

BUILT AT ITS CURRENT LOCATION OVER 30 years ago in 1986, Cortland Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, Ram, has been building its business and relationship with its customers through integrity. As far as financing is concerned, Cortland Chrysler does its best to do what is right for the customer. "We won't put a customer in a car they can't afford," Ken said. "We want to build customers, not introduce consumers to a bad experience. If we put them in a situation where they are unable to afford their car, then they may not come back to us. And we want them to come back."

The same can be said of Cortland Chrysler's sales practices. "We don't 'flood' the floor with sales people," he said. Their laid-back, low-pressure approach to customers is designed to assist in creating a comfortable, stress free car buying experience. "We have four Sales Associates: J.P., Viktor, Matt, and Mike; and a customer will most likely meet a sales manager. We are very proactive with the customers." This enables them to get to know the customer's situation and lend a personal touch to the experience, rather than hustling the customer through the process for the sake of selling a car. "It isn't about selling a car," Ken said. "It's about building a customer."

Instead, our Used Car Manager, Ryan Schafer, researches the used car market and what price the car is going for at dealerships within a 300-mile radius. He then prices each of our used car inventory accordingly to meet or to beat that price. This enables us to establish a firm but fair price up front, and removes any questions or issues as to mark-ups." Ken said that since Cortland Chrysler has implemented the practice of fair market value pricing, consumers come from all over and from as far as Pennsylvania and Watertown to purchase cars there. "This dealership is right in the middle of an area where there are several large dealerships. The best way for us to compete is to offer great pricing."

There are a couple of different reasons why Ken Terpening enjoys working in his position as Sales Manager at Cortland Chrysler. "I like the product. Jeep is fantastic; we have a lot of Jeeps on our lot, and they are really popular. Jeep has something for everyone, and stands alone as far as safety, reliability, and versatility. In fact, while there are

OUR PATH TO ALPACAS

THERE WAS A TIME WHEN my husband, Ken, and I were lacksquare anticipating the day when we would leave suburbia and find a quite home amid some flower and vegetable gardens on a few acres of land. That idea was tweaked a bit when we encountered the irresistible alpaca. We were immediately drawn to their relatively gentle disposition and the promise of a simpler lifestyle. Before long we owned 3 alpacas with another on the way. A number of years later we are sharing our farm with 85 alpacas, 42 chickens, 3 guineas and a few cats. The responsibilities of visiting the vet for the care of a few cats and a dog expanded into the art of animal husbandry and all that accompanies it. MIKE'S FISH TANK TANK CYCLING

What it means when we say a tank has to cycle. There is a good bacteria that forms when fish are put into an aquarium. The bacteria that grows lives off the urine the fish produce, also known as ammonia. This bacteria eats the ammonia and converts it to nitrites. There is another bacteria that eats the nitrites, it is commonly referred to as nitrifying bacteria. That bacteria produces nitrates. The ammonia and the nitrites are the two things that are bad for fish.

The nitrates are not as bad and those you get rid of by doing a water change. Siphoning the bottom of your fish tank is important. 20% or so once a month will help keep nitrates in check. Doing too many water changes can actually be bad because you are disturbing the growth of the beneficial bacteria. That is also why it's a bad idea to completely clean everything in the tank. You will kill that nitrifying bacteria and you do not want to do that. Overfeeding your fish

can cause higher loads of ammonia if the food sits on the bottom of the tank and decays. That can affect your good

Ammonia and nitrites can kill fish if they are too high. That is why it is so important to go easy on how many fish you put in a new tank. For example if you put 12 fish in a newly setup 10 gallon tank, thats 12 fish producing ammonia and with no good bacteria in your tank yet, they are swimming in high concentrations of ammonia. It also causes your tank to be cloudy. Do just a few fish until the ammonia eating bacteria has grown, then go slow until your nitrite eating bacteria has grown. all in all I tell people it's going to take 4 to 6 or 7 weeks until your tank is cycled and you have all the beneficial bacteria you need. 

CREATURE FEATURE THE CEDAR WAXWING

THESE BEAUTIFUL, MASKED BIRDS ARE nomadic, moving about depending on the food supply. They're named for bright red waxy spots found on the wingtips of the adult birds. Waxwings travel in flocks, foraging together on berries, small fruits and insects. They will also eat some flowers and oozing sap. Some of their favorite berry-bearing trees are cedar, juniper, dogwood, serviceberry, crabapple and wild cherry. If you have any of these trees in your yard, Cedar Waxwings will likely come a-calling. Listen for their high-pitched, sighing whistles and "bzeee" calls as they flap and flutter among the branches, plucking berries and swallowing them whole. A sociable bird, even in nesting season, they will pass berries back and forth to one another until one bird eventually eats the berry. Waxwings don't start nesting until mid-summer. The female selects the site and does most of the nest construction. The pair may steal building materials from neighboring nests. They guard just a small area of territory, so other waxwings may have nests close by, forming a little colony. At first, hatchlings are fed high-protein insects, and then berries are added. Cedar waxwing populations are increasing in some places where fallow fields revert to woodlands. They're also benefiting from the planting of berry-bearing trees in landscaping projects.
