CREATURE FEATURELIFEGIVING TREES

TREES SUPPORT COUNTLESS LIVING THINGS. They offer food, shelter, nests, nurseries, and hibernation nooks. Throughout their life, dying and death, trees play a vital role in the survival of diverse flora and fauna.

Trees set a year-round table for wildlife. Buds, catkins, seeds and sap are reliable food sources in spring; cherries, berries and other fruits nourish in summer; some tree species bear late-summer-through-fall seeds, nuts, fruits and pinecones; and other trees produce fall fruits that persist through winter into early spring.

Whether for food or due to their life habits, many animals depend on trees including mice, chipmunks, squirrels, rabbits, skunks, fishers, beavers, foxes, coyotes, deer, bears, grouse, turkeys, waterfowl, raptors, songbirds, frogs and salamanders. Myriad insects depend on trees, too, including valuable pollinators like bees. The birch itself hosts over 400 species of butterflies and moths.

Trees also offer refuge, when animals seek shelter, shade or windbreaks. Large "babysitter trees" help protect bear cubs. Cavities in trees provide homes and nests for owls, woodpeckers, chickadees, wood ducks, porcupines, raccoons, flying squirrels, bats, tree frogs, rat snakes, beetles and spiders... even certain plants and fungi grow in tree hollows.

As their life fades, trees remain important to wildlife. Standing dead or dying trees (called snags) attract species that might not otherwise settle there, those seeking homes, safety, and places to raise families, hunt or store food. Decaying trees retain moisture which supports amphibians and insects, and young trees often sprout from a fallen "nurse log." Toppled trees along waterfronts add valuable woody debris benefiting fish, turtles, dragonflies, native plants and other members of the aquatic community, while helping prevent shoreline erosion.

Fallen trees also provide ground cover which protects emerging seedlings. As insects, fungi and bacteria break down decaying wood, the surrounding soil is enriched with reabsorbed nutrients, supporting both new and existing plant growth. So that even in death, trees give life.

DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME ENDS

TIME WILL FALL BACK TO standard time again on Sunday. November 7 at 2am, when daylight saving time ends. History of Daylight Time in the U.S. Although standard time in time zones was instituted in the U.S. and Canada by the railroads in 1883, it was not established in U.S. law until the Act of March 19, 1918, sometimes called the Standard Time Act. The act also established daylight saving time, a contentious idea then. Daylight saving time was repealed in 1919, but standard time in time zones remained in law. Daylight time became a local matter. It was re-established nationally early in World War II, and was continuously observed from 9 February 1942 to 30 September 1945. After the war its use varied among states and localities. The Uniform Time Act of 1966 provided standardization in the dates of beginning and end of daylight time in the U.S. but allowed for local exemptions from its observance. The act provided that daylight time begin on the last Sunday in April and end on the last Sunday in October, with the changeover to occur at 2 a.m. local time. During the "energy crisis" years, Congress enacted earlier starting dates for daylight time. In 1974, daylight time began on 6 January and in 1975 it began on 23 February. After those two years the starting date reverted back to the last Sunday in April. In 1986, a law was passed that shifted the starting date of daylight time to the first Sunday in April, beginning in 1987. The ending date of daylight time was not subject to such changes, and remained the last Sunday in October. The Energy Policy Act of 2005 changed both the starting and ending dates. Beginning in 2007, daylight time started on the second Sunday in March and ends on the first Sunday in November.

T'S THAT TIME OF YEAR when people start thinking about $oldsymbol{oldsymbol{L}}$ bringing their pond fish inside.Some people start as early as september, but some people are doing it now.

Remember, goldfish can stay out in the ponds all year as long as the water doesn't freeze solid.

Of course around here, you never know because we can get a really cold winter. However if you want to leave them out in the pond all winter, thyere are a couple things you can do.

The first is a pond heater. It floats in the pond and keeps at least one area free from ice so that the fish don't freeze. Another is to have a pump blowing bubbles in the pond. That will prevent the water from freezing solid.

If you do bring your pond fish in, try to set up the tank a few weeks ahead of time and put a couple of small goldfish into the tank to get the beneficial bacteria going. If you bring in a whole bunch of pond fish and add them to your tank all at once, you could be facing a massive die off.

The good bacteria actually eats the urine the fish produce. So it is very important to have that.

After the bacteria grows, the rule of thumb is one inch of fish per gallon of water. Also be sure to have a good power filter and an air pump with airstone blowing lots of bubbles into the tank. Lots of bubbles is a very good thing. Feed your goldfish a good quality food and feed them small amounts but several times a day. The fish farms recommend feeding 3 to 4 times a day, but remember SMALL amounts.
