

HARKS ARE VERY POPULAR IN today's aquarium market. They are not true sharks but some do look like a real shark.

The redtail black shark is the most aggressive. The red-tailed black sharks seen in the aquarium trade today are all captive bred. Another popular shark is the Tricolor or Bala sharks. They are mostly a peaceful shark and can get very big. They do best in groups of 2 and are mostly farm raised now.

The iridescent shark is a member of the shark/catfish family and also get very big. They prefer a temperature range of 72-79°F. In the wild, They prefer large bodies of water similar to the deep waters of their native Mekong river basin.

They are a peaceful community fish but are prone to catching Ick, white spot disease. For that reason, keep an eye on them so if they come down with ick, you can treat them right away.

It's mostly juvenile iridescent sharks that are sold as pets for home aquariums, they are not easy fish to keep. While they can survive in a home aquarium, iridescent sharks are schooling fish that prefer groups, are accustomed to living in rivers and are active fish that require space. They have very poor eyesight, so detected movement from outside of their habitat can be seen as a threat. If stressed, their first instinct is to flee; a blind dash can cause injury in an aquarium

These injuries may result in the fish sinking to the bottom, where it may lie on its side or back until it recovers. Often when catching the iridescent shark, it will almost play dead and once back in the tank, acts fine and swims off.

CREATURE FEATURE ST. LAWRENCE SHARKS

THE ST. LAWRENCE RIVER IS home to LOTS of fish. In the L river's International section alone, there are 85 species, including popular sportfish such as striped, large- and smallmouth bass, walleye, northern pike and muskellunge. Prehistoric lake sturgeon swim the waterway, along with rare fish species like the pugnose shiner. There are also at least 8 species of sharks known to frequent the St. Lawrence. These sharks are not new or unusual visitors to the gulf and estuary sections of the river. In fact, they have likely been swimming there since the end of the last ice age, around 10,000 years ago!

- Basking shark common in the gulf and estuary; June to September.
- White shark common in the gulf, but rare to the estuary; July to October.
- **Greenland shark** [illustration] year-round resident, common in both the gulf and estuary.
- Common thresher very rare inhabitant of the gulf portion only: July and September.
- Blue shark common in the gulf, but rarely found in the estuary; July to September.
- Porbeagle shark common in both the gulf and estuary; June to October.
- Spiny dogfish common to the gulf, but rare visitor to the estuary; July to September.
- Black dogfish year-round resident, common in both the gulf and estuary.

Human activity has dramatically impacted St. Lawrence shark populations, with some species reaching historic lows; yet more sharks are being reported there each year. Why? The St. Lawrence Shark Observatory (ORS) warns that "appearances can be deceiving" and points to the present age of smartphones when shark catches are shared with the touch of button. Despite the increase in observations, most sharks are in decline due to overfishing and by-catches.

In the Early 1970's, a small group of local off-road motorcycle enthusiasts came together to form the Ithaca Dirt Riders (IDR). It was their vision to provide some local trails and events for their club members and others to enjoy. A year later, the club chartered with the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA). With many of its members interested in the AMA sport of enduros, the club sanctioned its first event. It is hard to believe, but this year is the 50th anniversary of The

Ithaca Dirt Riders Enduro! It will be held on Sunday, August 21 at 253 Andersen Hill Road, Berkshire, NY 13736 starting at 9:00 am and 1:00pm (depending on class, age and bike size), The 9:00am ride is two hours long and the 1:00pm is for the more experienced riders and is three hours long.. The sprint enduro consists of three "loops" through fields and woods. It is a great experience for riders with a good deal of challenge for them also and riders can ride as young as 12 years old, if they have a bike with at least a 19" front tire. There are NO spectator fees and we have information sheets available to see where the riders will be during the event. Find out more about these events at amad4enduro.com or ecea.org or on Facebook, look for "AMA District 4 Enduro Championship" or "East Coast Enduro Association" for event information.

SO, WHAT IS A SPRINT ENDURO? Enduros are a crosscountry event, which not only requires speed and ability, but also endurance (hence "Enduro").

With a Sprint Enduro, the timekeeping element is not a factor. Fairly new to the enduro world in America, sprint enduros allow competitors to race against the clock on wide, fastflowing trails and grass tracks. They ride a small number of special tests multiple times throughout the day, trying to improve their times each ride. There is a time limitation to complete the required test section or tests. The rider with the fastest time to complete the loops wins.

With the help of many volunteers and supporters, the Ithaca Dirt Riders have not only been able to host this local event, but many AMA national events over the years. IDR not only promotes the sport of off-road riding, but also helps the local communities, especially the local volunteer fire departments and emergency squads in the past, who provide great meals at the events, along with their services when necessary.

CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

In the last issue of the CAT, we asked if you could tell us what a sidepath was and what it had to do with Cortland County. Around the 1880s, bicycles became a popular way of getting around, but roads were bumpy and muddy. Sidepaths were the solution!

Sidepaths were trails designed specifically for bicycles to use. Sidepaths were made of gravel and/or cinders. Rollers packed the surface down so that it was smooth. Subscriptions were sold to build the sidepaths, and all users paid annual dues to maintain them. Members each had a sidepath license that was attached to their bicycle so that police could identify those who were allowed on the trails. Licenses were varied in shape and size, and the location the license was to be placed on the bike changed year-to-year so that it was easier to spot offenders.

A network of sidepaths developed in Cortland County, including ones in Truxton, Scott, South Cortland, McGraw, Homer, and Little York.
