MIKE'S FISH TANK STRIPED RAPHAEL CATFISH

VERY POPULAR FISH IS the striped raphael catfish. This Apeaceful, nocturnal species is a popular aquarium fish due to its pleasant temperament and curious nature. The striped Raphael catfish are commonly found in the Amazor and they have been introduced into the united states.

These fish burrow in the soft river bottoms and frequently occurs on sandy bottom. These fish feed on mollusks crustaceans and organic debris. They have rigid pectoral fir spines. The striped Raphael catfish also has tiny and curved protective spines running along its body. The striped Raphae catfish is a fine and sociable community fish that are peaceful to fellow catfishes and other fish species. However,they are nocturnal, and are usually not visible during the day. It is best not to catch the striped Raphael catfish with a fish net because they are prone to sticking out their pectoral fin spines in a very rigid manner, especially if stressed. Untangling these spines from a net is difficult and dangerous to both handler and fish Alternative methods should be used. I use a brine shrimp net to catch them because the net is unlike a normal fishnet, less holes, almost more like a pillowcase. The catfish does not get stuck in the net.

The Raphael catfish will make some grunting/squeaking noises while out of water. Although generally sociable with other fish, sometimes this fish can feed on smaller fish so take care when introducing any fish that might fit into its mouth.

The striped raphael is a very popular catfish, hardy and a very pretty fish. We do stock them here at PETS A PLENTY.

CREATURE FEATURE WHITE-TAILED BUCKS

T'S BREEDING SEASON FOR WHITE-TAILED deer. This is $oldsymbol{oldsymbol{L}}$ known as the "rut," when bucks are furtively seeking receptive does. Whitetails are polyandrous, meaning they mate with multiple individuals. There's a lot of competition among bucks for breeding opportunities. They'll fiercely fight one another using their antlers in an effort to win the rights to mate with a doe. Rival bucks have been found with their antlers locked together, sometimes with a tragic outcome for one or both animals. A common behavior that bucks display during the rut is making rubs on trees with their antlers. This leaves their scent behind to alert other deer of their presence. They also make scrapes under trees by disturbing the leaves and dirt, depositing scent from glands on their nose and forehead. Afterwards, they usually paw the ground and urinate to leave even more scent behind. A buck might even choose a licking branch, to apply more of his unique scent. These areas are like signposts. Once a receptive doe is won, a buck will spend 1-2 days with her before moving on. In this time period, he'll likely have his strength and endurance tested by rivals. A buck may lose around 30 percent of his body weight during the stresses of the rutting season.
