





## **CREATURE FEATURE** AMERICAN TOAD TRIVIA

THE CHUBBY AMERICAN TOAD MEASURES 2-4" long. It has rough skin In shades of brown, red or olive, with dark blotches and "warts" of varying colors. Its belly is white with black spots. It can be found in many habitats, including forests, backyards and gardens. Its thick skin helps retain moisture, allowing the toad to live in places too dry for most other amphibians. During a short breeding season each spring, it congregates in shallow ponds and streams, along river edges and in wet ditches. The male toad attracts mates with a melancholy, monotone trill lasting up to 30 seconds. During mating, the long strands of fertilized eggs anchor around submerged vegetation. Eggs hatch quickly, depending on water temperature, and the newly emerged tadpoles swim around together. They develop into toadlets within 70 days, at which time they leave the water for life on land. The American toad uses its tongue to catch and eat a multitude of insects such as flies, crickets, grasshoppers, slugs, spiders, worms and slugs. In fact, most of its prey is classified as agricultural pests. Toads are eaten by raccoons, snakes, hawks and herons. Unlike the poisonous cane toad (native to South America), the American toad is not dangerous to dogs; nevertheless, rinse your dog's mouth thoroughly if it foams after picking up a toad. Lastly, don't worry: you cannot catch warts from touching a toad!

# **MIKE'S FISH TANK** POND SEASON

OND SEASON IS FAST APPROACHING. Be sure your water has warmed up a bit before adding pond fish.

We haven't had too many warm days and the water could be quite cold. Most of the pond fish available for sale are in water that's about 62 degrees. So if your pond water is really cold, let it warm up a bit before adding fish.

Also when adding pond fish, let the bag float for 5 minutes to equalize the temperature. But no longer than 5 minutes, longer can be bad for the fish.

Pond comets, sarras, koi and shubunkins are all good types of goldfish to put in ponds. I feed the pond fish flakes when they are small and move on to pellets as they get bigger. Remember just like an indoor tank, do not add too many fish to your pond too quickly, you are still waiting for a good bacteria which will eat the ammonia.

Always try to put your pond in a shady area. This will cut down on too much algae growing in your pond.

The fish farms always tell me that Memorial day is the official start of pond season.

# SALE OF FLAVORED E-CIGARETTES STATEWIDE **AND ALL TOBACCO SALES AT PHARMACIES END MAY 18 IN NEW YORK STATE**

#### Great step forward for New Yorkers' health

THE SALE OF FLAVORED E-CIGARETTES ends in New York State on May 18, as does the sale of all L tobacco products in pharmacies. These are huge steps forward in helping New Yorkers live free from nicotine addiction.

The new laws were passed as part of the state's fiscal year 2021 budget. New York becomes the second state in the nation to restrict the sale of tobacco products in pharmacies.

"As we combat COVID-19, it's never been more important to keep our lungs healthy," said Jennifer Hamilton, Community Engagement Coordinator of the Tobacco Free Zone program, Cortland County Health Department. "These strong measures aid to reduce tobacco use and promote health, especially among our most vulnerable populations."

Research shows that the flavors in e-cigarettes attract kids and the nicotine addicts them. Nearly 40% of high school seniors in New York State use e-cigarettes, also referred to as "vaping," and 27% of all high school youth vape. According to the latest Cortland Area Communities That Care Youth Development Survey, 1 in 4 of all Cortland County high school students are vaping. This new law ending the sale of flavored e-cigarettes in New York State will protect kids from a lifetime of nicotine addiction.

"This is what we worked so hard to achieve," said Homer seventh grader and Reality Check member Christopher Boylan. "We put in a lot of hard work and effort, and it feels good to know that we helped make this happen, and save other kids from the health problems these products cause."

Selling tobacco products in pharmacies has long sent a contradictory message to consumers by offering tobacco alongside medicine or products for illnesses either caused by or made worse by smoking. That ends now in New York State. It also reduces the number of stores that sell tobacco products in every community, an effective way of supporting tobacco users who want to quit and reducing youth exposure to tobacco marketing. There is overwhelming evidence that the more young people see tobacco, the more likely they are to start smoking.

"These pieces of legislation are a move in the right direction. It's also important to close any loopholes to prevent tobacco industry interference," said Cortland City School District Resource Officer Robert Reyngoudt. "Hopefully the banning of flavored electronic liquids will reduce the appeal for children, and alleviate some of the burden placed on school districts dealing with youth use and addiction," said Douglas VanEtten, Homer High School Principal.

Support available for New Yorkers who want to quit

For help quitting smoking or vaping, including free nicotine replacement therapy for eligible residents, individuals can contact a health care provider, call the New York State Smokers' Quitline at 1-866-NY-QUITS or visit www.nysmokefree.com. Effective medications and counseling are covered by Medicaid and most insurance programs.

Tobacco Free New York State and Reality Check student groups around the state have worked tirelessly to educate local communities about the need to protect children from the billions of dollars of tobacco marketing in places where kids can see it. The statewide "Seen Enough




# **Additional COVID-19 Symptoms**

The average age of a new smoker in New York is 13 years old, and 90% of adult smokers say they first tried smoking by age 18. Tobacco Free New York State, including the Reality Check student youth groups, is part of the NYS Tobacco Control Program.


