STATEWIDE PARTNERS KICK OFF CAMPAIGN FOCUSED ON MENTHOL-FLAVORED TOBACCO PRODUCTS THAT ATTRACT & ADDICT YOUTH

THE TOBACCO FREE ZONE OF Cortland, Tompkins & Chenango L Counties and statewide partners are kicking off the statewide launch of the "It's Not Just" campaign, intended to educate people across New York State about the tobacco industry's historically inequitable marketing and promotion of menthol-flavored tobacco products. The It's Not Just campaign speaks from the youth perspective, blending powerful imagery with direct quotes by tobacco executives to highlight the striking contrast between how the industry views youth and how youth see themselves. It is an extension of the campaign launched in May 2021 to urge the public to take action against the hard-hitting menthol-flavored tobacco product marketing that has targeted and harmed Black communities

"For decades, tobacco companies have used flavors to recruit a new generation of users," said Jennifer Hamilton, Tobacco Free Zone Community Engagement Coordinator with the Cortland County Health Department. "Menthol cigarettes, which are the only flavored cigarettes still on the market, are easier to start and more difficult to quit, which can accelerate addiction."

The campaign is timely with the release of the Food and Drug Association proposed rules that would remove menthol cigarettes and flavored cigars from the market. Hamilton notes that "while it's great that the FDA has taken these additional steps to address menthol cigarettes, their rulemaking process is very lengthy and there's no guarantee the rules will ultimately be implemented. We would expect the tobacco industry to aggressively fight this proposal. Communities can continue to take action at the local level to protect

The tobacco industry tracks the behaviors and preferences of youth under 21 because it sees "today's teenager as tomorrow's potential regular customer." 1 To mask the harshness of smoke, tobacco companies use flavor, like menthol, in their products to make them more appealing to new users, almost all of whom are under 18.2 In fact, nearly 81% of youth who have ever tried tobacco started with a flavored product, and more than half (54%) of youth ages 12-17 years who smoke use menthol cigarettes.³⁴ Flavored tobacco products pose a serious health threat to today's youth.

Tobacco use is the leading cause of preventable death in the United States and worldwide. 6 According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, nearly $5.6\,\mathrm{million}$ of today's Americans younger than 18 will die early from smoking-related illness if the current rate of youth smoking continues.^{7,8} Even more shocking, every adult who dies early due to smoking is replaced by two new young smokers.

Menthol and tobacco marketing

- Tobacco companies have a long history of developing and marketing flavored tobacco products as "starter" products that attract kids.3.11
- Tobacco companies market menthol cigarettes as "smoother" than other cigarettes.4,13
- Documents from the tobacco industry show that the industry studied smokers' menthol preferences and manipulated menthol levels to appeal to adolescents and young adults. 9
- Research shows that the tobacco industry attracted new $smokers\,by\,promoting\,cigar ettes\,with\,lower\,menthol\,content,$ which is popular among adolescents and young adults.9
- Tobacco companies spend \$8.4 billion each year to promote their deadly products, much of which directly reaches and influences kids.10

Menthol usage and addiction

- Menthol cigarettes lead to increased smoking initiation among youth and young adults, greater addiction and decreased success in quitting smoking.2
- Menthol cools and numbs the throat, reducing the harshness of cigarette smoke, making menthol cigarettes more appealing to youth.2
- Over 7 out of 10 African American youth ages 12-17 years who smoke use

menthol cigarettes. 14,15

Health impact

- Menthol cigarettes are not less harmful than other cigarettes, and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration has found that they are likely a greater risk to public health than nonmenthol cigarettes.4
- Researchers estimate that if a menthol ban had gone into effect in 2011, 320,000 smoking-attributed deaths would have been averted by 2050.5,12
- Menthol cigarette smokers are as likely to experience premature morbidity and mortality as non-menthol cigarette

Support available for New Yorkers who want to quit

The New York State Smokers' Quitline is a confidential service for all New York State residents who wish to overcome tobacco use, including e-cigarettes. Free offerings include individualized coaching and assistance with quit-planning from highly trained Quit Coaches, text and chat support, and free shipping of stop-smoking medications such as nicotine patches or nicotine gum for those 18 and older. Residents of all ages may contact the Quitline for support and educational materials. In addition, the Quitline encourages teens and young adults (ages 13-24) to text "DROPTHEVAPE" to 88709 to join This Is Quitting, a free texting support program for help with quitting vaping. Visit nysmokefree.com anytime for more information or call 1-866-NY-QUITS (1-866-697-8487) seven days a week, beginning at 9 a.m.

Tobacco Free New York State and Reality Check student groups around the state have worked tirelessly to educate local communities on the tobacco industry's use of menthol and other flavored tobacco products as a tool to target, attract and addict new smokers. Tobacco Free New York State, including the Reality Check student youth groups, is part of the NYS Tobacco Control Program.





create problems in water heaters, dish washers and plumbing

Water purification can include the removal of iron, sulfur, chlorine and bacteria in a chemical-free process. Softening the water is also important and has many benefits, not only for family members, but for plumbing systems and appliances

"Uncontaminated water is essential for good health," Shute said. "Foul-smelling or unusual odors from your water should make you question your water's quality and safety."

Many families throughout Central New York use well water as a source of drinking water and for all its household needs. Unfortunately, water containing hydrogen sulfide gas has a



distinctive "rotten egg" odor which is especially noticeable when running hot water.

Shute said the danger lies in a gradual chemical reaction

"Hydrogen sulfide gas will corrode plumbing metals such as iron, steel, copper and brass, and the exposed metal parts in appliances such as dish washers and washing machines" Shute said. "Also, corrosion of iron and steel pipes from ferrous sulfide, or 'black water,' that can darken everyday tableware, discolor copper and brass utensils and alter the appearance and taste of cooked foods."

Additionally, Shute said, sulfur water can make washing clothes more difficult.

m OND}$ season fast approaching. Most pond fish breeders say that Memorial day is the official kickoff of pond season.

You want your water to warm up a bit before adding your fish. Fish that have been inside may not be ready for that chilly water yet. When you do take your pond fish back outside, be sure to float them in a bag BUT ONLY for 5 minutes.

This will help them adjust to the cooler water. Floating too long can have bad effects

Avoid Overstocking the Pond, especially a new pond.

To maintain healthy fish and clear water, do not overload the ecosystem with too many fish. For a new pond, a good rule of thumb is one inch of fish per square foot of surface area. A mature pond can support two to three inches of fish per square foot. The following are

Comets, one of the most popular types of goldfish, have long slender bodies and are typically solid orange and metallic in appearance. Shubunkins have longer, thinner bodies and are typically shaped like the common goldfish. They are primarily bred for their beautiful colors. Most shibunkins are calico in color, orange, red, gray, almost

Koi: are ornate cousins of the carp family and can be easily identified by their whiskers. Their vivid coloration, striking patterns, longevity and impressive size make them popular pets. Standard Koi colors are black, white, yellow, orange, blue or red. Other koi types are, Taisho Sanke: Pure white Koi with distinct red and black markings.

Ohgon or neon Koi: Usually yellow, orange or gold metallic.

Butterfly Koi: Distinguished by their long butterfly fins.

Sarasa comets are red and white and shaped like the shibunkins. They are hardy and not too expensive. Some people even use the cheap feeder fish, like you get at the fair. They often do ok in the pond

Normally most pond fish are fine together especially if similar in size. We are getting pond fish weekly now.






