





enable it to jump 15 times its body length. This feat allows the bullfrog to catch lots of different prey, including insects, minnows, rodents, bats, ducklings, snakes...even other frogs. Surprisingly, after they hatch, bullfrogs can remain in the tadpole stage of life for 1-3 years, depending on surrounding conditions. Tadpoles may stay active under the ice through winter; but the adult frog burrows into mud on the lake or pond bottom to hibernate, where it's able to absorb oxygen stored in the mud. Look for "Jeremiah Bullfrog" along lake/pond edges and wetlands where there are heavy mats of vegetation, like lily pads, or other emergent aquatic plants that provide cover. If you can't see one, you'll still know a bullfrog is near when you hear a slow, deep call that sounds like "jug-o-rum, jug-orum." An iconic sound of summer on the water!

MIKE'S FISH TANK PET HEAT

FEW TIPS ON PETS and summer heat. It's perfectly ok to buy fish

That bag will heat up fast, so you want the fish to get into your tanks as fast as possible. Goldfish do not like heat.

Feeder goldfish and feeder minnows do terrible in the heat. I don't even ship them in this time of year.

Sometimes pond fish will suffer if the water gets too hot. Always try to put the pond in the shade, it helps a lot.

As far as floating your fish when you get home, only float the bag 5 minutes, max. It only takes a few minutes for the water in the bag to equalize to your tanks temp. The fish farms do not recommend putting ice cubes in your tank to cool the water. You get pockets of really cold water which could cause your fish to get sick. If your tank gets too hot,

your tank and blow a fan on it. That will help cool it down slowly. It's a tip straight from the fish farms.

Rabbits do not like the heat at all, and hamsters do not like it either. Guinea pigs handle it a bit better. Just be sure to keep your pets water bottle filled, they get really thirsty when it's this hot. It's perfectly ok to blow a fan on them. If you see them really panting, that means they

The one pet that probably enjoys the heat are reptiles and snakes, but even they have a limit. If you start going over $90\$ to $95\$ degrees inside their habitat, it's probably getting too hot even for them. If that happens, turn the heat lamps off and even turn off any heat rocks or undertank heaters. They won't need them if really hot and humid

Also remember do not leave your dog in a car with the windows rolled down a little bit and the car turned off. In this heat, the inside temperature of the car goes up very fast and could be deadly to your pet dog. We have seen this in the news far too much.

Just remember all your pets need to stay hydrated in this heat. Be sure fresh water is available to all of them 24/7.

INTERNATIONALLY RESPECTED ARTISTS FEATURED AT GALLERY 54

NEONTA, NY ARTIST, PAINTER DAVE Kiehm is a BBC Wildlife Artist of the year and Hamilton, NY ceramic artist Leslie Green Guibault is one of only a few dozen artists throughout the United States permitted to use the Roycroft Artisan logo and she has one of her creations in the permanent collection of the Chengdu Ni Bang Ceramic Art Museum in China. Together they headline the August and September offering at Gallery 54, here.

Their show will open during the August First Friday, August 2, from 5 to 8 pm and run through the month of September.

While both are obviously at the top of their game, they could not be more different in many ways. Dave began creating art at a "very young age," he says, when after seeing painting while visiting museum, he thought ". . . the images were magical." It would appear likely that his interest in painting began, however, with his thought as a youngster, "I can do that." He says his "love of nature and animals and my agility to draw and capture their likeness encouraged me to pursue wildlife art."

Guilbault, on the other hand, didn't begin creating art until just a few years ago, after resigning from a job she didn't enjoy. This was when she "... made time" to teach herself how to carve bones. "I'm still not sure why I needed to carve that first bone," she wrote recently, adding, "After about six months I wondered what carving clay would feel like, so I started throwing posts on the wheel and carving them, too."

Kiehm notes, "I like to paint what and how I see. My work is fairly literal because I want to capture texture and color. Guibault was attracted to her art because of the meditative nature of freehand carving of the designs she creates. "The pieces are different every time," she says, "so I never get bored. There's always something new to learn."

The work Guibault will show at Gallery 54 is wheel-thrown porcelain that is freehand carved and finished in a variety of food-safe metallic glazes. She notes that she "loves experimenting in her studio." When I find a style or technique that makes my heart sing, I create a new collection to feature it." She currently has 14 distinct lines of ceramic art, bone carvings, and jewelry. Self-taught, Guibault believes different aspects of her personality shine through these collections.

Kiehm will show both oil and watercolor painting in the galley. The collection, he says, will feature examples of work he's been creating for many years. Asked what makes his work special, he deferred. "I think people have to determine if my work is special or not," he said. "I try to make every painting as good as possible and push myself relentlessly. Hopefully, that makes for solid paintings."

In addition to recognition as the BBC Wildlife Artists of the Year, Kiehm work has been recognized with the Cooperstown National Award, and the Society of Animal Artists Award. His work is shown internationally and throughout the USA including pieces in museums in Sedona, AZ, New Paltz, NY, the Fenimore Art Museum in Cooperstown, NY and the Munson Williams Proctor Institute in Utica, NY.

Guibault is no stranger to awards. Her work has been recognized by nearly a dozen show ribbons, two best of show and three first place in Ceramic Art. In addition, her work is represented in the Bluu Art Gallery in Carson City, NV, the Schoolhouse Gallery in East Aurora, NY as well as retail outlets in ten states.

During August 2 opening for this joint show, harpist Chris Molloy will entertain with his blue harp. Wine and light refreshments will be served.

Gallery 54, an upscale artist owned gallery featuring the work of dozens of Central and Upstate New York artists will be celebrating its 10th Anniversary in September, so stay tuned for details about the celebration.

SPCA NEEDS HELP DURING KITTEN SEASON

E ACH YEAR MAY THROUGH NOVEMBER marks "Kitten Season" for animal shelter staff when more than 600 kittens come through the doors of the SPCA's rescue building. Before finding their forever homes, kittens—those not old enough yet to stay in the Pet Adoption Center—live with the shelter's dedicated foster families until they have been fully vaccinated and are old enough to be spayed or neutered.

The SPCA is already seeing a high volume of kittens coming into the shelter and already have dozens available for immediate adoption. "Unfortunately, this is creating quite a backup of cats and kittens for us" says Jim Bouderau, Executive Director. "While our population was low coming out of the winter, we have dozens of cats who require single cat only homes."

The SPCA is currently waiving all fees for adult cats, and is reducing kitten adoption fees and extending hours on Wednesdays. Normally the SPCA's Pet Adoption Center on Hanshaw Road is not open on Wednesdays. However, this year it will be open every Wednesday from 4-7 p.m. and will be devoted exclusively to adoption of kittens. Kittens will be waiting for their "fur-ever" homes in the front lobby for a \$25 adoption fee.

"We are hoping the community can respond as soon as possible and help get these animals into the homes we know they deserve." Jim adds.
