



CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY **HISTORICAL SOCIETY**

AST TIME IN THE CAT, we asked if you could tell us what prosecuting Nazi war crimes has to do with Cortland. The Nuremberg trials were the military trials held after World War II by the Allied forces which would attempt to prosecute Nazi leaders for war crimes. The trials took place in Nuremberg, Germany with the whole world watching. But just what to do the Nuremberg trials have to do with Cortland?

Theodore Fenstermacher is the connection. Theodore Fenstermacher was a promising young attorney practicing law in New York City when he happened to have lunch with another attorney who was back from Nuremberg and looking to recruit additional attorneys for the legal team of the Allies. Ted decided to take this opportunity, and his wife, Nancy joined him. Nancy had majored in German at Vassar College and was a translator for the team. She also summarized an enormous number of German documents for the prosecution. He was one of 160 attorneys from four countries who worked to bring down Hitler's henchmen.

So how does this have anything to do with Cortland? Theodore and Nancy Fenstermacher moved to Cortland in 1948 when

Ted joined the law firm of Lusk, Buck, Folmer, and Ryan. This firm later became Folmer, Ryan, Fenstermacher, and Yesawich. Ted and Nancy raised their family and remained in Cortland for the rest of their lives. They were involved in Cortland life and enjoyed living here.

Ted's commitment to the community lives on through the Fenstermacher Fund which is administered through the Central New York Community Foundation. Every year, the foundation invites applications from nonprofit organizations in Cortland County and awards a number of Bright Ideas grants to support the missions of these important organizations.

brewery! The brewery was opened in March of 2019 by Brian and Erin Bullard and offers 12 taps of house brewed beers in a 2400 sq foot urban warehouse brewery with tasting room at the back of Applied Concepts on Route 281 in Tully. Since opening the couple has developed an outdoor beer garden and expanded into the remaining 3400 square feet available to them, well ahead of schedule

The brewery is very family friendly and offers wine, hard cider, soda, and coffee along with beer.

Well received by the community, the company is already becoming a key asset to the Town of Tully and surrounding areas. ONCO has become a popular gathering space for residents and visitors offering live music weekly, community focused events and private party spaces.

ONCO offers a "cozy urban warehouse" tasting room with garage doors that open to the deck and beer garden, a large indoor event space/party room, front deck, and beer garden space offering visitors many options for seating and enjoying a relaxing day at the brewery. Dogs are allowed to visit on the deck and in the beer garden, which features an acre of table space and lawn areas for chairs, blankets, and play, along with three firepits.

There is a house food truck on site run by Kevin and Melissa Spinner of Spinner LLC and Naan Ya' Business, offering "159 concept" menu (for Tully's zip code 13159) that changes weekly. The menus include brunch every Sunday from 11-1, after which the week's main menu resumes. Anyone is welcome to purchase 159 food for to go or to enjoy on ONCO's premises even if beer purchases aren't a part of their outing. Reservations are not required (though a call ahead to the brewery for larger groups is requested)

The brewery is open Thursdays and Fridays from 4-9, Saturdays from 1-9, and Sundays from 11-6. Current hours for food service are Thursdays 4-8, Friday 4-8, Saturday

2-8, and Sundays 11 – 5 (brunch to lunch). Live music schedule, events, and 159 Menus are updated regularly on ONCO's social media and website, www.oncoferment.com.

CREATURE FEATURE FAWN FACTS

This time each year, it's good to revisit some facts about ▲ white-tailed deer fawns.

A tiny fawn often appears abandoned when we stumble across it laying on the ground with no sign of Mother around. This is rarely the case, however, and the doe is usually nearby. She leaves her fawn alone, returning to tend and nurse it. This behavior keeps it hidden from predators. The worst thing we can do is approach or touch the fawn which can result in it $bolting\,away\,into\,danger\,or\,getting\,separated\,from\,its\,mother.$

A newborn fawn also has a "freeze instinct" to escape detection. This, teamed with a nearly scentless, camouflaged coat, helps the defenseless baby avoid predators and marauding dogs. Ironically, the instinct to remain motionless can endanger the fawn, as it

won't budge, even when haying equipment or other machinery bears down on it.

Until a bond is formed with its mother, a newborn fawn will follow any large, moving object; so that seemingly cute video of a fawn toddling after a child or dog is actually a sad situation, as the fawn is led away from the doe and into danger. The best care for a fawn is with its mother. Rarely is human intervention necessary - in fact, it often proves tragic. Remember: "If you care, leave it there."

Signs of legitimate concern include a fawn by a dead doe; visible injuries; curled ears (indicating dehydration); and incessant vocalizing. In this case, contact the NYS DEC at (607) 753-3095, extension 247 for guidance.

PROGRESSIVE AMERICAN FLAT TRACK WEEDSPORT SPEEDWAY JULY 2

THE PROGRESSIVE AMERICAN FLAT TRACK series is set to make its fourth-ever stop at Weedsport Speedway on July 2. The previous visits have proven popular with fans in central New York, drawing sellout crowds to observe its barbanging action and unpredictable racing. This year's edition of the New York Short Track is set to be all that much more special with a Fourth of July weekend fireworks display and up-close access to the riders and their equipment via a Paddock Pass Upgrade.
