



CORTLAND FIRE DEPARTMENT

 ${f B}^{ ext{EFORE}}$ the official Cortland Fire Department was established in 1854, homeowners were responsible for ensuring the communities safety. In 1830 the "Randall Tub" , the department's first piece of fire apparatus, was purchased by the Randall family. The Cortland Fire Department was originally composed of firefighting companies. The Waterwitch Steamer and Hose Company #1 was officially formed through a merging of the Water Witch Fire Company and the Water Witch Hose Company. During this time, other firefighting companies formed including Orris Hose Company #2, Excelsior Hook and Ladder Company #3, Emerald Hose Company #4 and Hitchcock Hose Company #6. The various companies of the Cortland Fire Department were well represented at state and national fire competitions and also very successful in these competitions. Prior to 1914, the volunteer companies were located in various parts of the city. With a new Central Fire Station built in 1914 all the companies moved to 21 Court street, in the downtown area of the City. This also represented the change from horse drawn apparatus to motorized apparatus. This building is still in use today serving as the headquarters fire station where all the administrative offices and a majority of operations occur. Fire Headquarters is on the National Register of Historic Places. The City has received significant grant funding to maintain the beauty and ability to continue to use the building as a fire station nearly 110 years later.

While the members of the department cannot predict the outcome of every day, training has become a ritual to maintain and shield against danger. The department responds to over 3000 calls annually and is constantly honing skills and making ready all the apparatus and equipment. The mission of the department has changed from a "fire suppression" organization to an "all-hazards" response agency encompassing Emergency Medical response, Hazardous Materials, rope rescue, confined space and water rescue. The department is also responsible for Code Enforcement and fire safety inspections within the City. The department also provides a number of outreach programs relating to fire safety education, CPR and First Aid Training, fire extinguisher training and public relation events including Firefighter for a Day Camp, Chester the Covid Bunny and Here comes Santa. With 39 career firefighters and 25 volunteers, the Cortland Fire Department is committed and dedicated to the

The department provides an annual physical, training, equipment and a Length of Service retirement option to volunteer members. Pursuing a career as a firefighter is equally as rewarding. CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY **HISTORICAL SOCIETY**

AST TIME IN THE CAT, we asked if you knew when the hospital in Cortland was established.

Women from the county were largely responsible for raising the funds to establish a hospital, and our hospital owes its origin to the Loyal Circle of King's Daughters of Cortland, who donated \$1,300 in 1889 for this purpose. Additionally, the first board of managers of the County Hospital Association were all women: Mrs. James H. House, president; Mrs. F. O. Hyatt, vice-president; Mrs. Hugh Duffey, secretary, and Mrs. Jerome Squires, treasurer.

The hospital was opened in April of 1891 in a rented house at 33 Clayton Ave. It had accommodation for six patients. Fifteen patients were cared for the first year, with a total of 611 days of treatment. For a time, a woman performed the duties of matron, nurse, and housekeeper, and a boy cared for the stove and walks. There was no city water or telephone, and friends donated nearly all the furniture and bedding. The first patient was a Normal School student who suffered from

The hospital moved to its current location when the former Copeland house was available for purchase. Both William and Harriet Copeland died in 1900, and in 1908, a decision was made by the hospital to acquire the property to increase its capability to serve the community. The home was now owned by George H. Wiltsie, and the price was \$18,000 which was a huge sum for the struggling organization to come up with. Businessman Chester Wickwire felt strongly that the community needed to have a good hospital, and he donated \$70,000 towards the endeavor.

From here, the hospital grew increasingly larger to better serve the community, and today, it has become a part of the Guthrie Medical Center.



A FAMILY TREE WITH **DEEP ROOTS**

CHUTE'S WATER SYSTEMS AND SHUTE'S LaFayette Well Drilling has been a family-run business serving Central New York for more than 50 years, drilling wells, installing pumps and treating problem water.

Originally known as LaFayette Well Drilling, established in 1963 by Howard Shute, and brother-in-law, Warren Shetler, both the business and their reputation grew





over the years. Shute continued on with the business after Shetler decided to pursue other interests.

Shute was then joined by his sons, Mark, Neil and Scott. Howard Shute retired at nearly 80 years of age while his sons continued the family tradition of providing safe and pure water to the community.

Today, Shute's Water Systems is run by Scott Shute and Matt Farkas, and Shute's Excavation is run by Todd Shute. Scott's wife Becky runs the office with Mark Shute's daughter Jill. "Also, corrosion of iron and steel pipes from ferrous sulfide, or 'black water,' that can darken everyday tableware, discolor copper and brass utensils and alter the appearance and taste of cooked foods."

Additionally, Shute said, sulfur water can make washing clothes more difficult.

NORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION OF TOMPKINS County's Spring Garden Fair and Plant Sale will take place Friday, May 19, from 12 to 6 pm at the Ithaca Farmers Market. One of the Finger Lakes' most highly anticipated gardening events, the annual sale has been organized since 1982 by CCE Tompkins County. 


CREATURE FEATURE SAVING SEA LIFE WITH SCULPTURES

LONG A STRETCH OF THE Tuscan coast, an Italian fisherman ${f A}$ named Paolo Fanciulli is protecting the region's marine life by sinking marble statues in the sea. For over 40 years, Fanciulli has made a living fishing off the coast of Tuscany. In the late 1980s, he began observing signs of illegal trawling. The poachers were devastating the ecosystem as well as Fanciulli's livelihood as they carelessly dragged heavily weighted nets that ripped away plant and marine life. The trawlers were rewarded with burgeoning catches while simultaneously stripping the sea bed

To deter the illegal activity, Fanciulli began sinking enormous stone sculptures along the seabed to prevent the nets from scraping the bottom. While other authorities have used sunken structures in various coastal areas to revive flagging marine populations, Casa dei Pesci, or "House of Fish," is Fanciulli's own labor of love. His efforts are paying off, as illegal trawling has ceased in the area, fish numbers are increasing, and more marine life is returning to the waters including lobsters and sea turtles

While protecting sea life, the 39 different fifteen-ton marble statues carved by talented sculptors create a fantastical underwater park reminiscent of an ancient, submerged city. Another dozen are currently being sculpted, and Fanciulli also plans to include large replicas of Roman urns in the House of






