

N SATURDAY, DECEMBER 7, THE Village of Dryden kicks off the Holiday season with events and activities throughout town. This year's plans include festivities throughout the village, with a history trivia challenge and walking tour, a business passport with over 20 local businesses and organizations, horse drawn wagon rides, stories, crafts and more. The evening includes our historic tree lighting at the Village Green with caroling and a live nativity.

There will be horse drawn wagon rides, caroling, stories, open houses, tastings, ornament making, crafts and cookies. Activities begin with Breakfast with Santa at the historic Dryden Hotel from 8-11am to support Cops, Kids & Toys. For every toy brought in, each family will earn a coupon for \$5 off a pizza, and there will be specials all day, so be sure to stop in! Dryden Agway will host a holiday craft fair from 10-2 with local craftwork as well. The Town of Dryden Historical Society will host a free ornament workshop with refreshments and displays from 10-1. The festivities continue from 12-4 with horse drawn wagon rides leaving from the library. From 2-5, the Dryden Kiwanis will have free cider and donuts at the warming tent at Time Square. The Southworth Library will have a special story time with Santa and his elf from 2:30-3 and a visit with Pete the Cat at 3pm. Each family will receive a free holiday book to keep and there will be crafts for adults and kids and cookie decorating as well. Families have an opportunity to get a holiday photo with Santa from 3-5 at the library as well, with 5 lucky winners receiving a coupon for a free photo block at the Dryden Kinney's Pharmacy. From 3-5 you can also do some free holiday children's crafts at the Dryden United Methodist Church and go to Dedrick's Farm Market for holiday activities! At 5pm the Dryden Presbyterian Church will sponsor a live nativity with sheep, goats, calves, horses and alpacas, followed by caroling on the green. At 5:30 Santa himself will arrive by fire truck to light the tree and join in the carols. After the tree lighting, the Dryden Community Center Café will reopen for free coffee, cocoa and cookies and the winners of the gingerbread House Contest, sponsored by the Habitat for Humanity and the Dryden Rotary will be announced as well as the winner of the Town of Dryden Recreation Department Holiday art Card contest. The drawings for the business passport prizes will also be at the Café following the tree lighting.

The History Trivia Challenge and Walking Tour provides a unique look of the Village past and present. Participants can pick up the map, clues and booklet at the Southworth Library and the DTHS Southworth Homestead and take a walk through Dryden Village to find the answers to the questions and learn some of our local history. Completed sheets can be turned into the library for a special prize!

The Town of Dryden Recreation Department is organizing a Christmas Card Art Contest with the cards to be delivered to the troops. The cards will be displayed in the Dryden



Community Center Café and people can vote for their favorite. The Rotary Club of Dryden has combined efforts with habitat for Humanity for a Gingerbread House Contest open to groups and organizations. Houses will be on display at the Habitat for Humanity Office on Main St. for public voting as well.




