

### **CREATURE FEATURE** WHOOO GOES THERE?

LONG WITH BATS AND BLACK cats, owls are among Halloween's Amost iconic animals. With huge, glaring eyes, nocturnal behaviors and eerie vocalizations, it's easy to see why owls have been featured in creepy folklore for centuries. One tale claims that an owl will wring its own neck trying to watch you run in circles around a tree where it is perched. Fact or

Unlike most other animals that use their eyes to track a moving object, owls must turn their necks to keep an object in sight because their eyes are fixed in their sockets: and while owls can't turn their heads in a complete circle, they can rotate them up to 270 degrees without causing any internal damage. This amazing feat is possible because their tissue and blood vessels are very flexible. They also have "backup arteries" that kick in when blood vessels get closed off by rapid rotation. As well, their heads are connected by one socket pivot (humans have two, limiting our ability to twist). Furthermore, owls have lots of vertebrae in their neck and spine, allowing for a wide range of motion and the ability to look behind them.

So, should you choose to run in circles around a tree where an owl resides, you might get dizzy...but the owl will be just fine HAPPY HALLOWEEN!

LOT OF PEOPLE ARE interested in other types of creatures besides fish for their aquarium. Here are a couple ideas.

The blue crawfish are found in Florida. They are the only native species of crawfish in the everglades. It is the lack of a gene that causes them to be blue. Also known as the Electric Blue Crayfish. As far as feeding, pelleted fish food that settles to the bottom should be provided. Crayfish are omnivorous scavengers and will eat almost anything they can grab with their claws from small fish, to worms, to vegetation. Crayfish like to burrow and hide, so provide a cave or hiding rock.

Most shrimp are fine to keep with these guys because they are fast and stay out of the way of the Electric Blue Crayfish. They also enjoy logs to hide under, driftwood and rock shelters. Crayfish are very good at escaping so make sure to have a tight fitting lid on your tank.

Blue crayfish can be messy eaters so make sure to do regular water changes. If you have live plants in your tank ,there is a good chance they are going to eat them.

Ghost Shrimp, also known as Glass Shrimp, are excellent scavengers. They are inexpensive and efficient aquarium cleaners that will actively search for any kind of leftover food in your aquarium. Their transparent bodies and frenetic food-searching behavior make Ghost Shrimp an interesting addition to your freshwater aquarium. The Ghost Shrimp body is transparent, and an orange to yellow colored spot is visible in the center of the tail. The body is segmented, and features ten sets of legs. The first four sets have tiny claws that aid the shrimp in feeding.

Ghost Shrimp are relatively small invertebrates, reaching a maximum size of only 2"

The Ghost Shrimp are omnivores and will consume algae, detritus and left over food. If insufficient food is present, supplement with a quality flake food or pellet.

Ghost shrimp are an excellent food source for many types of both freshwater and saltwater fish.

### DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME ENDS

TIME WILL FALL BACK TO standard time again on Sunday, ▲ November 6 at 2am, when daylight saving time ends. History of Daylight Time in the U.S. Although standard time in time zones was instituted in the U.S. and Canada by the railroads in 1883, it was not established in U.S. law until the Act of March 19, 1918, sometimes called the Standard Time Act. The act also established daylight saving time, a contentious idea then. Daylight saving time was repealed in 1919, but standard time in time zones remained in law. Daylight time became a local matter. It was re-established nationally early in World War II, and was continuously observed from 9 February 1942 to 30 September 1945. After the war its use varied among states and localities. The Uniform Time Act of 1966 provided standardization in the dates of beginning and end of daylight time in the U.S. but allowed for local exemptions from its observance. The act provided that daylight time begin on the last Sunday in April and end on the last Sunday in October, with the changeover to occur at 2 a.m. local time. During the "energy crisis" years, Congress enacted earlier starting dates for daylight time. In 1974, daylight time began on 6 January and in 1975 it began on 23 February. After those two years the starting date reverted back to the last Sunday in April. In 1986, a law was passed that shifted the starting date of daylight time to the first Sunday in April, beginning in 1987. The ending date of daylight time was not subject to such changes, and remained the last Sunday in October. The Energy Policy Act of 2005 changed both the starting and ending dates. Beginning in 2007, daylight time started on the second Sunday in March and ends on the first Sunday in November.




### A FAMILY TREE WITH DEEP ROOTS

Shute was then joined by his sons, Mark, Neil and Scott. Howard Shute retired at nearly 80 years of age while his sons continued the family tradition of providing safe and pure water

Today, Shute's Water Systems is run by Scott Shute and Matt Farkas, and Shute's Excavation is run by Todd Shute. Scott's wife Becky runs the office with Mark Shute's daughter Jill. The family attributes the majority of its continued success from recommendations it receives from satisfied customers.

Shute said many municipal water systems contain calcium and magnesium, which as "hard" substances, form scale and create problems in water heaters, dish washers and plumbing systems.

### **CHANGES TO TRUXTON SENIOR CENTER**

FTER JUST OVER A YEAR of programming one local senior Acenter is still working out what is working and what services need to be re addressed.

The town of Truxton opened their senior center at the United Methodist Church last fall with the assistance of the LASS grant through the Cortland County area agency on aging. The grant allowed for the center to open its doors once again with a renewed spirit and ambition from community members. The grant regulates the center will be open 6 hours a week and certain programming should be included.

Program director, Jill Kraft got started a day a week last fall and quickly the community came out in support. Kraft says the winter months, like many of the centers, saw a small decline in participation. Throughout the spring and summer, the center continued with their biweekly fitness program, a new line dancing program, and monthly art and crafts. Adding also she plans on changing the name to better reflect that it is more of a senior club, not a senior center. "I think

people may be more interested to know that the center is a funlighthearted way to visit with friends and enjoy themselves."

The center currently called the Truxton Living Well Senior Center will know be called the Truxton Living Well Activity Club. Kraft says over the summer the hours were changed to try to service the community two days a week, but the plan did not pan out as anticipated. Starting November 1st, the club will be open Tuesdays 12-6 pm. The center will be open all afternoon (12-4) for coffee and cookies, card and game playing and general socialization. Beginning at 4pm Tuesdays there will be fitness, art, line dancing and other scheduled monthly run programs followed by dinner at 5pm. Anyone in Cortland County is invited to attend and there is a free will donation of \$5 for dinner. If anyone has questions, feedback, or concerns Jill can be contacted at 607-244-1445.

THE HISTORY CENTER IN TOMPKINS County announces f L their next major exhibit 'Knot Sew Fast: Patchwork of Tompkins County', to open on February 3rd 2023 at their Exhibit Hall on the Ithaca Commons. Knot Sew Fast pulls from the extensive textile and fabric arts collections held by The History Center to lay out the stories these functional artworks tell about Tompkins County history.

Piecing together the story of quilts encourages us to consider shifts in technology, industry, transportation, and materials over generations of local life. As we unravel (figuratively) each quilt we consider the hands that did the work, and the stories they captured in every knot and stitch. In addition to historic quilts displayed from four of the nine townships of Tompkins, there will be interactive patternmaking stations in the Exhibit Hall; an invitation for our modern audience to try their hand at replicating patterns from ancestral woven Haudenosaunee belts to modern-day art quilts.

Quilts are a unique measure to explore history as the practice of quilting was a skill developed and practiced equally by historic Ithacan city-dwellers, as well as our rural township communities of Trumansburg, Groton, Dryden, Lansing, Caroline, Newfield, and Danby. The merging of this functional skill, and the hundreds of hours and handwork displayed in each quilt shares narratives about community, history, home, and skilled labor.
