TULLY FIRE DEPARTMENT

'N THE HEART OF VILLAGE of Tully, the fire department was incorporated by New York State in 1895, however, their services were operational beforehand with the help of Tully Hose Company

There is a board of fire commissioners that serves the Tully Joint Fire District. Each member is chosen by the village and town board, only serving for a term of five years. These members coincide with the Tully Ambulance District that are appointed every three years by the Town Board. These board members are also responsible for the finances of the community and oversee the training of its firefighters and emergency management of public safety.

There are two official buildings but the main one is located on Railroad Street. Not only do these dedicated workers serve the community twenty-four seven but are available to provide a variety of services. Averaging ten to fifteen calls a month for fire-rescue related issues, seventy-five percent majority of the emergencies arise from medical crises. Both the ambulance and fire providers are located in the same building but are separate solutions. In addition, Tully Fire Department assists with motor vehicle collisions, search and rescue, flood management, and even individuals stuck in an elevator just to name a few. This is a direct representation of the unwavering commitment these firefighters have to protect and serve Tully for their countless hours of training .

Notably, all personnel are CPR and First Aid certified. CPR training is also offered to the community that includes lifeguards at Green Lake. Open to the public is a semi-annual tour for people of the community who are interested in learning more about Fire and EMS Services. Equally important are fundraisers they host to support Scholarships for girls and boys of the Senior Class to further their education in Fire Science or a Nursing Field with a "Fill the Boot" drive. Towards the winter season, a tree lighting ceremony fund raising event is held to help people offset their holiday season purchases. Santa and

Mrs Clause are also in attendance to receive letters from children requesting wanted gifts for Christmas. The Tully Fire Department is driven, dutiful, and loyal to the Tully community. For questions and concerns, their number is (315) 696-6414.





CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

AST TIME WE ASKED IF you knew the name of a radical school in McGraw. The New York Central College was founded by anti-slavery Baptists in McGraw and chartered in 1848. The cornerstone was laid on July 4, 1848, and it opened its doors in September of 1849. It was the first college in the United States that accepted all students who were qualified to attend and did not restrict access to education based on gender or skin color. This also applied to teachers; Charles L. Reason was the first African American faculty member to teach at a college in the United States. At that time, it was unheard of for a black professor to instruct white students. Females both taught and attended classes, and this was significant at a time when most females received little formal education.

Unfortunately, the New York Central College was only open from 1849 to 1861. There is much research that has been done on this topic, and if you would like to learn more, we invite you to stop by the Cortland County Historical Society. It's a fascinating chapter of Cortland County history that intersects with important national history.

CREATURE FEATURE NOCTURNAL ANIMALS

TE KNOW THAT MANY CREATURES in the Animal Kingdom are nocturnal and that this evolutionary adaptation has numerous advantages, but we can't say with certainty why the trait arose; and while there are some solid theories that may explain why certain animals are active at night, it's likely these behaviors evolved slowly over time in response to a combination


The majority of nocturnal species are mammals, birds, and insects. A leading theory as to why certain animals are nocturnal states that the trait evolved to help avoid being eaten by dinosaurs and other apex predators that prowled the days back in a time when mammals and birds began expanding as groups.

Another theory reasons that nocturnal species can better avoid being detected under the cover of darkness. Although many nocturnal creatures boast heightened senses, it's still easier to remain undetected at night. Darkness enables both hunters and hunted to move around with added secrecy-predators often employ ambush tactics, while prey animals use the cover of night to forage more safely. Since predators have greater success if they hunt when their prey is active, scientists further speculate that they may have evolved to mirror their prey's habits, such as barred owls hunting flying squirrels.

Additional theories reason how some animals developed

nocturnal behaviors to reduce conflict over resources during the day, and that certain desert and tropical dwelling species can avoid scorching heat and conserve hydration by reserving activity for after dark when it's cooler.
