Each scene is entirely FOR YOU, with You, the Hero and central figure of your Story, is called to BE the Goodness that you naturally, inherently are, or you will contract in righteousness, and place a barrier between you and the expression of Love. We will go in depth about barriers and ways to dismantle them, so for Now, just consider we are getting our feet wet together here at the shoreline. So, Who You are Being, NOW, is ALL that Matters. Sometimes Who you are Called to Be is one who is making amends for something past, in the Living Moment, Now. Sometimes Who you are Called to Be is the embodiment of Grace in the Living Moment, Now. Your whole life is ONLY happening Now. We'll dive in much more here, too, I promise. Again, we're simply letting this bathe our whole selves right now, and letting It wash through us like a gentle warm shower...

So, if you have ever seen the movie Groundhog's Day, you can appreciate the premise of each One Day is What Is, and each scene you are in is for You to Heal, Evolve, and ultimately Flourish as your Kindest Humanity. Life will, all on Its own, flush out your barriers via agitations, offenses, and judgements of yourself and others. And all so that you can live your Life so Alive and as the Clarity, Peace, and Freedom that is your absolute capacity and birthright. You are here to shine as your Luminous, Radiant Self. Your





MIKE'S FISH TANK STRIPED RAPHAEL CATFISH

VERY POPULAR FISH IS the striped raphael catfish. This Apeaceful, nocturnal species is a popular aquarium fish due to its pleasant temperament and curious nature. The striped Raphael catfish are commonly found in the Amazon and they have been introduced into the united states.

These fish burrow in the soft river bottoms and frequently occurs on sandy bottom. These fish feed on mollusks, crustaceans and organic debris. They have rigid pectoral fin spines. The striped Raphael catfish also has tiny and curved protective spines running along its body. The striped Raphael catfish is a fine and sociable community fish that are peaceful to fellow catfishes and other fish species. However,they are nocturnal, and are usually not visible during the day. It is best not to catch the striped Raphael catfish with a fish net because they are prone to sticking out their pectoral fin spines in a very rigid manner, especially if stressed. Untangling these spines from a net is difficult and dangerous to both handler and fish. Alternative methods should be used. I use a brine shrimp net to catch them because the net is unlike a normal fishnet, less holes, almost more like a pillowcase. The catfish does not get stuck in the net.

The Raphael catfish will make some grunting/squeaking noises while out of water. Although generally sociable with other fish, sometimes this fish can feed on smaller fish so take care when introducing any fish that might fit into its mouth.

The striped raphael is a very popular catfish, hardy and a very pretty fish. We do stock them here at PETS A PLENTY.





Welcome to the Center Lisle Diner! It might not look like much from the outside, but looks can be deceiving. The food coming out of this kitchen is phenomenal, and that is coming from somebody that considers herself an (albeit amateur) foodie. I Google, Yelp and study restaurants and their menus, following them for sometimes a year (sorry Burger Mondays – Binghamton) before I step into their restaurant. I like to see good ones succeed (The Commons Kitchen – Ithaca) and when they don't, I'm sometimes heartbroken (The Knight Kitchen – Binghamton).

The Center Lisle Diner is different. This diner holds a special place in my heart. It has been open and closed, under new management then closed; under new management with a new name then closed again, repeatedly, over the last several years. A vicious and unfortunate cycle for this little diner set in the middle of farm land and the busy Route 79, carrying Ithaca College and Cornell University students and their parents from I-81 to Ithaca. It has been the Dudley Creek Diner, Crossroad diner and many in-between.

For the first time in 10+ years, the diner is back in the Gehm family, being ran by the daughter and granddaughter of James Gehm, the building owner. Jo and her daughter JoAnne are an amazing team! They are turning out some of the best BBQ Chicken, Cheeseburgers and omelets that I've ever had.

Sunday and Monday, the diner is open from 7am to 2pm, serving breakfast (till 11am) and lunch. Tuesday, and Thursday through Saturday, they open from 7am – 8pm with a different dinner special every night. They are closed on Wednesdays.

Tuesday they will be serving chicken and biscuits. Thursday is Spaghetti with homemade sauce and homemade meatballs. Friday is your choice of a Fish or Prime Rib dinner. Saturday is their delicious Chicken BBQ, where you can get $\frac{1}{2}$ a bird for \$7.50 or the dinner for just \$10.00, which includes your choice of homemade macaroni or potato salad, corn on the cob and a dinner roll.

Meals are very reasonably priced, with breakfast items coming with toast and coffee... \$3.29 for one egg to \$8.99 for the #1 selling 3 egg Garbage Plate omelet with ham, sausage, bacon, green peppers, onions, tomato and mushrooms. To complete the breakfast menu, they have pancakes, home fries, French toast, more than 5 different types of omelets as well





has the best Sausage Gravy and Biscuits I've had this far North of the Mason Dixon. Apple/Orange/Tomato juice or coffee and tea, both with decaf available. Did I mention that most everything is homemade?

Their lunch/dinner menu has 8oz hand formed hamburger patties on a Kaiser roll with French Fries or chips for just \$6.99. For less than \$2.00 more, you can have a Bacon Cheese Burger with crispy bacon and warm melted cheese. They also have sandwiches, salads, hotdogs and a cold plate for those hot summer days. Their BLT is the perfect amount of crispy bacon, juicy tomato and fresh lettuce on toast with just a touch of mayonnaise. All burgers and sandwiches come with hand cut French Fries or chips.

Last but not least, for those with a sweet tooth, they have homemade pies, muffins and...ICE CREAM! Both soft serve (chocolate, vanilla, twist) and hard (chocolate, vanilla, strawberry with cream). Smalls are \$2.00, Med \$3.00 and Large is \$4.00. Milkshakes are \$3.50.

ITHACA DIRT RIDERS CLOSED COURSE ENDURO & YOUTH CLOSED COURSE ENDURO

TWO DAY EVENT: AUGUST 18 - AUGUST 19, 2018

In the EARLY 1970's, a small group of local off-road motorcycle enthusiasts came together to form the Ithaca Dirt Riders (IDR). It was their vision to provide some local trails and events for their club members and other to enjoy. A year later, the club chartered with the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA). With many of its member interested in the AMA sport of Enduros, the club sanctioned its first event.

This year is the 45th anniversary of The **Ithaca Dirt Riders Enduro**! It will be held on **Sunday, August 19** and starts at 305 Andersen Hill Road, Berkshire, NY 13736, starting at 9:00 am. There are no spectator fees and we have information sheets available to see where the riders will be during the event

Also this year, the Ithaca Dirt Riders are continuing their effort to involve youth rider. On **Saturday, August 18**th, at noon, we will be holding a **youth closed course enduro** for boys and girls, **ages 4 to 16 years old** and 50cc to 150cc bikes (shorter than the adult ride and less intense), at the same location, 305 Andersen Hill Road in Berkshire. It consists of a series of "loops" through fields and woods. It is a great experience for young riders with a good deal of challenge for them also. *There is something for everyone this year!*

For both events spectating is FREE, with many places to watch the riders of all ages make their way through the course! Find out more about these events at ithacadirtriders.com or ecea.org on Facebook, look for "AMA District 4 Enduro Championship" or "ECEA Sprint Jr Enduro Series" for the youth event.

SO, WHAT IS A CLOSED-COURSE ENDURO?

Enduros are a cross-country event, which not only requires speed and ability, but also endurance, (hence "Enduro"), with the courses taking at least five hours to complete. The rider must also stay on time. A route is laid out for the riders to follow and a speed is set for them to maintain. Small groups of riders, (usually four), are started every minute. The rider must then try to maintain the speed scheduled for any given area. To score the riders, the promoter has secret "check points" along the route. If he/she is not on time, they are given 1 point for every minute they are late. Being early is much worse, with 2 points for the first 2 minutes that you are early and 5 points for every minute earlier than that and disqualification if you are more than 15 minutes early. Like golf, at the end of the event the scores are added up and the rider with the lowest score wins.

With the help of many volunteers and supporters the Ithaca Dirt Riders have not only been able to host this local event, but many AMA national events over the years. Those national events have brought rider from all over the USA, Canada, Europe and even Australia. IDR not only promote the sport of off-road riding, but also help the local communities, especially

the local volunteer fire departments and emergency squads, who provide great meals and bike washes at the events, along with their services when necessary.

Dexterous front paws with long "fingers" enable them to quickly grab frogs and crayfish, as well as small rodents, insects and eggs raided from nests. Raccoons are omnivorous creatures, and will consume fruits, nuts and plants. They may also pillage vegetable gardens and raid trash cans to feast on the spoils. In their northern range, raccoons pack on fat during warmer months to prepare for winter, through which they spend much of the time snoozing inside their dens. Tree cavities and hollow logs make for desirable dorms, as do house attics. In late spring, a mother raccoon will typically bear 3-5 babies, called kits [photo], within her den. The kits remain in the den for the first several weeks of life. Afterwards, they'll toddle along behind mom until autumn, when it's time to strike out on their own. Raccoons can become problematic when people inadvertently provide food sources, such as easily accessed garbage or pet food left outside. They are also attracted to structures offering shelter by way of accessible cavities. Raccoon-proofing can be challenging, because those oh-so-nimble paws enable these clever animals to manipulate latches, doorknobs and even jar lids. Hunting or trapping raccoons is permitted only during open season and requires a license. Tempting as it may be, it is illegal to keep a raccoon as a pet, and although some people feed them, it's not wise to do so. Canine distemper is a common disease that causes mortality in the raccoon population, but cannot be transmitted to humans. Raccoon rabies reached NY State in 1990 and has since become widespread. Rabies can be transmitted to people. A raccoon that is infected with distemper or rabies may seem "tame," act aggressively, appear uncoordinated, salivate excessively or drag its hind legs. If you suspect a raccoon may be rabid, keep your distance and contact local health officials.






