RE YOU INTERESTED IN WALKING through history? The Central New York Living History Center is the place for you! Conveniently located at 4386 US Route 11 between Cortland and Homer, our three component museums offer something for everyone. We like to pride ourselves on Trucks, Trains and Tractors, but there is so much more!

The Brockway Truck Museum is devoted to the history, furniture, carriages and the trucks that were produced here in Cortland County from 1875 until 1977. These dependable, heavy-duty, diesel trucks and the history of this local company, put this area on the map as Huskietown, USA. Not to be missed, is the 1925 Buenos Aires, Argentina and its 17,000 mile venture back to Cortland.

For the train enthusiasts, The Homeville Museum will not disappoint. Model trains layouts will take you back to your childhood and the mockup of the Lackawanna RR Engine 2107 with its original lights and working bell will truly amaze. Local History and Military Memorabilia dating back to the Civil War, from the Ken Eaton Collection, round out this one of a kind museum.

Lastly, the Big Red Barn on the property, is the home of the Tractors of Yesteryears Collection. This multicolored collection of vintage tractors promises to be some of the most unique tractors that you have ever seen. In "Grandma's Kitchen and Parlor", you will find items that made up the heart of the home in years past and a special exhibit of Textiles.

Even with the pandemic, our exhibits have been updated, expanded and refreshed. While our usual line-up of events has been placed on hold, due to the Covid-19, we plan to bring events back to the CNY Living History Center when it is safe to do so. THE 1890 HOUSE MUSEUM WAS built by Chester Wickwire a local farm boy who made his fortune by introducing window screens to the United States and selling them at a very affordable price. The House represents the lavishness of the Victorian Age with its beautiful handcrafted woodworked ceilings, wall panels, magnificent front staircase and the unique Engel Nook, the space under the stairs.


The slate roof, hand laid parquet floors, front staircase are all original having stood the test of 130 years, which speaks to the quality of craftsmanship in this building. The Gold Parlor, library, dining room with its 14 foot table and handcrafted chairs, billiards room and ballroom make for a very interesting 15,000 square foot house to explore. The beauty of the House is accented

by the stainless windows throughout and the unique set of three stain glass panels designed by Tiffany and Company.

CREATURE FEATURE DRESSING FOR THE SEASON

Leaves are falling and frost is on the way...sweater weather! Time to break out our sleek boots, chunky-knit hats and cozy scarves. As autumn gives way to winter, some animals are in the process of changing their wardrobe, too.

Short-tailed weasels ('ermines') change their coats – literally! Their pretty cinnamon-brown colored summer fur gives way to dazzling white in winter, an adaptation that provides excellent camouflage in the snow. This is advantageous while hunting and helps weasels escape detection from larger predators.





White-tailed deer are shrugging off their summer coats, too. Deer actually shed, or 'molt', their hair twice a year, once in spring and again in fall. During these transition periods, they appear scruffy. By early autumn, deer are starting to lose their red-brown fur; soon, they will be dressed in thick, gray-brown coats that keep them warm while enabling them to blend in with the winter landscape.

Have you noticed the goldfinches are turning from bright lemon-yellow to a drab olive-gray? As their old summer feathers are pushed out by newly emerging plumage, these tiny year-round favorites are essentially changing into their winter clothes. Now that breeding season is over, there is no need to be flashy -- in fact, it behooves these tiny birds to remain obscure to help them survive the winter season.

MIKE'S FISH TANK POND WINTER

UTUMN IS HERE AND SOME people will be bringing Atheir pond fish inside soon.

Try to move them on a day that the water temperature in your outside pond and inside pond are within a few degrees of each other. This will avoid putting the fish under unnecessary stress. Be sure to cover the indoor tank with a net. Fish, especially Koi, will sometimes jump after a move.

If you have gravel in your pond, bring some of that in too. If no gravel, bring in any rocks that you may have in

The beneficial bacteria lives in that gravel and this will help your fish's transition from out to in. But don't rinse the gravel because this can kill the good bacteria.

If bringing pond fish inside, the bigger the tank the better as goldfish and koi produce a lot of waste.

If you decide to leave your pond fish outside, just be sure the pond deep enough so that it will not freeze through.

As long as you have open water the fish are usually ok. They make pond heaters/deicers that help keep an area of your pond from freezing. Also having a pump blowing lots of bubbles can help your pond from freezing.Lots of aeration is good.

Cold snaps that drop temperatures below freezing for extended periods can reduce the ability of deicers and aerators to keep holes in the ice for gas exchange. The depth of the outdoor pond and/or if it is an above ground pond will also impact how your pond freezes. Ponds under two and half feet deep are more at risk.

Koi are (cold-blooded) and have adapted to handle cold temperatures. Their metabolism and overall activity is dependent on the ambient water temperature. As the temperature drops, so does their appetite and movement as they settle into what is essentially a state of hibernation.

If it looks like it's going to be a cold winter and you are not sure if your pond will freeze through, then a better option might be to bring your pond fish inside especially if you have expensive koi or fish you've had a long time.

o you mountain bike? Do you have a good friend that watches you pull out the driveway as you leave for your ride? Your dog can also enjoy the fun and benefits of being in the woods and on trails as well. Dogs have a lot of energy and require exercise just like you or I. Depending on the type of dog you have will determine the extent of running he can do. Most medium to large size dogs from the hunting or working class groups (or a combination thereof) do well with biking. Obviously a little dog with short legs will have a tough time trying to keep up. If you have a four legged buddy you want to take out on the trail for the first time it would be a good idea to talk to your dog's veterinarian about what you have in mind for him. It is important that your dog can deal with the rigors and intensity of a trail run. Mountain bikes can move right along at a good pace and cover many trail miles. If the dog is just a puppy, it's recommended to leave him home until he is at least 6 months old. After he has gotten a little older,

start your first slow and short ride someplace where you can work out the little details. Dogs are instinctively pack animals and if you lead they will follow. Since he will be off the leash for the ride/run he needs to know a few important commands. The most important ones are "stay" and "come". Control of Fido is very important because of all the distractions on the trail. Distractions come in many forms, such as other people and possibly their dogs, horses, deer and vehicles. If you start your ride from a spot near a busy road, it might be a good idea to keep him on a leash until you are ready to leave for the ride.

I have found another good way to break him in is to take him on a group ride with other well behaved dogs. He will most likely be so excited to be in the woods, around you and the other dogs that he will follow without question; again it's the pack idea. Before you hit the trail you should have a checklist for Fido. Your list should include a water bottle just for him, a leash, and some first aid supplies and maybe some treats to lure him back when he strays (a little piece of a peanut butter Clif bar is our dog's favorite). So, you and dog are headed down the trail, now what? Well you'll find that while you are following some kind of trail, your 4-legged buddy will be running from one side of the trail to the other, smelling all those scents that drive a dog nuts. Some dogs can put on half again as many miles as the rider, so keep that in mind when watching your mileage because he will have more. Most dogs will want to be out front, but because of their sniffing, they may lag for a few seconds and then come charging up thru. It's important for you to hold your line, because that is what the dog is expecting. A few things that the new trail dog must learn and that is to stay away from the bike's front wheel or even stopping in the middle of the trail, not good. Usually if you shout "Go!" works, but sometimes a collision happens. Both you and the dog need to be alert and aware of what is going on. Sometimes a friendly low speed bump from your front wheel to the dog's rump or tail can quickly bring this point clear. A few applications of this can burn it into his mind An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure.

There are some young dogs that have so much energy or get so excited when they get out on the trail that controlling them can be a real handful if not nearly impossible. You need to evaluate the excitable boy or in our case, Lula Belle. She came to us as a beautiful 2 1/2 year old rescue that needed more room to run and was well trained with an E collar. We have had great luck with our last two trail huskies but this one needs more attention before I felt comfortable with her just running free. The last thing I want is for her to take off and end up lost. Many people have had good luck with training collars for dogs "off leash" in the woods. Some people don't like them but a correction for unwanted behavior and when done properly they can keep the dog with you, safe and sound. With something like this it requires time and work but it may be the best way to train a stubborn dog. All E collars have a "beeping" option which is the desired end result form of correction. Discussing training collars would require more space then I have here and there is good info on the internet. SPORTDOG.COM is a good place to start.

Mountain biking with your dog can be a challenge, but patience and time will make it worth the effort. Just remember, that it will be difficult to pull out the driveway without taking your riding buddy along. If you are a cross country skier, this same kind of fun can continue when the
