



CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

AST TIME WE ASKED YOU if you knew the name of a Cortland County transplant who developed textbooks for beginning readers. Did you happen to guess? Charles W. Sanders is the answer.

Sanders was born in Newport, NY on March 24, 1805, his family moved to Homer when he was nine. Here he attended the Cortland Academy. He was finished his education by the age of 14, and he became a licensed teacher at 16.

This seemingly ordinary young man would go on to become quite important in the development of the education system.

Sanders would spend 17 years teaching at schools in Cortland County. At 24, he was elected to be an inspector of schools. During his years of teaching, Sanders found it difficult to teach young children to read with the materials he had, which included Webster's Dictionary and readers which were designed for older students. He set about designing simple spellers and readers which emphasized pronunciation and included illustrations and uncomplicated stories more appropriate for beginning readers.

Sanders and his brother visited log schoolhouses all over New York and even into the wilds of Ohio by horse and on foot. They would introduce themselves and visit with both the teacher and the students. Sanders would read a story from his book, and upon his departure, he would present of copy of the book and from there, the orders would roll in. He sold over 13,000,000 books in his lifetime. His works included 42 titles and his series included chemistry, mathematics, and elocution as well as readers and spellers for all age groups. Sanders included songs in his earliest books and shares credit with William B. Bradbury for introducing singing into public schools. His work on educational books made his fortune and he collected \$30,000 a year in royalties.

If you are buying fish during the winter, be sure it's your last stop on your way home. If you are purchasing tropical fish that like it warm, it's important to get them home into your tank as soon as possible. If they get chilled, they could get sick. Goldfish like it cold and are less likely to get sick in the cold. However, you should still get them home as soon as you can. Don't let the cold stop you from buying tropical fish. As long as you go right home and be sure the car is warm, they should be fine. When you do get home, only float the bag of fish for 4 or 5 minutes, it doesn't take long for the water in the bag to adjust, floating too long can injure your fish. The fish farms say the quicker they get into the tank, the better. Another important tip is, do not put the bag of fish next to your car's heater vent, that will cause the bag of water to heat up too quickly. Bottom line is you can buy fish during the winter, just get them home quickly and safely into your tank. Tropical fish like temps in the 78 to 80 degrees range. Be sure to feed fish 3 times a day.






