 $P_{\rm provide\ enough\ algae\ to\ keep\ your\ pleco\ full.\ You'll$ need to feed plecos algae wafers too. Plecos will sometimes eat vegetables including zucchini, spinach and kale.

Since algae is the favorite food, I tell people to wait until you have algae, then add a pleco to your tank.

Life Expectancy: Plecos who live in captivity tend to have slightly briefer lifespans than those out in the wild. Pet plecos often survive from 10 to 15 years. Those that live on their own in natural settings, however, often exceed 15 years in age.

Plecos can grow big. I have seen them up to 2 feet long and sometimes even larger than that.

There are a lot of different plecos, all with a variety of prices. The black and white pleco can sell for as much as \$100.

Plecos prefer temperatures between about 75 and 82°F. With that being said, there are some pleco species that are hardier than others, and may be able to withstand some cooler waters. Clown plecos and rubber plecos tend to stay smaller.

I do have people ask me if a pleco eats the waste of other fish, they do not. To get rid of excess food and waste, you will need to do a water change using a siphon.

Plecos are quite hardy fish as long as they have algae to eat. Do they overeat? I have had people say they put a pleco in a very algaed tank and in 2 days the tank is clean and the pleco dies. So it could be that plecos can eat themselves to death. I think it's rare but possible.



CREATURE FEATURE RING-BILLED GULLS. ADAPTIVE SURVIVORS

DULT RING-BILLED GULLS ARE GRAY and white gulls with ${
m A}_{
m yellow}$ legs and a black band across their bill. These strong, agile flyers can be found in varying habitats. Coastal areas aside, they are common to inland water bodies and urban, suburban and agricultural landscapes. Indeed, many of these adaptive "seagulls" never see the sea! Chances are, the gulls you see canvasing a fast food parking lot are ring-bills as are those hanging around golf courses, marinas, and garbage dumps -- hence their nickname, "Dump Chicken."

Whether floating, flying or afoot, these gulls are on the look-out for something edible, be it fish or French fries. Mostly, though, they eat small fish, insects and other invertebrates. They also pluck berries, nab rodents, scavenge carrion, and steal food from other birds. In other words, ring-billed gulls are shameless survivors.

Nesting colony counts can number in the thousands. Nests are simple scrapes on the ground, lined with plant material. Both parents care for the young, which can fly at around 5 weeks. Colonies typically contain a small percentage of 2-female pairs, where each is fertilized by a random male and lays her eggs in a shared matriarchal nest. Most ring-billed gulls return to breed at the colony where they hatch. Many also return to the same wintering places in the south, using an internal compass to navigate, as well as landmarks and highaltitude winds to guide them.
