How did you start doing this?

I bought a few pieces of mismatch silver plate flatware in 2016 at a garage sale. It sat for a year before I investigated what I could make from it. I made a simple fish mobile and a teapot wind chime. Now in 2020, I create over 20 wicked and whimsical sea creatures from spoons, forks, butter knives, and serving pieces using the basic tools I "borrowed" from my husband. My creatures include whale, shark, pufferfish, proboscis fish, sea snakes, squid, manta ray, a variety of tropical fish and species yet to be discovered. I'm careful to cut each mouth differently, hand etch the fins, gills and stripes, design different tails for different species, and make each as detailed as possible. My latest, greatest piece is my Fish Chandelier with tea light candles. Everybody needs one of these, right?

What about the Jewelry?

In 2018 I moved to jewelry design but wasn't happy with the results. I slowly invested in professional tooling and am so glad I did. I developed my skills and remember my grandmother telling "Practice makes perfect"! I made basic pendants, then fork tine earrings, then bracelets and rings. Now I can create jewelry faster and its high quality with great prices. I'm always shopping for flatware at the very best price. I want people to have something really nice at a great bargain. It makes them happy and gives me great joy. My new favorite is Mermaid Tail pendants. They are created from a spoon bowl, etched with a pave finish, burnished and then I have the option to add a pearl rivet. All my pendants come with a silver snake chain and I have lengths from 16" to 30".



Who is Alta?

She was my grandmother who raised me. Alta Ethilda Barnhart was born in 1904 and making something out of nothing was her talent. She certainly needed that talent being married to a carpenter at a coal tipple who farmed on the side. She loved to knit, crochet, sew, bake, craft, and write poetry and lyrics. She had large plastic tubs and when the garden vegetables came on, she canned vegetable soup literally by the bushels. I'm grateful I inherited my ambition and creative abilities from her and followed her example of hard work, determination, and perfection. She was as CRAZY for jewelry



T HAS BEEN 18 YEARS since we were introduced to alpacas. In the years since then we have grown from two adults and one cria (baby) to a herd of 82. Our move to Homer in

program as well as have a shop that offers luxury items made from their fiber which they are mostly used for here in the US. Here at Tartan Acres, they share their barn with chickens, guinea hens and a couple of cats.

Part of their appeal is the ease of raising them. Their diet consists of 2nd cutting hay and pelleted grains. They have foot pads instead of hooves and so they have little impact on the ground in the pasture.

They require an injection every 5-6 weeks to guard against a parasite carried by deer. And, yes, we have learned to inject the vaccine - and found it a pretty easy task. Likewise we have learned how to assist a new mom bring her baby into the world and then monitor and document his growth to insure good health.

These new responsibilities are accompanied by a great amount of pleasure. The satisfaction of a well-kept, orderly barn filled with content animals can't be beat. Likewise, watching young stock gleefully pronging through the pastures is hard to pass up. Like any other livestock, alpacas have individual personalities. Some will welcome a friendly pat on the neck, others will shy away, but all of them are curious and will be quick to find out who is paying them a visit.

We welcome guests to the barn to provide "Alpaca 101". It is our way of introducing interested people to the possibilities of owning alpacas as we demonstrate several aspects of their care and raising.. Other visitors to our farm might bring an animal of their own for breeding to one of our award winning herd sires, browse in the alpaca apparel shop, take pictures of



CREATURE FEATURE A COYOTE BY ANY OTHER NAME...

SINCE MIGRATING TO OUR REGION over a century ago, eastern coyotes have become an established part of the landscape. While colloquial names like coy wolf, brush wolf and coy dog seem to suggest different animals, they are

all eastern coyotes. People are surprised to learn that all eastern coyotes (the only kind present in NY State) are a hybrid, produced by crossbreeding between western coyotes, both western and eastern wolves and even domestic dogs. In a matter of fact, a 2012 study sampling 407 coyotes from several northeast states and Quebec, found that 100% of the animals carried domestic dog DNA. Although there were variations, the study concluded that the average eastern coyote is about 65% western coyote, 25% wolf (about half western gray wolf and half eastern wolf) and 10% dog. With variations in genetic ratios, physical characteristics often differ among individuals. One coyote might be smallish with finer limbs and facial features; another could be larger with heavier bones and a broad skull. The latter can trick people into "crying wolf," although they are actually seeing an eastern coyote with more wolf genes. While hybridization often creates sterile offspring (i.e. mules), eastern coyotes are an evolutionary success story. As humans have removed most large natural predators, wildlife biologists support the presence of coyotes as they play an important role in a healthy ecosystem's predator-prey dynamic.

MIKE'S FISH TANK CORY CATS

ORY CATS ARE A VERY popular fish. They are well suited to tropical freshwater community aquariums, as they get along well with other species and are not at all aggressive. Corydoras are quite timid and do well in groups of 2 or 3. Corys mostly hang at the bottom of the fish tank, so they should be offered sinking pellets. But, be careful, do not add too many pellets as they could pollute your tank. A fish stomache is not very big.

If flake foods are used, care should be taken to prevent all food from being eaten by faster moving fish at the higher levels of the tank. Corys will come up to eat the flakes but then go back

to the bottom to eat what other fish have missed. A lot of people think that corys clean the bottom of the tank, and they are good at finding food down there but they will not eat food that has spoiled. They will not eat the waste of other fish either.

So be careful not to overfeed as it can cause your tank to become cloudy. In order to get rid of waste or spoiled food, you must use a siphon. There is a wide range of corys, spotted, masked, big, little, they are a great addition to an aquarium.

These fish are fairly easy to keep, being peaceful, hardy, active and entertaining. Occasionally they will dart to the surface, sticking their snout above the water for an instant to take a "breath" of air. This behavior is perfectly normal and is not an indication that anything is wrong with the fish.


