

LTA'S ORNAMENTATION IS A MEMBER of the Greater Ithaca Art Trail and my home studio will be open from 11 am to 4 pm on Saturday June 1 at 96 Lake Road in Dryden. It is a part of the Community Arts Program which is now in its 22nd year. You'll see my white tent on my driveway with jewelry, mobiles and chimes for sale. Visitors must wear masks and maintain social distancing. All open artists have signed an agreement agreeing to wearing masks at all times, maintain 6 foot distancing, clean surfaces frequently, limit the number of people inside a space, and provide hand sanitizer. I bought a few pieces of mismatch silver plate flatware in 2016 at a garage sale. It sat for a year before I investigated what I could make from it. I made a simple fish mobile and a teapot wind chime. Now, I create over 20 wicked and whimsical sea creatures from spoons, forks, butter knives, and serving pieces using the basic tools I "borrowed" from my husband. My creatures include whale, shark, pufferfish, proboscis fish, sea snakes, squid. manta ray, a variety of tropical fish and species yet to be discovered. I'm careful to cut each mouth differently, hand etch the fins, gills and stripes, design different tails for different species, and make each as detailed as possible. My latest, greatest piece is my Fish Chandelier with tea light candles. Everybody needs one of these, right?

I developed my skills and remember my grandmother telling "Practice makes perfect"! I made basic pendants, then fork tine earrings, then bracelets and rings. Now I can create jewelry faster and it's high quality with great prices. I'm always shopping for flatware at the very best price. I want people to have something really nice at a great bargain. It makes them happy and gives me great joy. I can make any size bracelet, anklet or ring. Custom orders are not a problem.



CREATURE FEATURE LEAD TOXICITY IN BIRDS

DID YOU KNOW THAT INGESTING one small lead sinker can kill an adult loon? When loons, bald eagles, swans and other birds swallow lead, it breaks down and releases toxins into their bloodstream leading to organ failure and death. Lead toxicity is responsible for the deaths of millions of birds each year. It is especially deadly in loons and eagles, which rarely survive even with veterinary intervention (such as the eagle shown here); and yet, lead tackle and lead ammunition continue to collect in the environment.

How do birds wind up ingesting lead? Birds swallow grit to help digest food but can't discern between pebbles and lead pellets. Loons and eagles ingest lead when they eat living or dead fish with broken/cut fishing line and tackle attached. Dabbling waterfowl ingest lead in the shallows or in flooded fields, where entire flocks have been poisoned by lead-contaminated water. Hawks and other raptors ingest lead after eating dead, unrecovered game animals or from gut piles.

Isn't lead illegal? NY State laws regulating lead use in fishing, hunting and Skeet shooting are inadequate; some types of lead tackle and ammunition are illegal, while others are still permitted.

How can we help? STOP USING LEAD TODAY and spread the word about its deadly impact. There are lead-free options available to sports enthusiasts – environmentally-safe, non-toxic products made from steel, copper and tungsten-nickel-iron blends. They cost more, but isn't the health of our wildlife and natural resources priceless?

CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

In the last issue of the CAT, we asked if you could name both rivers which run through Cortland County. The Tioughnioga and the Otselic are the two rivers in Cortland County. Both rivers retain the names given by the indigenous peoples of this area. According to Bertha Blodgett's Stories of Cortland County, Tioughnioga means "waters with flowers hanging over their banks," and Otselic means "wild plums." According to Aboriginal Place Names of New York by William M. Beauchamp, Tioughnioga means "meeting of waters." Otselic has been translated as "capful" and also "plum creek."

Traveling by waterways was an important part of life for both indigenous peoples and for the early white settlers who came to this area after the American Revolution. Thick forests made land travel arduous, but rivers provided an easier way to navigate the area. Goods like potash and whiskey were taken on arks made of logs to ports south of here. After landing at their destination, the arks were taken apart and the logs sold for lumber!

SUNY Cortland is an important part of our community. It was not always located "on the hill." It started out at the Cortland Normal School. Do you know where the Cortland Normal School was originally located?

TOBACCO FREE ZONE PROGRAM URGES PUBLIC TO TAKE ACTION AGAINST UNJUST MARKETING & PROMOTION OF MENTHOL CIGARETTES

New statewide "It's Not Just" campaign aimed at hard-hitting menthol marketing targeting Black communities

NEW STATEWIDE INITIATIVE AIMS to put a spotlight on how the tobacco industry has specifically targeted African American communities for decades with its aggressive marketing of menthol products.^{1,2} The "It's Not Just" campaign launches regionally and statewide on No Menthol Sunday, May 16, and is focused on ending the misconception that menthol is just a flavor. It's not just an injustice, it's killing Black Americans.

Smoking-related illnesses are the No. 1 cause of death in the African American community, surpassing all other causes of death, including AIDS, homicide, diabetes and accidents.^{3,4,5} Overall, 85% of African American smokers use menthol cigarettes, compared to 29% of white smokers.^{3,6}

The "It's Not Just" campaign is intended to educate people across New York State about the injustice of menthol product marketing and promotion. The campaign uses direct language and powerful, emotional imagery of people who represent communities targeted by Big Tobacco. It describes how menthol is more than a flavor, highlighting hard-hitting facts about the manipulative, aggressive nature of menthol tobacco marketing and its impact on African American communities.

"The industry strategically and aggressively targeted the Black community with menthol cigarettes for decades. Menthol masks tobacco's harsh taste, making it easier to start and harder to quit," said Jennifer Hamilton, coordinator of the Cortland County Health Department's Tobacco Free Zone program. "It's sickening how we've allowed Big Tobacco to target various groups like African Americans, the LGBTQ community, and youth all this

"With the recent FDA announcement to ban menthol, this campaign couldn't be more timely and relevant," said LaTroya Hester, director of communications, The Center for Black Health & Equity. "We know that the tobacco industry will fight this decision with the full force of its legal and marketing power, but we're not intimidated. The Center is excited about the launch of this campaign, and we are so honored to contribute to muchneeded counter-messaging."

While the tobacco industry has traditionally targeted Black communities with the marketing of menthol products, menthol is also a driver of youth initiation.^{7,8} When New York State ended the sale of flavored e-cigarettes statewide in May 2020, it was a significant step toward reducing youth tobacco use. However, other flavored tobacco products, such as menthol cigarettes, continue to present an obstacle to decreasing tobacco use among young people and underserved populations.

Additional statistics:

Menthol marketing

- Menthol use among Black communities is a direct result of the tobacco industry's marketing practices and product
- Historically, the marketing and promotion of menthol cigarettes have been targeted heavily toward African Americans through culturally tailored advertising and
- Menthol products are given more shelf space in retail outlets within African American and other minority
- In addition to being heavily advertised and widely available, certain tobacco products have been found to be priced lower in African American communities, making them more appealing, particularly to price-sensitive youth. 12,13,14

Menthol usage

- Ninety-three percent of Black smokers started by using menthol cigarettes.15,16
- Over 7 out of 10 African American youth ages 12-17 years who smoke use menthol cigarettes.^{1,17}
- Research indicates that menthol makes smoking easier to start and harder to quit. 18,19
- $To bacco\ companies\ add\ menthol\ to\ make\ cigarettes\ seem\ less$ harsh and more appealing to new smokers and young people. 15
- Tobacco companies market menthol cigarettes as "smoother" than other cigarettes.2,15
- Menthol in cigarettes creates a cooling sensation in the throat and airways when the user inhales.2,9,15

Health impact

- Menthol cigarettes are not less harmful than other cigarettes and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration has found that they are likely a greater risk to public health than nonmenthol cigarettes.2,15
- Black smokers smoke less but die of heart attacks, strokes and other causes linked to tobacco use at higher rates than white smokers.1,20-24

For help quitting smoking or vaping, including free nicotine replacement therapy for eligible

residents, individuals can contact a health care provider, and call the New York State Smokers' Quitline at 1-866-NY-QUITS or visit: nysmokefree.com. Effective medications and counseling are covered by Medicaid and most insurance programs.

Tobacco Free New York State and Reality Check student groups around the state have worked tirelessly to educate local communities on the tobacco industry's use of menthol and other flavored tobacco products as a tool to target, attract and addict new smokers. Tobacco Free New York State, including the Reality Check student youth groups, is part of the NYS Tobacco Control Program.



MIKE'S FISH TANK TANK TIPS

Some helpful hints for your tank.

Feed your fish small amounts at least 3 times a day. Fish burn a lot of calories swimming. They need food.

Keep your temperature at 78 to 79 degrees for tropicals, no heat on goldfish tanks.

Only float your bag of fish for 4 to 5 minutes, that's all it takes to equalize the temperature.

After buying fish, take them right home and put them away. The sooner they get into your tank, the better.

Don't mix tropicals and goldfish, it's a bad idea because the temperatures are different.

Only get an algae eater when you see algae. They make algae tablets but they don't always like them.

Also algae eaters are tropical so they might not do good in a cooler goldfish tank.

Do A water change using a siphon to drain off 20 percent of the water monthly. Always drain from the bottom where food and waste settle.

A lot of times people call cory catfish bottom feeders. Nothing eats the waste or decaying food off the bottom. They are only called bottom feeders because they hang at the bottom. They really should be called bottom dwellers.

The bigger the tank, the better your fish will do. Any tank under 5 gallons will always have more problems then a 10 gallon tank and up.

1, 2 and 3 gallon tanks are very hard on fish. They are most suited for a betta fish.




