

The 1890 House Museum is a historic mansion located in Cortland, New York. It was built in 1890 for industrialist Chester F. Wickwire and was designed by architect Samuel B.


Chester made his fortune by establishing the Wickwire Brothers Company in Cortland, which mass-produced various wire products for rural Americans. Chester Wickwire lived in his home on Tompkins Street with his wife Ardell and sons Charles and Frederic from 1890 until his death in 1910.

The house lay dormant from 1915-1923 until Frederic moved in with his wife Marion, a local poet. Frederic and Marion made extensive renovations to the house, reflecting the elegance and flair of the 1920s. These renovations include the addition of the Fernery, the lincrusta wallpaper on the second and third floors, and the removal of the mantles over the house's fireplaces.

The 1890 House Museum is a true historic gem located at the gateway to the Finger Lakes Region. With its unique mix of Victorian and 1920s architecture and furnishings, this mansion is the ideal venue for annual events such as Gambling with Gatsby or our Victorian Teas.





CREATURE FEATURE NATURE IN DISGUISE

Athough wild animals don't trick-or-treat, many do disguise themselves through *camouflage*. Both predator and prey species improve their odds of survival by staying concealed.

Different animals use different types of camouflage. Gray squirrels employ 'color matching' to avoid the sharp eyes of hungry hawks and owls. The next time you see a gray squirrel in a tree, notice how it blends in with the bark. The fur along its back and tail may even have a greenish tinge that matches

Another form of camouflage known as 'disruptive coloration' uses contrasting colors and markings like spots, splotches and stripes that help obscure an animal's recognizable profile. The northern pike has a long, green body splashed with pale spots, allowing it to disappear in aquatic weed beds. Meanwhile, the barred and dappled plumage of the ruffed grouse makes it challenging to detect in shaded forests.

'Self-decoration' is a fascinating kind of camouflage where creatures use things within their habitat to disguise themselves. Both snapping and painted turtles exemplify self-decoration when they allow algae or tiny water plants to grow on their shells. The caddisfly larva spins a silk case for protection, then adds bits of sand, gravel and plant fragments. These decorations strengthen its mobile home and camouflages the caddisfly as it matures underwater.

MIKE'S FISH TANK COLD WEATHER

S WE APPROACH LATE AUTUMN and Winter, a lot of people worry $A^{\text{S WEAT NOTES}}$ about buying fish in cold temperatures.

Shopping for fish in cold weather, not a problem. Just follow a few simple rules. Buy the fish just before you go home. You don't want to buy fish and then go shopping elsewhere. Tropical fish like temperatures near 80 degrees. Once you purchase those fish, the temperature in that bag is dropping fast. If it's in the 20's, or 30's outside, then the water in the bag will get really cold really fast.

It might not kill the fish right away, but a chilled fish is more at risk to get ick or other fish related diseases. If you do have to make a quick stop, take the bag of fish into the store with you. Better safe $\,$

Now a small exception to the rule is goldfish. They like cold water. They could handle a trip where the temps are colder. Obviously that doesn't mean leaving the fish in the car while you shop an hour. If it's really cold, even the goldfish could get sick if chilled

But they could handle the cold a bit better. If it's really cold and you want fish, shop local. Don't take the chance of driving 30 to 60 minutes to purchase fish.

Another tip, when you get home, only float the bag of fish for 5 minutes. The little bit of water in that bag will only take 4 to 5 minutes to equalize. Floating too long will just cause more problems. We sell a lot of fish in cold weather and most people have no problems.

DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME ENDS

TIME WILL FALL BACK TO standard time again on Sunday, ▲ November 1 at 2am, when daylight saving time ends. History of Daylight Time in the U.S. Although standard time in time zones was instituted in the U.S. and Canada by the railroads in 1883, it was not established in U.S. law until the Act of March 19, 1918, sometimes called the Standard Time Act. The act also established daylight saving time, a contentious idea then. Daylight saving time was repealed in 1919, but standard time in time zones remained in law. Daylight time became a local matter. It was re-established nationally early in World War II, and was continuously observed from 9 February 1942 to 30 September 1945. After the war its use varied among states and localities. The Uniform Time Act of 1966 provided standardization in the dates of beginning and end of daylight time in the U.S. but allowed for local exemptions from its observance. The act provided that daylight time begin on the last Sunday in April and end on the last Sunday in October, with the changeover to occur at 2 a.m. local time. During the "energy crisis" years, Congress enacted earlier starting dates for daylight time. In 1974, daylight time began on 6 January and in 1975 it began on 23 February. After those two years the starting date reverted back to the last Sunday in April. In 1986, a law was passed that shifted the starting date of daylight time to the first Sunday in April, beginning in 1987. The ending date of daylight time was not subject to such changes, and remained the last Sunday in October. The Energy Policy Act of 2005 changed both the starting and ending dates. Beginning in 2007, daylight time started on the second Sunday in March and ends on the first Sunday in November.
