CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY **HISTORICAL SOCIETY**

AST TIME IN THE CAT, we asked if you knew where State Street was located in Cortland.

There is no trace of this street left today if you consult Google maps, but it does show up on earlier maps of Cortland. State Street opened on Port Watson Street a little more than halfway between Greenbush and Church Streets and led directly to the State Normal School which was located where the Courthouse is today. It appears that it might have been like an access road to the school. The Normal School was a training school for teachers and the predecessor of SUNY Cortland. The building suffered a catastrophic fire in 1919 and the school was rebuilt on the hill where the college is located



THE TRUMANSBURG CONSERVATORY OF FINE Arts (TCFA) is pleased to announce its 38th annual Fall Invitational, this year titled "ALTERED: Changed, Repurposed, Reconsidered." Curated by Ann Welles, the exhibit features the work of six artists all of whom challenge us to experience the familiar in new ways. Tt's that time of year when people start thinking about $oldsymbol{oldsymbol{\bot}}$ bringing their pond fish inside. Some people start as early as September, but some people are doing it now.

Remember, goldfish can stay out in the ponds all year as long as the water doesn't freeze solid.

Of course around here, you never know because we can get a really cold winter. However if you want to leave them out in the pond all winter, there are a couple things you can do.

The first is a pond heater. It floats in the pond and keeps at least one area free from ice so that the fish don't freeze. Another is to have a pump blowing bubbles in the pond. That will prevent the water from freezing solid.

If you do bring your pond fish in, try to set up the tank a few weeks ahead of time and put a couple of small goldfish into the tank to get the beneficial bacteria going. If you bring in a whole bunch of pond fish and add them to your tank all at once, you could be facing a massive die off.

The good bacteria actually eats the urine the fish produce. So it is very important to have that.

After the bacteria grows, the rule of thumb is one inch of fish per gallon of water. Also be sure to have a good power filter and an air pump with airstone blowing lots of bubbles into the tank. Lots of bubbles is a very good thing. Feed your goldfish a good quality food and feed them small amounts but several times a day. The fish farms recommend feeding 3 to 4 times a day, but remember SMALL amounts.





CREATURE FEATURE RIGHTY OR LEFTY?

In this right-handed world, between 75-90% of us use our right hand to write, eat, throw, etc., but did you know that animals can also be righties or lefties? Perhaps it's not so surprising that many other primates use a preferred hand. Most great apes, our closest primate relatives, are righties, including gorillas and chimpanzees. On the other hand

(wink), orangutans have a higher percentage of lefties.

More surprising is the fact that most walruses, like humans, are righties, and even octopuses use a favourite tentacle (although the latter seems based on individual preference rather than a populationwide trait). Researchers discovered that some mice are righties while others are literal "southpaws," and that certain species of tree frogs preferentially jump in one direction or the other to escape predators.

Another fascinating example of right- and left-handedness was observed in blue whales as they fed on krill. Scientists noted the whales exhibited a preference for one side or the other when practicing specific feeding maneuvers. During "side rolls" (turning 90 degrees onto their side), most of the whales rolled to their right, identifying them as lefties. During the "barrel roll" (rising from the depths and performing a 360-degree spin), the whales almost always rolled left, making them righties. Furthermore, those whales exhibiting a clear preference for right-sidedness could switch to lefty-driven barrel rolls, revealing an ambidextrous capacity.


