



Dogs must be leased or in carriers, cats and ferrets must be in carriers. Donations accepted.

TEW YORK STATE REQUIRES ALL cats, dogs, and ferrets to have their first rabies vaccination between 3 and 4 months of age. Since this is required by law, we hold rabies clinics throughout the year to ensure you are able to keep your pets protected. Ferrets must be vaccinated yearly after the initial vaccine. Cats may receive either a 1-year or 3-year vaccine after the initial vaccine depending on the type of rabies vaccine given and whether proof of previous vaccination is available. We currently use a vaccine that is effective for three years after the initial 1-year vaccination. Dogs receive a 3-year vaccine after the initial vaccine. Rabies vaccines are licensed for either 1 or 3 years. This means that your pet is considered up to date for the amount of time the vaccine is licensed as long as there is proof of prior vaccination. If a 3-year vaccine

is given to a pet with no proof of previous vaccination, then the vaccine is only considered effective for 1 year. People often bring their pets to a rabies clinic and have forgotten their paperwork. The vaccine we use for cats and dogs is licensed for three years, so if you forget your paperwork the night of the clinic, your pet has still received a vaccine that is licensed for 3 years. 

CREATURE FEATURE BLUEBIRDS IN WINTER

PERHAPS YOU'VE SEEN ONE OR more bluebirds flitting about this winter and wondered why they didn't fly the coop for warmer climes. After all, many eastern bluebirds migrate in autumn from breeding grounds in the northern part of their range, winging it to the southeastern U.S. and sunny Mexico. Ornithologists confirm that while this migratory behavior is typical, some small flocks of bluebirds choose to stay behind each winter. You might also wonder what these beauties eat throughout the barren months of the year. During the winter, bluebirds mainly feed on fruits and berries clinging to native plant species like red cedar, dogwood, junipers, service and elderberries, sumac, hollies, and wild grape.

There are a few ways you can attract and support bluebirds year round. For example, plant native trees and shrubs that bear fruit, and provide fresh, clean water in a maintained bird bath throughout the winter—adding a feature to make the water trickle or spray is attractive to this species. Also,



avoid using pesticides and other chemicals on your lawn, as bluebirds feast on insects found at or near the ground during warmer months. Although some experts recommend removing nesting boxes in the fall, a snug cavity to spend cold nights is crucial to winter survival for bluebirds. You may discover they are roosting in your nesting boxes—if so, enjoy the wonderful opportunity to observe these colorful birds in the dead of winter.

TN THE LAST ISSUE OF the CAT, we asked you to answer this: ▲This man's musical career took him from playing trumpet at Cortland High School to selling out concerts all over the world. What was his name? If you answered Ronnie Padavona (aka Ronnie James Dio), you are correct!

Ronnie J. Padavona was raised in the city of Cortland and attended Cortland High School where his instrument of choice was trumpet. He was a talented musician. Ronnie was bitten by the rock-n-roll bug and formed his first band in high school, the Vegas Kings. From there, the band name and lineup changed some, and from 1958-1961, the band was called Ronnie and the Red Caps. They played dances, halls, and fraternity parties in several states and had quite a following.

Ronnie Padavona graduated from high school in 1960. He tried college but ultimately dedicated himself to music. In 1961, he changed his name to Ronnie Dio and the band became Ronnie and the Prophets. They flirted with celebrity in those days, working with the Angels on "My Boyfriend's Back." In 1967, the band's name changed to The Electric Elves and the lineup changed some as well. They were in a bad car accident in 1968 which killed lead guitarist Nicky Pantas and severely injured the other guys in the band. They regrouped and continued until 1972 when the band became known as Elf. Elf opened for Deep Purple, and in 1979, Ronnie Dio replaced Ozzy Osbourne as the lead singer of Black Sabbath. From there, he followed a path of heavy metal music, forging a highly successful career for himself.
