CREATURE FEATURE OH DEER!

ANY OF US HAVE HAD harrowing encounters with wildlife on the road, with most drivers reporting at least one close call behind the wheel. Along with squirrels, rabbits, raccoons, woodchucks and even low-flying birds of prey, deer are among the most commonly encountered animals on our roads and highways. They are also one of those most often hit. Unfortunately, car collisions with deer can be both costly and dangerous

Although accidents involving deer spike during the fall mating season when the animals are on the move, they occur year round. In springtime, grass and clover are greening up along road edges, and deer relish the tender, new growth. During summer, roadside mowing encourages more new vegetation growth, which continues to attract deer. They also come to the roadways in winter to lick the salt used to manage ice. So we inadvertently lure deer to our roads all year long, increasing the chances of potentially dangerous encounters for motorists.

To help prevent an accident on the road, be aware of deer activity warning signs, and slow down during dawn, dusk and evening hours when they are most active. Know that where there is one deer, there are often others. Drive defensively, anticipating "what if" situations, and avoid swerving, which can result in a serious crash.



Chase was a pilot in WWII, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War. At the end of his tour in Vietnam, he had completed 512 combat missions in his career, quite an accomplishment. Levi R. Chase Day was held in Cortland on November 19, 1966 with a parade and a reception at the armory. A dinner at St. Mary's school cafeteria followed. Chase and his wife Jean retired to Florida in 1985 and visited home every summer until his death in 1994.

Dress reform was a hot topic in the mid-1800s, and a Cortland County native was an important figure in the debate over a woman's right to wear pants instead of skirts. A new "costume" came into fashion that included a short dress (which fell below the knee) that was worn over a pair of loosely fitted pants. The look was quite feminine, and the pants were barely noticeable, but the ensemble created a commotion in society. Do you know who the "bloomers" were named after?



MIKE'S FISH TANK DWARF GOURAMIS

This issue we'll discuss the dwarf gourami. Most dwarf gourami live for about 4 years, but with proper care can live longer. Dwarf gouramis are peaceful fish and do well in most community aquariums. They require a tank of at least 10 gallons. They are usually found swimming in the middle to top regions of the aquaria. This is not a surprise since, like all gouramis, the dwarf is a labyrinth fish. That is, dwarf gouramis can breathe oxygen from the air through their labyrinth organ {like a betta} if necessary. It is important, therefore, that the surface of the water be exposed to fresh air. Dwarf gouramis are so docile that they will allow themselves to be bullied to death before fighting back.

Despite their shy, and docile nature they are aggressive towards fellow dwarf gourami. Each fish tends to establish a territory, and hiding places are a must. Loud noises often scare them, so the tank should be in a quiet area. Regular water changes are necessary, as this gourami can be susceptible to disease. The dwarf gourami is tolerant of fairly high temperatures. A temp of low 80's is easily tolerated.

The dwarf is an omnivore that prefers both algae-based foods and meaty foods. Feed them a vegetable flake, along with freeze dried bloodworms, tubifex, and brine shrimp for a balanced diet

Breeders have created different color variations, varying the red/blue colouring. The flame red is mostly red with a strip of bright blue at the top. The neon red is mostly a solid orange, the neon or powder blue is a pale sky blue and the rainbow is about a 50/50 mix of red and blue. They are all beautiful and they are all male as the female does not exhibit the colors that the males do.

 $T^{\rm N}$ the last issue we asked if you knew who the bloomers were named after? Did you guess Amelia Jenks Bloomer? Amelia was born in Homer and lived there until she was about six years old. Her family moved to Seneca Falls, NY and that is where she met many of the women who would be instrumental in the women's rights movement. As a matter of fact, it was Amelia Bloomer who introduced Elizabeth Cady Stanton and Susan B. Anthony. Seneca Falls is where Bloomer first saw Elizabeth Smith Miller wearing an outfit that included pants worn beneath a short, below the knee skirt. Bloomer adopted the look and popularized it in her newspaper (believed to be the first owned and operated by a woman). The ensemble was widely ridiculed, and the name "bloomer costume" became attached to the new look. Bloomer is often credited with inventing the bloomers, but she did not.






