





#### CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

IN THE LAST ISSUE OF the CAT, we asked if you could name the world-renowned mathematician from Cortland. Were you able to come up with an answer?

Cortland's own David Eugene Smith was a worldrenowned mathematician who traveled the world collecting mathematical and astronomical instruments as well as rare mathematical related books and manuscripts. Smith was the author of more than 70 books, and he was a leader in mathematics education. Smith's story begins in 1860 when he was born to Judge Abram P. Smith and Mary Elizabeth Bronson. David's mother taught him Latin and Greek when he was a child, and she enriched his education by taking him to museums, historical sites, and art exhibits. David attended the Cortland Normal School and then studied at Syracuse University where he would earn a bachelor's degree in philosophy in 1881. He went into law practice with his father upon graduation until 1884 when he was offered a position as an interim mathematics instructor at the Cortland Normal School. He discovered a love for teaching mathematics, and that was to be the trajectory of his life from then on.

Smith went on to earn a Ph. D. and an LL. D. from Syracuse University while concurrently teaching at Cortland Normal and traveling the world. He crossed the Atlantic 80 times and visited every continent. That was quite a feat in his lifetime!

Where was State Street located in Cortland?

Tropical fish need a heater and filter which is hard to get on a small desktop tank.

And finally when it comes to cichlids, there is no way of knowing if they will get along with other fish or even other cichlids. They tend to be aggressive and do best in a bigger tank

#### **CREATURE FEATURE WILD ABOUT MUSHROOMS**

TTHILE MOST PEOPLE ARE LEERY of eating wild mushrooms, they're often on the menu for bears, deer, opossums, skunks, raccoons, rabbits, hares, squirrels, mice, turkeys, grouse, crows and many other wild creatures.

White-tailed deer consume 580 different species of fungi! By providing digestible protein, phosphorus and a bigger punch of energy than other plants, mushrooms compensate for dietary deficiencies in deer, especially in lean times when hard mast crops like acorns and beechnuts are poor.

Red squirrels commonly gather mushrooms and store them on tree branches to dry, which extends and concentrates their nutritional value. Researchers discovered that chipmunks that gobble up lots of mushrooms in fall pack on more fat for hibernation. Bits of fungi scattered on stumps, logs and rocks are clues that squirrels and chipmunks have been snacking there, as are the chiseled grooves left on mushrooms from their incisor teeth.

Turkeys and grouse scratch in the leaf litter to unearth tasty mushrooms. Meanwhile, blue jays and robins - while they don't eat fungi -- will pick them apart searching for hidden insect larvae. Bugs and other invertebrates are wild about mushrooms, too. As they feed, slugs scoop out tunnels of fungi flesh using a horned mouthpart. Coolest of all are the

"fungi farmers"-certain types of ants, beetles and termites that "plant" fungal spores within their habitats to grow their

It is important to recognize that not all mushroom species consumed by wildlife are safe for us to eat; in fact, some are highly toxic to people and pets.
