, bartering for whole grain and collecting leaf bags and wood chips to create multiple wheelbarrow loads of compost per week while raising 50 chickens in a front yard. The chickens also provide ample amounts of eggs and meat for the table and for bartering. The techniques and concepts they have worked with can be scaled up and can easily be scaled down or added in small ways to a backyard chicken operation. Together, the farms milk over 1000 cows each day. Keeping with their mission of producing fresh and local foods, the milk is processed at the local Byrne Dairy plant, located only miles away in Cortland, NY.



MIKE'S FISH TANK NEON TETRA

THE NEON TETRA IS A freshwater fish of the characin family. This type of species is native to blackwater clearwater streams in the Amazon basin of South America. Its bright colouring makes the fish visible in the dark blackwater streams, and is also the main reason for its popularity among tropical fish hobbyists.

It grows to approximately 3 inches in overall length. The female having a slightly larger belly, and a bent iridescent stripe rather than the male's straight stripe. They have recently become available in a long-fin variety, but those are hard to get at the present time.

Most neon tetras available in the United States are imported from Hong Kong, Singapore, and Thailand, where they are farm raised, or to a lesser extent from Colombia, Peru, and Brazil, where they are collected from the wild. I have found while doing some research that during a single month, an average of 1.8 million neon tetras with an estimated value of \$175,000 are imported into the United States for the aquarium trade.

Mid-level feeders, they are best kept in schools of six or more, for the shoaling effect when they move around the tank.

They shoal naturally in the wild and are thus more brightly colored and more active when kept as a school as opposed to singly. The color and the iridescent stripe of this fish may become dim at night, and can be virtually invisible after a period of darkness. The

color may also fade during a period of stress.

You may often read that the neon tetras like a low ph and high acidity, but these captive raised neons do just fine in a higher ph and low acidity. They are susceptible to ick if chilled. I stock them and rarely lose any of them. They are a much hardier fish then they used to be.



DON'T LET BLACK FRIDAY OVERSHADOW SMALL BUSINESS SATURDAY

During our first year in business (2011), I had a huge sale planned for the day after Thanksgiving. I would open early, supply coffee and donuts and offer sales that would bring in customers from all over... By 6pm, the coffee was nasty, the donuts stale and the cookie trays had long since been put away into air-tight containers... and my Dad and I were disappointed.

WHAT IS ECZEMA AND HOW DO I CARE FOR IT IN THE WINTER?

Eczema (Atopic Dermatitis) is often known as "the itch that rashes." This means that itching of the skin is often the first sign of eczema. Scratching causes the skin to become red, itchy, and flaky. It can affect any part of the body and although the cause is unclear, people with a family history of eczema, hay fever, or asthma may be more likely to develop eczema. Dry air such as during the wintertime when the heat is on tends to cause the skin to dry out and eczema to flare.

Skin that is prone to eczema has difficulty keeping in moisture (think of a wall of bricks which is your skin, and the mortar in between the bricks which keeps moisture in—for patients with eczema, this mortar is less effective); thus, it is important to moisturize and keep the skin hydrated such as with a humidifier at night and creams during the day. We recommend applying moisturizers twice a day, including right after showering or bathing in lukewarm (not hot) water, and before bedtime.

To keep your skin healthy and eczema-free in the winter, try these useful tips: Use a facial moisturizer with SPF 15

or higher on a daily basis. For your lips, use a fragrance-free lip balm with at least SPF 15. sun block. Choose a fragrance-free ointment or cream (not lotions), such as Cetaphil®, CeraVe®, or Eucerin® to apply to your entire body twice a day. Heavy ointments such as Vaseline®, Aquaphor® or hydrated petrolatum are useful for severely dry areas such as the hands, feet, elbows and knees. Wearing cotton gloves or socks over an ointment on hands or feet at bedtime can help with severe dryness and cracking. 

No Smoking, Vaping, Tobacco Use AT ANYTIME IN THIS PARK

KEEP BUTTS AWAY FROM WHERE WE PLAY

AST WEEK, THE VILLAGE OF Dryden passed legislation prohibiting tobacco use on Village-owned property, including Montgomery Park and Jim Schug Trail. The Village of Dryden is one of more than 450 New York State municipalities adopting tobacco-free outdoor policies to protect the public. The Tobacco Free Zone program of Cortland, Tompkins and Chenango Counties, including Reality Check, raises awareness of the environmental impact of tobacco litter, dangers of secondhand smoke and influence on children when tobacco use is not restricted.

Tobacco litter is poisonous to children and wildlife. Discarded cigarette butts are the most common form of litter. Studies show they are toxic, slow to decompose, and costly to remove. Children routinely pick up these toxic butts and try to place them in their mouths.

Family recreation for children should not mean having to play among cigarette butts or being exposed to secondhand smoke. The U.S. Surgeon General has declared that there is no safe level of exposure to secondhand smoke. Children have smaller lungs than adults and consequently breathe in 50 percent more air pollution. It's important to expand tobaccofree outdoor areas so we can reduce exposure and prevent tobacco-caused disease.

There is tremendous public support for outdoor tobacco use restrictions. The Tobacco Free Zone program can provide technical assistance to municipalities, worksites and other entities, including signage. Visit www.TFreeZone.net to learn more.


