CREATURE FEATURE THE AMERICAN MINK

THE MINK IS A SMALL, slender mammal in the Mustelid family (weasels, otters, etc.). There's more to a mink than just its valuable, glossy-brown fur. Slightly webbed feet enable it to move freely between terrestrial and water environments, and it's an excellent swimmer. It inhabits forested areas close to water and prefers shorelines with rocky, brushy cover. The mink is often within 100 feet from the water. One Quebec researcher found the majority of mink activity within 10 feet of a stream.

Fish make up nearly half of its diet, but it will also eat crayfish, rodents, amphibians and birds. Although diminutive in stature, the mink is innately fierce. It attacks and eats larger animals like rabbits and muskrats. From my boat, I've observed minks as they run along the lakeshore, investigating crevices between rocks and logs for frogs and other prey. They'll slip silently into the water for a moment before scooting back up onto shore, forever on the go.

Recent studies show a strong link between declines in mink populations in areas where wetlands are found to be polluted. Even small amounts of mercury and PCB's can seriously impair its reproduction, and higher doses

can be lethal. Pollutants, pesticides and heavy metals are known to cause biomagnification - toxins concentrate as they move up the food chain. Being near the top of the chain, the mink is vulnerable to these concentrated toxins. The mink, therefore, acts as a "canary in the coal mine," warning of contaminated waterways and reminding us how our actions can directly impact natural resources, wildlife, and even our own well being.

CAPTURING WEDDING MOMENTS SHANA KARN, SHOTS BY SHANA PHOTOGRAPHY, DRYDEN



T's September; shades of red, orange, yellow and gold are creeping along the edges of the leaves still clinging to the trees after a full summer, kids have returned to school and there was a full week of first-day-back-photos posted by both sad, yet anxious parents, we had a day or two of cool, autumn air—though true fall doesn't begin until later this month and pumpkin-flavored coffees and baked goods abound at every turn. Many of us are anxious for the cooler temps and the opportunity to wear sweaters; we are excited about the colorful display of leaves that we hope and pray for every year. 

607 HEALING HEARTS

HAT IS 607 HEALING HEARTS? It is a group created out of necessity. This was a need for such a group to help with the understanding and loss that really only a parent can understand from the loss of their child. 607 Healing Hearts is an overdose grief support group for parents and guardians who have lost a child.

What led to

It was the early morning hours on March 23, 2017, that started this journey that I did not ask for or ever thought I would be on. I received a call that my son Spencer M. O'Gorman was in the emergency room. A call no parent ever wants to hear, I was not given much info at all when I said "I am on my way" in that short 5 minute drive I could not have, nor did I ever think I would see what I saw when I walked in the room my son was in. There is nothing that can prepare a parent for what I saw! There laying in a bed with tubes and lines in my baby boy. He was on life support. My heart sank. Fast forward a bit and I am told my son had cocaine and opioids in his urine. I just found out my son not only was on life support but learned that he was using drugs. There is no real way to express the feelings and the thoughts for all that I saw, heard, was told, and experienced in the hours after those moments.

On March 24, 2017 at 11:30am the doctor came in and said, "Spencer has gone without oxygen to his brain for too long, an anoxic injury, leaving him with major brain damage and zero percent chance of coming back." Zero percent chance! Again, there is simply no way to describe the feelings at a moment like that.

On April 8, 2017 my son officially passed. I am pretty sure the Dean O'Gorman that I was on March 22, 2017 also died on April 8. The days that followed I posted about Spencer in an open and honest way. What this did, I could not have imagined. It brought so many messages my way, people thanking me for being so open, and shared their stories they have not talked to anyone about. There was one person that stuck out to me.

They asked me if I knew of any groups for parents, they had been looking for a year.

What I found out is that there was not any type of support group for parents. I went to a group that had an addict that lost their friend, a girl that lost her boyfriend, a sister that lost her brother, and a girl with her grandmother that lost her mom. I clearly remember thinking at one point I needed to be in a parental role, this group was not going to help me or other parents to try and find a way to survive this nightmare journey we are now on.

So I ended up working with some really wonderful people, these people have helped to set up a group, where parents, step-parents, and guardians can go and talk openly, knowing they are not losing their mind. It is a place where we can be there for one another and help others who are on this journey. It is a group that can grow and adapt to the needs of each person there. It is a safe place to stop holding it all in, because nobody could ever really understand what we have had to do.

MIKE'S FISH TANK CLAWED FROG

THE AFRICAN CLAWED FROG ALSO known as the xenopus, African clawed toad is a species of African aquatic frog of the Pipidae family. Its name is derived from the three short

claws on each hind foot, which it uses to tear apart its food. The word Xenopus means "strange foot".

African clawed frogs can grow up to a length of 5 in. They have a flattened head and body, but no tongue or external ears.

The species is found throughout much of Sub-Saharan Africa (Nigeria and Sudan to South Africa), and in isolated, introduced populations in North America, South America, and Europe. All species of the Pipidae family are tongueless, toothless and completely aquatic. They use their hands to shove food in their mouths and down their throats and a hyobranchial pump to draw or suck things in their mouth. Pipidae have powerful legs for swimming and lunging after food. They also use the claws on their feet to tear pieces of large food. They lack true ears but have lateral lines running down the length of the body and underside, which is how they can sense movements and vibrations in the water.

They use their sensitive fingers, sense of smell, and lateral line system to find food. Pipidae are scavengers and will eat almost anything living, dying or dead and any type of organic waste.

These frogs are aquatic and are often greenish-grey in color. Albino varieties are commonly sold as pets. "Wild type" African Clawed Frogs are also frequently sold as pets. The average life-span of these frogs ranges from 5-15 years with some individuals recorded to have lived for 20–25 years. They shed their skin every season, and eat their own shedded skin.

Male and female frogs can be easily distinguished through the following differences. Male frogs are usually about 20% smaller than females, with slim bodies and legs. Males make mating calls to attract females, sounding very much like a cricket calling underwater. Females are larger than the males, appearing far more plump with hip-like bulges above their rear legs.



ARLINGTON ACRES AN OLD BARN GETS A NEW LIFE

THEN KATIE JEROME GOT ENGAGED and said that she wanted to get married in her grandpa's barn, her fiance and family thought she was crazy. Hundreds of bales of hay were stacked from floor to ceiling; parts of the floor hadn't been uncovered in 50 years; wind and rain blew through the walls, and horses were still living downstairs. The barn hadn't been painted in decades, and years of hard farming had left numerous patches and repairs. Standing on a family farm that was originally settled by family ancestors in 1862, the barn has weathered the test of time and remains a testament to the strength of love and family.

It was all-hands on deck to transform the barn into a venue fit for such a special day. This massive undertaking became a family affair, with parents, aunts, uncles and the engaged couple all contributing elbow grease. Between the 2015 engagement and the couple's wedding on June 11, 2016 the family restored the barn to its former glory. After a massive cleanout, the exterior was stained, and repairs were made. Instead of renovations, the family focused on restoration and gave new life to original features-- the granary was transformed into a bar topped with a slab of butternut found on the property; the original watering trough became a cocktail

hour site and real stairs were added to the upper hayloft for additional seating and an incredible view of the dance floor.

As the barn was transformed, the family thought perhaps others would be interested in holding their weddings there too. A simple Facebook page was created, and without any advertising, the interest was overwhelming. Arlington Acres hosted 10 weddings in its first year, 35 over the last two seasons, is nearly full for 2019--and already has bookings for

The venue was named Arlington Acres in honor of the family's patriarch, Arlington Garrett, who was the last to operate the farm as a dairy until his unexpected death in 1977. Arlington was a respected and active community leader--serving 25 years as the Town Justice of Fabius, President of the Tully Masonic Lodge, deacon at the Apulia Station Methodist Church, and active volunteer fireman.

"Every time I walk into the barn I smile," says Nancy Hatch, Arlington's daughter, who grew up on the farm. "I know my dad would just love that his farm is home again to so many happy memories."

Arlington Acres continues its 150-year family-run tradition. Katie and her husband run the business side of things and





coordinate the weddings, her parents give tours, maintain the grounds and staff the events. You're also likely to meet one of the many aunts, uncles, cousins and family members that stop by frequently and support the venue as well.

The sense of rustic comfort is a central theme throughout Arlington Acres Wedding Barn. Golden string light garlands wrapped around wooden beams and jumbo white paper lanterns lend the barn an air of festive magic. Above the polished butternut bar hang electric Ball jar lanterns, and the bar stools are repurposed and updated tractor seats. The ivory-clothed tables are adorned simply with burlap runners and polished wooden slabs, upon which sit fairy-lighted mason jars. The rustic down-home feeling is completed by framed historical black and white photos of different sizes that decorate the walls.

The high ceilings and the wide-open doors opposite one another on each side of the barn create a generous, clean airflow on a pleasantly breezy day; and the doors can be closed against the elements on cold winter days, where the inside of the barn stays pleasantly warm.

Outside, at the top of a nearby knoll, against the majestic backdrop of Labrador Mountain, stands a wedding arch, waiting to be decorated according to the couple's wishes. Wooden church pews acquired from Habitat for Humanity are available as outdoor seating for guests to observe the
