This year's patch honors Art Crane: "Chief" Art Crane

Oscar Cronk called him "The Dean of Old Time Fox Trapping". Johnny Thorpe called him "The Grand Daddy of all Modern Fox Trappers".

Those are pretty powerful statements from a couple of real legends themselves. However, when comparing the two quotes above, and with some hard-to-find history, you will find the real story of one of the greatest New York State fox trappers. Art Crane was like a mythical legend whose exploits were only carried on in a verbal tradition. If you were not in his inner circle, you knew very little about this trapper.

He was the son of Marion and Francis Crane, of Sanford, New York. In 1921 he married Alta Holmes Oliver, who liked to make garments from fox pelts.

Arts first public appearance in trapping history were some very well staged early photos posted of his fox catches in Hunter Trader Trapper magazine between 1913 and 1930. Art was an expert fox trapper using the dirt hole and the spring hole sets way before they were documented by other trappers. The best photos are in Ray Duntley's book. His dirt hole set copied the way a fox actually dug out a mouse hole. Art also had a pet fox named "SKIPPE". Maybe that fox was Art's mentor!

Art passed away in 1967, they say he was 88; he spent his last 2 years at a mink farm in Massachusetts.

CREATURE FEATURE MANGE THREATENS WILDLIFE & PETS

ARCOPTIC MANGE IS A COMMON, widespread disease in mammals. It is caused by a microscopic mite that burrows into the skin, igniting an immune response. In North America, some of the most commonly affected species include red foxes, gray wolves, coyotes and, more recently, black bears. Mange also threatens our pets.

In addition to tunneling into the skin, mites also deposit eggshells, molted skin and waste, further exacerbating an immune response in the host. Afflicted animals can suffer miserably from intense itching, hair loss, thickening, cracked skin, and sores [photo]. Many eventually die from emaciation, secondary infections or septicemia. Several decades ago, in parts of the U.S. and Canada, humans intentionally introduced sarcoptic mange to coyotes and wolves to control their populations – a cruel and foolish strategy. Since then, mange has spread and is now endemic in several species.

Mange spreads through direct and indirect contact with an infected host or a shared environment; for example, adult foxes can pass mites to their young, or your dog might develop mange after rolling in an area occupied by a diseased animal (sickly wildlife is more likely to seek human spaces). Experts advise against feeding wild animals, which promotes the spread of mange.

The most common medication to treat animals with sarcoptic mange is Ivermectin. While effective, especially when coupled with supportive care, it requires multiple doses and offers abbreviated protection. Fluralaner, the active drug in veterinarian prescribed Bravecto, is very effective, requires just one dose, and provides 2-3 months of protection to help break the reinfestation cycle. Licensed wildlife rescue and rehabilitation specialists perform a valuable community service when they treat wild animals suffering from mange. Consider supporting these unsung heroes with a donation today.

THE RED TAILED BLACK SHARK, also known as the red tail shark, is a species of freshwater fish in the carp family where it is prized for its deep black body and vivid red or orange tail.

Red tail sharks can reach a length of 6 inches but in rare cases they can reach 8 or even 9 inches depending on how they are

Typically they are aggressive chasers, but will rarely bite or harm other fish. Individual personalities vary greatly-some are calm, while others are rather aggressive towards tank

mates. They are bottom dwellers and like lots of dark hiding places. They get along with other semi-aggressive fish, but they do not like other sharks. Redtail sharks are considered compatible in some community tanks, although they may chase docile or peaceful fish that present a large target (such as "silver dollar" fish). This may be physically harmless, but could cause a great deal of stress for the pursued fish, sometimes resulting in death due to stress. No one likes to be

They will mostly chase fish away from their territory and then retreat; therefore, it is important to ensure the aquarium is large enough to allow the redtail some space to call its territory. Redtails are bottom dwellers. It is often reported that they do not generally harass loaches and may even exhibit schooling behavior with them.

Most people tell me their red tail shark is either peaceful or it's after every fish in the tank. They are a bit unpredictable.

There is an albino version of the red tail black shark but it is not very common. The rainbow shark looks a lot like the red tail black shark, the difference being rainbow sharks have all red fins and the red tail black only has the back tail red. They are a very popular fish and I always have them in stock. There is a new version now called a ghost shark. It's a redtail shark but the back fin is white.



LOST DOGS OF THE FINGER LAKES

UR MISSION AT LOST DOGS of the Finger Lakes is to help the lost become found. Recently, I spoke with a wonderful woman who had found a dog. We posted the dog on our page and while the owner was found and positively identified in a matter of a few hours, it was not before the finder received a handful of calls from other people professing to be the dog's owner. One caller even claimed to be the neighbor of the owner but when questioned, couldn't give simple identifying

But there are lessons here, and ones that we need your help in sharing far and wide. People with bad intentions for our beloved pets are watching our page and others like it. They also ride the roads looking for pets that aren't secured or being monitored. They are attempting to steal dogs or claim dogs that are not theirs and the reasons why are all bad; dog fighting, selling to labs for testing, adding to their hoarding collection, flipping...it's an endless and terrifying list.

What can you, as the finder or owner, do? First and most importantly (as we've always preached) call your local Dog Control Officer (DCO) and file a lost or found report. Calling your DCO is not optional - it is a legal requirement. This report helps you and helps your dog. It creates a legal paper trail that will help to identify your dog when found or will help

> to prosecute someone who may have found your dog.... and kept them.

Second, this is for you the finder, when an individual calls or arrives to claim ownership, insist on proof. Ask for vet records, licensing documentation, or even photos. If the individual claiming ownership cannot show proof, call your local police department or DCO right away and let them sort it out.

Third, and this is for you the owner, make sure your dog is licensed and wearing their tags. This registration is required by law and serves as proof of ownership and is a vital link to getting your dog safely home should they ever become lost.

What can we, as a community, do? We can educate about the role of our DCOs and the importance of licensing. We can make sure that we're aware of the dangers out there for these dogs and protect them with everything we do. Thank you to all who share our posts...you've saved countless lives.
