Now, with the help of his wife Jessica, friends, and family, he will assist the Denman's in continuing the legacy of Frozen Ocean.

Currently, the facility sits on 66 acres overlooking Skaneateles Lake and the surrounding Finger Lakes area at 4415 Vanderstouw Road, Auburn. There is a challenging Night Cross track, a Super Cross track, a practice track for 50cc riders, an off-road track for ATVs and side x sides, and a clay oval for go-kart racing. Frozen Ocean is a full-service facility with a pavilion, flush toilets, concession stand and merchandise for sale.





MIKE'S FISH TANK POND SEASON

POND SEASON IS HERE. MOST of the fish farms say Memorial day is the start of pond season. Over the winter months, a whole range of nutrients have accumulated such as phosphate and nitrate, which can cause algae to grow in springtime.

A partial water change of approx. 30% of the water is now needed to remove nitrate. For best results, fill your pond with tap water. This water is continuously monitored at the water works and so is of excellent quality. Spring water can contain fertiliser and rainwater is often too soft meaning that the pH (acidity) of the water is liable to fluctuate. By spring water, it means from an outdoor spring not bottled spring water.

Waterside and marsh plants help make your pond safe. Over the winter months, many plants perish, leaving your pond easily accessible to children and small animals. Abundant vegetation can stop them in their tracks. Plus, you need have no worries about the dog, the neighbour's cat or birds taking a sip from the pond. Tetra water conditioners, and anti-algae agents are all kind to animals and plant life.


If your pond is a veritable sun trap, it's worth also planting well around your pond. Shade in the middle of the day will give fish protection from the sun and prevent algae growth.

If you are just starting a pond, go light on fish the first month or so. Just like an aquarium, you need the beneficial good bacteria. Once that is established you can gradually add more fish.Some of the fish that do well in ponds are Koi, Sarasa comets, regular comets and shubunkins. Keep in mind these fish will grow, so allow room for that.

Most of these fish will eat things that may fall into the pond but it's still important to feed some flake food or pellet food several times a day. We have all the fish mentioned above.


