CREATURE FEATURE EMERALD ASH BORER BEETLES

THE FIRST INVASIVE EMERALD ASH borers (EABs) were f L discovered in Michigan in 2002, where they probably hitchhiked overseas from Asia inside wood pallets. Since then, the beetles have decimated hundreds of millions of ash trees in North America where all 16 species are vulnerable to the destructive pest. EABs lay their eggs and feed exclusively on ash trees. Infested trees usually die within 2 to 5 years. The statistics are sobering: 35 states are now infested with EABs, and ecologists hold little hope for the future survival of ash trees, at least in the short term.

Adult EABs emerge June-July. They are metallic green, with flat heads, large black eyes and short antennae. Each female lays between 60 – 90 eggs, one at a time, inside bark crevices. The larvae are cream-colored with a brown head. They chew "S" shaped tunnels under the bark before overwintering, pupating the following spring, and emerging as adults.

Sadly, native ash have no evolutionary defense against these beetles. Trees suffering from EAB infestation exhibit telltale signs of damage including yellowing/wilted foliage; "D" shaped exit holes across the bark; chipped bark; dead/dying branches; curvy patterns under the bark; and shoots emerging from branches or trunks.

Eradicating EABs remains highly unlikely, but new research offers a bit of hope for ash trees in the long term by focusing on control tactics: early detection, selective applications of insecticides, introducing wasps that target EABs, and efforts to develop genetically resistant trees are all showing promise.

Meanwhile, we place our hope in the biologists, ecologists and forestry experts racing to preserve a future for ash trees before it's too late.

A LOT OF PEOPLE ARE not familiar with the banjo catfish. They are a cool looking catfish and I try to get them in whenever they are available. The common name of the family "banjo catfishes" refers to their overall body shape, with a depressed head and slim body. Habitats ranging from shallow backwaters to deep river channels to tidal estuaries.

They spend a lot of time hiding on the bottom so be sure to have some nice hiding places for them.

Although not schooling fish, they are tolerant of their own kind and also get along with other small aquarium species.

Like most fish, they are able to swim by undulating their bodies; however, they also propel themselves by pumping water through their gill openings to skip along the substrate. Some species are able to produce sounds by moving their pectoral fin spines back and forth making a sound like a croaking frog.

If you need to net one of these banjo catfish, be sure to use a brine shrimp net. The banjos are so spiny and sharp that

they get caught in a regular net. They are excellent scavengers and are a cool looking fish.

A FAMILY TREE WITH DEEP ROOTS



A native Californian now residing in NYC, Judy has toured for the United States Information Agency throughout India, Portugal, Brazil and Singapore. In 1992 Ms. Carmichael was the first jazz musician sponsored by the United States Government to tour China. The musician that critics have referred to as "astounding, flawless and captivating" (The New York Times), she has played in a variety of venues from Carnegie Hall to

the Peggy Guggenheim Museum in Venice (the first concert ever presented by the museum) to programs with Joel Grey, Michael Feinstein, Steve Ross and the Smothers Brothers. In addition, Ms. Carmichael has done comic skits and performed her music on radio and TV and performed private recitals for everyone from Rod Stewart and Robert Redford to President Clinton and Gianni Agnelli.

Ms. Carmichael is one of a handful of musicians who approach jazz from a perspective of its entire history. She explores the music deeply, infusing it with a "fresh, dynamic

interpretation of her own" (Washington Post). She has served on a variety of music panels at the National Endowment for the Arts and is one of the few jazz pianists honored as a Steinway Artist. She has been included in a number of jazz anthologies and is listed in Who's Who in the East, Who's Who in Finance and Industry in America, Who's Who in American Woman, American Women in Jazz, Who's Who in the World, as well as the Encyclopedia of Jazz. She has been featured on National Public Radio's Morning Edition, Entertainment Tonight and multiple features on CBS' Sunday Morning.

Finnley has also provided comfort to victims during sentencings. As a teen victim and their family members sit in a court room listening to the judge list off all the terrible things that their perpetrator did to them, Finnley is in their arms being petted and whispered to. Words cannot explain the amount of support that Finnley is providing to this family during this most difficult time.

When Luna, a mini-golden doodle, arrives at our Center, she immediately makes her rounds to all the staff members. We cannot express how much staff look forward to her visits and immediately feel a sense of calmness during her visit.

Luna knows that she's here to comfort a child and makes an instant connection upon the child victim's arrival. She follows the child into the soundproof interview room and sits next to the child. The forensic interviewers have observed Luna instinctively leaning into the child as they disclose their abuse. Luna has also





been observed lying next to the forensic interviewer during an occasional tough interview.
