LIVING WITH HEARTFULNESS

s Valentines Day rounds the corner, it is the perfect time As of year to talk about heartfulness meditation. When we are upset we can engage in heartfulness to send ourselves compassion and love. Heartfulness is a practice of kindness and compassion in each moment. With each phrase, we are planting the seeds of loving wishes in our heart.

You can begin the practice of Heartfulness right now by letting yourself sit in a comfortable position. Breathe. Let your body be relaxed. Place your hand on your heart.

Breathe gently, and recite inwardly the following words directed to your own well-being. You begin with yourself because we must feel love, in order to send love.

- I wish for me to be happy
- I wish for me to feel healthy
- $I {\it wish for me to be peaceful}$
- I wish for me to experience freedom

As you repeat these phrases, picture yourself living the phrases, and hold that image in lovingkindness. Adjust the words in any way you wish. Repeat these phrases many times, focusing on what feelings come up. Practice this meditation for a number of weeks, until the sense of Heartfulness for yourself grows.

This meditation may at times feel awkward. It can also bring up feelings contrary to heartfulness, like irritation and anger. If this happens, be patient with yourself, allow whatever arises to be received in a spirit of understanding.

When you have established a strong sense of lovingkindness for yourself, you can include others. You can simply replace the Me in the phrases with You or someone's name, or all beings.

The most important part of heartfulness is to follow the way that most easily opens your heart.

MIKE'S FISH TANK ICH

THIS IS THE TIME OF year when a lot of people have fish L catching ick, due to varying temperatures.

Ichthyophthirius multifiliis is an ectoparasite of freshwater fish which causes a disease commonly known as white spot disease or ich. Ich is one of the most common and persistent diseases in fish. It appears on the body, fins and gills of fish as white nodules that look like white grains of salt. Each white spot is an encysted parasite.

If not controlled, there is a 100% mortality rate of fish. With careful treatment, the disease can be gotten rid of. But the protozoa damages the gills and skin as it enters the tissues, leading to ulceration and loss of skin. Severe infections rapidly lead to loss of condition and death. Damage to the gills reduces the respiratory efficiency of the fish, reducing its oxygen intake from the water. This causes the fish to become less tolerant to low oxygen concentrations in the water.

Ich is a stress disease. Stresses like water temps going down or up, fish being chased by bully fish. Tapping or hitting the glass tank can all cause ich.

Check your fish carefully daily. Treating the ich fast is the key to not losing any fish.





"Hydrogen sulfide gas will corrode plumbing metals such as iron, steel, copper and brass, and the exposed metal parts in appliances such as dish washers and washing machines" Shute said. "Also, corrosion of iron and steel pipes from ferrous sulfide, or 'black water,' that can darken everyday tableware, discolor copper and brass utensils and alter the appearance and taste of cooked foods."

Additionally, Shute said, sulfur water can make washing clothes more difficult.





CREATURE FEATURE THE CANADA GOOSE

OST FOLKS CAN EASILY IDENTIFY the Canada goose. In fact, Lit's so familiar that we may take its stately elegance for granted. The most defining features of this large goose are its black head and neck and a white cheek patch. It usually resides near water and congregates in expansive, grassy areas like parks, golf courses and farm fields. These open places provide a good view of approaching danger. The Canada goose eats different grasses and aquatic vegetation. It "dabbles" dipping forward and reaching its neck underwater in search of submerged plants. It's comical to see a goose bum tipped



skyward as it forages this way. In cold months, berries, seeds and agricultural grains are eaten. The Canada goose typically selects a mate sized similarly to itself, and pairs tend to mate for life. Mother Goose chooses the nest site, often using a muskrat mound or hump of collapsed cattails. Papa Goose aggressively protects her and the nest, reacting to threats with angry hissing. He may even pummel an intruder with bruising blows from his powerful beak and wings. Respect nest sites by steering clear. Most goslings stay with their parents for the first year. During noisy migrations, flocks fly in a V-formation called a "skein," with the more experienced geese taking turns leading.
