



TARTAN ACRES FARM

ALPACAS, OFTEN THOUGHT OF AS the "cuddly" livestock, are Anonetheless an interesting creature. Part of the camelid family, they originated in the South American Andes. They are related to llamas, a larger version, used as pack animals while the smaller alpaca is valued for its soft wool. There are two breeds of alpacas: the Huacaya and the Suri. The difference being the length and fineness of their wool/fiber. The suri wears a coat of long fibers, described as 'silky dreadlocks'; the huacaya's coat is more compact, 'crimpy' and shorter.

Alpacas are very social animals, quite gentle and very curious. They can never be kept as a lone animal, preferring to live in a herd of at least three. Like any livestock animal they each have their own temperament depending on how they are handled from a young age. With much handling they can become pets to the person who takes the time to be with and train them.

FAQ

- <u>Do they spit?</u> Spitting is a defensive action taken when they are stressed, arguing with one another or feel in danger. So, yes, it does happen and you don't want to be in the middle of an argument!
- <u>What do they sound like?</u> Alpacas make a calm humming noise when all is right

with the world. They can shriek when they suspect a potential predator is near sending up what we call a warning cry. Males can get into arguments and, in addition to spitting, will scream at each other.

- What do they eat? During the summer, they munch on grass in their pasture and in the winter we provide hay. Year round they receive pelleted grain and a mineral block. Basically, they eat 1.5 percent of their body weight about 2 pounds per day.
- <u>How long do they live?</u> We are finding they live between 17 21 years in the States.
- <u>Are they easy to care for</u>? Absolutely!! Surprisingly they have a communal dung pile they all use for a 'bathroom' area. Otherwise,







once every 4 weeks they receive a shot to ward off parasites.

- <u>How long is their gestation period?</u> 11 months. Once that 15-20 lb. baby (cria) is born it is up on its feet and feeding within an hour.
- What colors can they be? Alpaca coloring has been divided into 22 different colors from very black to browns, tans and brilliant white. The fiber is prized for yarn and knits up wonderfully. Each fiber is hollow, providing excellent insulation properties while not retaining water.

Here at Tartan Acres Farm we currently house 73 alpacas. We started raising them in 2001 and have learned much over the years. In addition to raising and breeding alpacas, we have a gift shop filled with products made from their luxurious fiber including socks, scarves, gloves, mittens, hats, blankets, sweaters and a number of crafted items.

CREATURE FEATURE FOX FRIENDSHIPS

OMETIMES, ANIMALS SURPRISE US WHEN they exhibit behaviors Devond what we would call typical. Take, for example, interspecies friendships: when a bond is formed between different kinds of animals. This is a common enough occurrence between dogs, cats and other domestic animals; but what about the unusual, unexpected friendships that develop where one or both of the pals are wild critters?

Wild foxes have been known to form quirky friendships with other animals, perhaps, in part, due to their playful and inquisitive nature. Foxes have been observed initiating play and cavorting merrily with dogs (as well as "borrowing" their toys). Some people are surprised to learn that foxes may also pal around with house cats. Some of these friendships last for years, until one companion dies - revealing that animals-just like us-are capable of forming lasting, meaningful bonds.

I recently watched an amusing video of a red fox and a fisher engaged in a lengthy, playful game of animal "tag." Another account shared a series of trail camera images showing a large buck and a fox side by side and more of the same deer licking the fox's face. The fox appeared to be enjoying it!





YPOSTOMUS PLECOSTOMUS (KNOWN AS A sucker fish) is the \square scientific name for a type of freshwater tropical Central and South American fish belonging to the family Loricariidae. They are large algae eaters, and to differentiate them from small algae eaters, they are often referred to as plecostomus, often abbreviated as plecos or plecs.

They are extremely popular in aquariums for their ability to clean tanks by eating algae growth and will eat dead fish. These friendly-natured fish can typically be purchased when about (2 inch) and often grow up to (24 in). Such larger specimens are impractical for any but the largest aquariums.


Plecos are omnivorous, but in the wild feed nocturnally mostly on plant material. During the day, their unusual eyelids block a lot of light out of their eyes, but they are usually open at night. They can roll their eyes within their sockets, giving the appearance of winking. Plecos are usually skittish and quickly hide whenever they sense danger. They live in tropical freshwater and have been found in tropical ponds in Indonesia, as well as throughout South America. Plecos are omnivores. In planted aquariums, they will eat naturally growing algae in the tank.

In tanks without live plants, their diets can be supplemented with sinking fish food, usually algae wafers readily available from a pet store.

Although the plecostomus is a known common algae sucker, it requires more than just pellets and tank algae. It should also be fed algae wafers, zucchini, cucumber, lettuce, and peas. They also may eat shrimp, shrimp pellets, and flake fish food.

Plecos may become more aggressive with age and are best kept individually in tanks. Plecostomus catfish are some of the most commonly kept algae-eating catfish, and are also some of the largest. Their growth may become stunted in a smaller tank, depending on the species as some will grow 3", and some will grow 18″ or more.

The common pleco usually cost about \$4.99 to \$6.99. The more rare plecos may cost \$20.00, \$30.00, or even \$100.



CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY **HISTORICAL SOCIETY**

AST TIME, WE ASKED YOU what street in Cortland was originally named Gazlay Avenue. Hamlin Street is the correct answer, and here's the scoop.

Hamlin Street was named after United States Vice President Hannibal Hamlin. Hamlin was the vice president under Abraham Lincoln during his first term. In the 1864 election, Andrew Johnson was chosen to run as vice president. Our story could end there, but the original name of Hamlin Street was Gazlay Avenue. Why?

Dr. Henry Champion Gazlay (1818-1900) was a physician in Cortland for many years. He graduated from the Eclectic College in Syracuse and began his practice in Truxton in 1841. He moved to Fabius until 1847, returned to Truxton, and then moved to Homer in 1857. He was a partner with Dr. Ezra Loomis for some time, too. Dr. Gazlay is listed in the 1887 city directory as a physician and surgeon as well as the jail physician. He practiced medicine for 40 years, all told. Gazlay had his home and office in the Floral Avenue and Hamlin Street area.
