N ANNUAL SUMMER GATHERING BEGAN to unfold with the smell of A^{N ANNUAL SUMMER UNTILLING 22-1} Chicken barbeque in the air as the dew slipped away from the grass. The small town was a buzz of activity that morning, as baskets of blueberries lined the tables, deliveries of prize worthy baked goods were donated and local authors pulled out their latest creations for display and signing. Free children's books were waiting for the touch of little hands and a room filled with all kinds of bargain priced books was truly inviting. Antique vehicles were arriving and vendors filled the spacious grounds. This was the start of the 5th Annual Blueberry and Book Festival. TRUXTON LIVING WELL SENIOR CENTER

CINCE OCTOBER THE NEWLY DESIGNED Truxton Living Well senior Ocenter has been busily adding programs, gauging community needs, and offering a space where seniors can socialize, take part in activities, play games, do art, and spend some time with others. Beginning in May the center, which operates out of the Truxton Methodist church, will be changing hours to better accommodate the needs of seniors in the area.

Instead of offering the center once a week for a full day program, the center will now be catering to more of a late day and early morning schedule twice a week. The center will be open 4pm to 7pm Tuesdays for a family style potluck style dinner and activities such as bingo, movin and groovin with Val fitness class, painting with Jill, pitch, games, and more. Thursdays the center will be open for breakfast starting at 8 am with a \$5 free will donation.

"We are hoping with the change in days and times that more people will be able to utilize the center and take part in activities," said senior center director Jill Kraft.

"We are open to the idea of bringing in new programs, events, workshops and activities as well, we just have to find out what people would like to see happening at the center," she said. The center has been open for several months but with the rise in Covid cases and the winter months being hard on everyone, Kraft says she is hoping with the warmer weather more people will come out. The center is open to anyone in Cortland County and it is free to attend (minus the free will breakfast donation). Kraft says also that she is hoping to have a fundraiser, senior trips and some other larger events this summer. "The center caters to the needs of seniors, we have guest speakers in to discuss topics such as healthy eating, computer scams, how to use social media, financial wellbeing and others. CRT NEXT PRESENTS TWO REVIVALS FOR THEIR 50TH ANNIVERSARY SUMMER SEASON

FOR THE SECOND AND THIRD shows in their 50th Anniversary season, Cortland Repertory Theatre presents two revivals of popular shows from their past: "Over the River and Through the Woods", a comedy by Joe DiPietro, and the musical "Kiss Me, Kate" with music and lyrics by Cole Porter with book by Sam and Bella Spewack.

"Over the River..." will have performances at the Little York Pavilion in Preble from June 22^{nd} – July 1st with evening shows at 7:30 PM. Matinees are available on June 24^{th} , 26^{th} , 29^{th} and July 1st at 2:00 PM. "Kiss Me, Kate" performances will run from July 6th – 16th with evening shows at 7:30 PM. Matinees are available on July 8th, 10th, and 13th at 2:00 PM.

Tickets may be purchased by calling 800-427-6160 or by visiting the CRT Box Office at 24 Port Watson Street in Cortland. Tickets are also available through CortlandRep.org with ETIX, for a small additional charge. CRT cautions that ETIX is the only approved online ticket service; others charge significantly higher rates for tickets and are not approved by CRT. First produced at CRT in 2005, "*Over the River*..." is a hysterical comedy that is for, and about, the whole family. Nick is a young Italian American living in New York City who meets both sets of grandparents in New Jersey for dinner every Sunday. That is, until he accepts his dream job in Seattle. The news sets the grandparents reeling, and then scheming, as they find ways to keep him from moving - including playing matchmaker with a lovely young lady who has no idea what she's getting into. At CRT's previous production, patrons commented that they felt they were seeing their own family on stage!

In "*Kiss Me, Kate*", sparks fly both onstage and off when actor/ director Fred Graham attempts to mount a musical version of *The Taming of the Shrew* with his ex-wife Lilli Vanessi in the leading role. 



CREATURE FEATURE SWALLOWTAIL BUTTERFLIES

THE SWALLOWTAIL BUTTERFLY FAMILY HAS several ▲ members, including the Tiger Swallowtail, Giant Swallowtail, Black Swallowtail and Spicebush Swallowtail. They are large, beautiful, and vibrant butterflies that capture both our eye and appreciation when we encounter them gracefully moving from flower to flower. They are aptly named for the long projections at the base of their hind wings that resemble a swallow's tail.

Swallowtail butterflies typically fly with slow wingbeats as they forage on taller flowers, but when spooked, these big beauties can fly away fast on their strong wings, often retreating to tree tops. In fact, most swallowtail varieties prefer to have trees nearby to where they feed.

Male swallowtail butterflies like to visit puddles. The nutrients they glean from the puddles and moist areas support their reproductive needs. They may gather around such wet places in numbers in a behavior called "puddling." Female swallowtails search for the right plants to lay their eggs on such as pawpaw, prickly ash, wild carrot, dill, sassafras and spicebush, to name just a handful. They use scent and taste, as well as an ability to recognize leaf shapes, to determine the correct host plants.






