

MIKE'S FISH TANK GUPPIES

Guyana, Jamaica, The Netherlands, Trinidad and Tobago, the U.S. Virgin Islands and Venezuela. However guppies have been introduced to many countries on all continents, except Antarctica. Sometimes this has occurred accidentally, but most often as a means of mosquito control, the hope being that guppies would eat the mosquito larvae, slowing the spread of malaria. While wild type females are grey in body color, males

have splashes, spots, or stripes that can be any of a wide variety of colors.

Guppies are highly prolific livebearers. The gestation period of a guppy is 21-30 days, with an average of 28 days, varying according to water temperatures. After the female guppy is inseminated, the dark area near the anus, known as the gravid spot, will enlarge and darken.

Just before birth, the eyes of fry may be seen through the translucent skin in this area of the female's body. When birth occurs, individual offspring are dropped in sequence over the course of an hour or so. Guppies prefer water temperatures of about 68-81 degrees for reproduction. The female guppy has drops of between 2 and 50 fry at a time, typically ranging between 5 and 30. After giving birth, the female is ready for conception again within only a few hours. Guppies have the ability to store sperm up to a year, so the female can give birth many times without depending on the presence of a male. From the moment of birth, each fry is fully capable of swimming, eating, and avoiding danger. If not kept separate, the older, mature guppies will eat the fry, so the use of a breeder box, net breeder, or a separate tank is recommended. Live or fake plants can be used as hiding places for the fry.

The highlight of the Cortland Country Music Park is the NYS Country Music Hall of Fame with an array of memorabilia from many Nashville and local entertainers.





CREATURE FEATURE KEYS TO THE KINGDOM: BEAVERS

In ancient times, Roman architects designed arches $ldsymbol{\perp}$ by stacking square stones on top of one another, leaning inward. A keystone was placed at the top of the arch to dissipate the weight from all those below. Removing the keystone caused the entire arch to collapse.

In much the same way, a "keystone species" functions within an ecosystem by playing a role no other species can perform. When a keystone species declines or is removed, it can result in the collapse of an entire ecosystem. One such valuable keystone species is the

In a relatively short period of time, industrious beavers transform moving streams into ponds, creating surrounding wetlands that provide habitat and breeding places for multitudes of species. Without beavers, this process would take decades or possibly centuries to occur. The altered landscape creates a complex eco-web. Flooded, decaying trees provide food and nesting opportunities for various woodpeckers, nest cavities for wood ducks, rookery sites for herons and look-out perches for ospreys, owls and kingfishers. Waterfowl, muskrats, mink and otters move in, as well as turtles, snakes, frogs, dragonflies and damselflies. Songbirds feed on the explosion of insects. The growth of new aquatic plants and meadow grasses invites voles, rabbits, and deer to browse, which in turn attracts species like hawks, foxes, fishers and coyotes.

By creating diverse, vibrant ecosystems, beavers truly hold keys to the natural kingdom.

Are you interested in Walking through history? The Central New York Living History Center is the place for you! Conveniently located at 4386 US Route 11 between Cortland and Homer, our three component museum offers something for everyone. We like to pride ourselves on Trucks, Trains and Tractors, but there is so much more!

The Brockway Truck Museum is devoted to the history, furniture, carriages and the trucks that were produced here in Cortland County from 1875 until 1977. These dependable, heavy-duty, diesel trucks and the history of this local company, put this area on the map as Huskietown, USA. The museum features a rotating collection of trucks owned by the Brockway Truck Preservation Association. Not to be missed, is the 1925 Brockway Fire Truck from Buenos Aires, Argentina.

For the train enthusiasts, The Homeville Museum will not disappoint. Model trains layouts will take you back to your childhood and the life-size display of the Lackawanna RR 2107 Engine with its original lights and working bell will truly amaze. Also featured

in this unique museum is an extensive collection of Military Memorabilia dating back to the Civil War and as far forward as the modern day conflicts. For those interested in local history, information on the industries and sports from this area are on display. The majority of items in the Homeville Museum are from the private collection of the late Ken Eaton, a WWII Veteran and Civil War enthusiast.

Lastly, the Big Red Barn on the property, is the home of the Tractors of Yesteryears Collection. multi-colored collection of vintage tractors and behinds, promises to be some of the most unique tractors that you have ever seen. In "Grandma's Kitchen and Parlor", you will find items that made up the heart of the home in years past. This year's special exhibit features all types of Textiles, including linens, clothing and more.
