

ULLHEADS AVERAGE BETWEEN 8-14" LONG with elongated bodies Dand smooth, slippery skin. They range in color from ochrebrown to blue-black along their backs and sides with pale bellies. Squared-off tails help distinguish them from channel catfish, which have deeply-forked tails.

Bullheads have sensitive whiskers, called 'barbels', around their mouths. The barbels can't hurt you; but getting stuck by sharp spines located on the pectoral and dorsal fins can sting for hours after an irritating, but otherwise harmless toxin, gets released.

Most active at night, bullheads forage on or near the lake bottom for plants, algae, insects, worms, mollusks, crustaceans, crayfish, small fish and fish eggs. They have poor vision, relying instead on sensory adaptations to find food. Their whiskers, mouths and bodies are packed with thousands of taste buds, and they have a heightened sense of smell. Bullheads also use these extraordinary senses to communicate with one another.

Research suggests that bullheads are monogamous during each May-June breeding season. Males are the primary caregivers, guarding the eggs and young until they're around 1" long. The babies linger in the shallows, swimming in a compact ball.

Larger bullheads sometimes avoid being eaten thanks to their sharp spines, but smaller ones are taken by several wild predators. Meanwhile, anglers catch bullheads from shore at night using earthworms, doughballs or stinkbaits fished off the bottom.

and management and general advice about keeping healthy during travel. Information on COVID-19 test documentation needed to re-enter the U.S. is also provided, and Dr. MacQueen strongly encourages everyone considering international travel to have completed their COVID-19 vaccination.

"When we see patients planning to travel to certain areas, we first review their vaccination history to see if they are up-to-date on routine immunizations for diseases like tetanus diphtheria, flu, and of course COVID-19. Then, we'll check several sources such as the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the World Health Organization, and consulates to see what vaccines are recommended for the countries on their trip schedule," MacQueen says, who opened the Travel Clinic in 2018.

The team can provide individualized services to travelers 16 or older, those with special travel health needs, immunocompromised travelers, pregnant travelers, those preparing to work or live overseas for prolonged periods, and business and adventure travelers.

Among the more common immunizations travelers may need are vaccines for: hepatitis, typhoid (in oral and injectable doses), Japanese encephalitis for travel to south and east Asia, and rabies for travelers who expect to work with animals. The Clinic prescribes oral medications to prevent malaria. Yellow fever vaccine that had been in short supply is now available at

"We also advise travelers on preventing diseases transmitted by mosquitoes and other insects, such as malaria, dengue fever, and Japanese encephalitis and avoiding insect bites," MacQueen says.

Common concerns such as prevention and treatment of traveler's diarrhea and travel-related health problems such as traffic accidents, altitude illness, motion sickness, and jet lag are also reviewed.

"Special care for those traveling during pregnancy, healthy travel for individuals with chronic diseases such as diabetes or immunosuppressive disorders, and health topics for longterm travelers including adjustment issues, tuberculosis testing, and healthcare options abroad are also discussed," MacQueen says.

Most health insurance plans do not cover the cost of the appointment or vaccinations at the Travel Clinic. Patients can expect an out-of-pocket expense of about \$300 for an office visit and routine travel vaccines. The fee can be higher depending on the number and types of vaccines a patient

When travelers return home, the Clinic also provides diagnosis and treatment of health problems related to a trip such as acute and chronic diarrhea, skin diseases, and parasitic diseases including malaria, schistosomiasis, filarial diseases, and Chagas disease.

Getting an appointment

The Travel Clinic schedules most appointments within a few days after a patient calls the office. Patients should bring a list of their current prescriptions, medical and vaccine history, and travel plans to an office appointment. For details, call (607) 241-1118.



We posted the dog on our page and while the owner was found and positively identified in a matter of a few hours, it was not before the finder received a handful of calls from other people professing to be the dog's owner. One caller even claimed to be the neighbor of the owner but when questioned, couldn't give simple identifying information.

But there are lessons here, and ones that we need your help in sharing far and wide. People with bad intentions for our beloved pets are watching our page and others like it. They also ride the roads looking for pets that aren't secured or being monitored. They are attempting to steal dogs or claim dogs that are not theirs and the reasons why are all bad; dog fighting, selling to labs for testing, adding to their hoarding collection, flipping...it's an endless and terrifying list.

What can you, as the finder or owner, do? First and most importantly (as we've always preached) call your local Dog Control Officer (DCO) and file a lost or found report. Calling your DCO is not optional - it is a legal requirement. This report helps you and helps your dog. It creates a legal paper trail that will help to identify your dog when found or will help to prosecute someone who may have found your dog....and kept them.

Second, this is for you the finder, when an individual calls or arrives to claim ownership, insist on proof. Ask for vet records, licensing documentation, or even photos. If the individual claiming ownership cannot show proof, call your local police department or DCO right away and let them sort it out.

Third, and this is for you the owner, make sure your dog is licensed and wearing their tags. This registration is required by law and serves as proof of ownership and is a vital link to getting your dog safely home should they ever become lost.

What can we, as a community, do? We can educate about the role of our DCOs and the importance of licensing. We can make sure that we're aware of the dangers out there for these dogs and protect them with everything we do. Thank you to all who share our posts...you've saved countless lives.



GOULASH STUFFED PEPPERS

Make your favorite Goulash, or.,

In a large saute/frying pan

- 2 Tablespoons Butter
- 2 Tablespoons Olive Oil
- 1 c. diced peppers,
- 1 c diced onions
- 1 c. roasted red peppers chopped
- 1/2 c. sundried tomatoes

Saute until onions are translucent and a little browned.

Add Garlic saute for 1 or 2 minutes.

Add 3 - 4 c. of your favorite Marinara. I use my Homemade or Barilla in

Simmer for about 30 minutes

While simmering cook 2 c. of pasta about half way, drain and set to one side. Do not rinse.. (I use Barilla elbows) (it will cook more in the stock

Clean and Half 3 large red peppers. Pat them dry

When the sauce is done, add some of the sauce to the pasta.

Cover pan with foil and bake at 400 for about 30 minutes,

Put some of the sauce into the bottom of a 9X13 pan (just cover the bottom)

Fill each of the halved peppers with the goulash and set down into the pan.

Reserve the rest of the sauce to ladle over the pepper when you serve them.

Remove the foil

You can now top with your favorite shredded cheeses. (I use mozz, parm, x-sharp cheddar mixture.

CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY **HISTORICAL SOCIETY**

O YOU KNOW WHAT THOMAS Jefferson, sheep farming, and Cortland have in common? The answer is Cortland native, Henry Stephens Randall.

Henry Stephens Randall was the son of Roswell Randall, one of Cortland's earliest white settlers, and he is well known as THE biographer of Thomas Jefferson. Henry Randall was looking for a project, and a biography of Jefferson came as a suggestion from a new publishing company, Derby and Jackson. Randall thought that he might be able to complete a one volume biography on Jefferson in a year, but when he met with Jefferson descendants and was given full access to a treasure trove of previously unknown papers of Jefferson's, his plans shifted. It took Randall eight years to complete the three-volume biography. For 158 years, Henry Stephens Randall's biography of United States President Thomas Jefferson was the authoritative work on his life. Even today, it is unparalleled in its scope. Henry Stephens Randall's home $was\,18\,Tompkins\,Street, the\,cute\,little\,house\,on\,the\,right\,of\,the$ Fun fact: a huge collection of Thomas Jefferson's personal papers and more was in Cortland for the duration of time Randall spent writing the biography.

Henry Randall was far more than Jefferson's biographer. He was an attorney who had political aspirations, and he served as the Secretary of State of New York for one term. He was a sheep farmer who wrote popular columns on sheep husbandry as well as three important books on sheep farming. Fun fact: a young Francis Bicknell Carpenter created the artwork for Randall's 1848 "Sheep Husbandry in the South." In 1838, Randall was a founding member of the Cortland County Agricultural Society. He served as the superintendent of common schools of Cortland County for four years and was president of the Local Board of Managers for Cortland Normal School for almost a decade. Henry Randall was an important contributor to not only life in Cortland County, but also New York State and the United States.
