

MIKE'S FISH TANK POND SEASON

Pond season fast approaching. Most pond fish breeders say that Memorial day is the official kickoff of pond season.

You want your water to warm up a bit before adding your fish. Fish that have been inside may not be ready for that chilly water yet. When you do take your pond fish back outside, be sure to float them in a bag BUT ONLY for only 5 minutes. This will help them adjust to the

Avoid Overstocking the Pond, To maintain healthy fish and clear water, do not overload the ecosystem with too many fish. For a new pond, a good rule of thumb is one inch of fish per square foot of surface area. A mature pond can support two to three inches of fish per square foot. The following are good fish for ponds.

Comets, one of the most popular types of goldfish, have long slender

bodies and are typically solid orange and metallic in appearance. Shubunkins have longer, thinner bodies and are typically shaped like the common goldfish. They are primarily bred for their beautiful colors. Most shubunkins are calico in color, orange, red, gray, almost Koi:are ornate cousins of the carp family and can be easily identified

by their whiskers. Their vivid coloration, striking patterns, longevity and impressive size make them popular pets. Standard Koi colors are black, white, yellow, orange, blue or red. Other koi types are, Taisho Sanke: Pure white Koi with distinct red and black markings.

Ohgon or neon Koi: Usually yellow, orange or gold metallic. Butterfly Koi: Distinguished by their long butterfly fins.

Sarasa comets are red and white and shaped like the shubunkins. They are hardy and not too expensive. Some people even use the cheap feeder fish, like you get at the fair. They often do ok in the pond as long as it's not too hot.

Normally most pond fish are fine together especially if similar in size.



YOUTH VAPING DISCUSSED AT COMMUNITY FORUM THE NEW FACE OF NICOTINE

APING, OR SMOKING ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES, among youth has become a growing concern in Cortland County. As vaping devices continue to evolve, it makes it challenging for parents, caregivers and school administrators to stay on top of current trends.

This is why the Tobacco Free Zone program through the Cortland County Health Department teamed with local businesses and agencies to hold a youth vaping community forum on Wednesday, April 24th at the Homer Intermediate/Junior High School Auditorium. The event was open to all Cortland County residents, with approximately 50 persons in attendance. The forum was an opportunity for residents to learn more about electronic cigarettes, the challenges school administrators are facing and what we all can do in our community to address this growing concern.

A panel of experts including Douglas VanEtten, Homer High School Principal, Rob Reyngoudt, Cortland High School Student Resource Officer, Mike Bort, Homer High School Student Resource Officer, Stuart Gillim, MD, Cortland County Medical Advisor, Emily Nink, Tobacco Policy Center Associate, Jenn Hamilton, Tobacco Free Zone, Melissa Potter, Reality Check, and Christopher Boylan, Reality Check member and sixth grade student at Homer Jr. High School provided information related to the local vaping landscape, how schools currently handle vaping on school property, the health and behavioral risks, including the use of illicit drugs through these devices, tobacco and vape industry marketing practices, and evidence-based policy efforts local municipalities can implement to minimize the problem.

Electronic cigarettes are the most popular tobacco product among youth. In the past four years, electronic cigarette use has risen an astonishing 160% among NYS



high school students. In Cortland County, 22% of students in grades 7-12 have reported using electronic cigarettes in the past 30 days, according to Cortland Area Communities that Care 2018 Pride Survey.

"Part of our responsibility as a school district is to educate families about health issues related to their children. Vaping among our youth has become a real concern and we owe it to parents to inform them of the dangers associated with it," said Tom Turck Homer Central School District Superintendent.

The high-nicotine product JUUL has become so popular with youth that it has captured nearly 75% of the e-cigarette market. The JUUL product is sleek, very discrete and comes in a variety of flavors. "Many young people are aware of and using JUUL, but they are unaware that the product always contains the highly-addictive chemical nicotine," says Jenn Hamilton, Community Engagement Coordinator with the Tobacco Free Zone program. According to the product website, a single JUUL pod or cartridge is roughly equal to a pack of cigarettes putting a new generation of youth at risk of nicotine addiction. While electronic cigarettes are less toxic than combustible cigarettes, at least 60 chemical compounds are found in e-liquids, and more are in the aerosol they produce. Electronic cigarettes are not harmless.

Electronic cigarette companies have taken a page out of Big Tobacco's playbook when it comes to their marketing strategies. Locally, tobacco and electronic cigarette marketing and sales in stores near schools is a particular concern because teens that pass by or shop at these stores are routinely exposed to pro-tobacco and electronic cigarette messaging. Exposure to point-of-sale advertising and promotions prompts initiation, encourages tobacco and electronic cigarette use, aids unplanned purchases, and undermines quit attempts.



CREATURE FEATURE RACCOONS

ACCOONS ARE ONE OF THE most easily recognized mammals. Some folks find them adorable; others feel they're a nuisance. Either way, these masked creatures are intelligent and adaptable. They're primarily nocturnal and spend lots of time foraging for food. Dexterous front paws with long "fingers" enable them to grab frogs, crayfish and other prey. Raccoons are omnivorous, so they also eat fruits and plants. Here in NY, raccoons pack on fat during the warmer months. Over the winter, they snooze a lot inside their dens within tree cavities and hollow logs. In late spring, a mother raccoon bears young, called kits, within her den. They stay in the den for several weeks, then tag along with mom until fall, when they'll strike out on their own. Raccoons can become problematic when we inadvertently provide food sources, like easily accessed garbage or outdoor pet bowls. They're also attracted to structures offering shelter via accessible cavities. Raccoon-proofing can be challenging, because these clever animals can manipulate latches, doorknobs and even jar lids. It's illegal to keep a raccoon as a pet, and it's not wise to feed them. Raccoon rabies reached NY in 1990 and has become widespread. A raccoon infected with rabies or distemper may act tame or aggressive, appear uncoordinated, salivate excessively or drag its hind legs. If you suspect a raccoon may be rabid, keep your distance and contact local health officials. It's a myth that any raccoon active in the daytime is sick; they may forage in daylight, especially mothers.
