happening, there's still much more work to do in terms ofeducating the public about how to protect themselves in the event of one," said Lorraine Carli, NFPA's vice president of Outreach and Advocacy. "This is particularly critical given the increased speed at which today's home fires grow and

Carli also notes that although people feel safest in their home, it is also the place people are at greatest risk to fire, with four out of five U.S. fire deaths occurring at home. Thatoverconfidence contributes to a complacency toward home escape planning and practice.

Members of local fire departments know from years of experience working in the fire service that people often make choices that jeopardize their safety or even cost them their lives. People need to become better educated about the potentially life-saving difference escape planning and practice can make. The NFPA's Fire Prevention Week is geared to help educate the public and motivate people into

This year's "Look. Listen. Learn." campaign highlights three steps people can take to help quickly and safely escape a fire:

- · Look for places fire could start.
- Listen for the sound of the smoke alarm.
- Learn 2 ways out of every room.

While NFPA and the Cortland Fire Department are focusing on home fires, these fire safety messages apply to virtually anywhere.

People need to be aware of their situations wherever they go. One of the basic preventative measures is to look for exits anywhere you may be. Alarm systems should be taken seriously when they sound, and people need to immediately exit the building.

CREATURE FEATURERUFFED GROUSE

The ruffed grouse is an upland game bird with many common names, including partridge. Resembling a chicken in shape, it is exceptionally well-camouflaged, with speckled plumage that ranges in color from gray to a rich red. It has a dark-colored ruff around the neck, especially noticeable in male birds. The tail has a black band. Preferred habitat includes brushy woodlands with poplars, birch and alders, where the grouse feed on buds, berries and insects. Although ruffed grouse spend most of their time on the ground, they're skilled short-distance fliers and are able to navigate between trees at high speeds. The male grouse has a fascinating spring mating behavior called "drumming." It

finds a staging spot, such as a stump or large rock. There, it begins to slowly beat its wings, building up speed and ending in a rapid whir. This creates a low-pitched thumping, reminiscent of an old-time engine slowly warming up. The sound is produced because a vacuum is created when the wings are drawn outward. As air rushes in to fill the void, it produces a thump. Drumming serves to attract females, as well as defend the male's territory. Ruffed grouse don't migrate. By winter, they have grown rows of tiny extensions on their toes that biologists believe act as snowshoes.

MIKE'S FISH TANK POND WINTER

 ${f A}$ UTUMN IS COMING AND SOME people will be bringing their pond fish inside soon.

Try to move them on a day that the water temperature in your outside pond and inside pond are within a few degrees of each other. This will avoid putting the fish under unnecessary stress. Be sure to cover the indoor tank with a net. Fish, especially Koi, will sometimes jump after a move.

If you have gravel in your pond, bring some of that in too. If no gravel, bring in any rocks that you may have in the pond.

The beneficial bacteria lives in that gravel and this will help your fish's transition from out to in. But don't rinse the gravel because this can kill the good bacteria.

If bringing pond fish inside, the bigger the tank the better as goldfish and koi produce a lot of waste.

If you decide to leave your pond fish outside, just be sure the pond deep enough so that it will not freeze through.

As long as you have open water the fish are usually ok. They make pond heaters/deicers that help keep an area of your pond from freezing. Also having a pump blowing lots of bubbles can help your pond from freezing. Lots of aeration is good.

Cold snaps that drop temperatures below freezing for extended periods can reduce the ability of deicers and aerators to keep holes in the ice for gas exchange. The depth of the outdoor pond and/or if it is an above ground pond will also impact how your pond freezes. Ponds under two and half feet deep are more at risk.

Koi are (cold-blooded) and have adapted to handle cold temperatures. Their metabolism and overall activity is dependent on the ambient water temperature. As the temperature drops, so does their appetite and movement as they settle into what is essentially a state of hibernation.

If it looks like it's going to be a cold winter and you are not sure if your pond will freeze through, then a better option might be to bring your pond fish inside especially if you have expensive koi or fish you've had a long time.
