

CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

 Γ N THE LAST ISSUE OF the CAT, we asked if you knew the lacksquare name of Cortland's sister city in Pakistan. The name of the city is Peshawar, and the relationship between the two cities developed through the initial efforts of college students.

In 1953, the Delta Kappa fraternity chapter at the Cortland State Teachers College (SUNY Cortland) invited Pakistani Ambassador Mohammed Ali to be the principal speaker at their pledge dinner. He accepted, and a sister city relationship developed between the cities of Cortland and Peshawar. One of the scheduled activities was an exchange of mayors for the two cities.

President Dwight D. Eisenhower was interested in fostering relationships between nations by bringing those relationships to an individual and community level. In 1956, Eisenhower established two programs which adhered to the idea of forging understanding between countries at an individual level. These programs were Sister Cities International and People to People; the first is still in existence today, but the latter has disbanded.

It seems that Cortland was ahead of the curve by beginning their sister city three years before the Sister Cities International program was founded. The sister city relationship with Peshawar continued until at least into the 1960s.



RICHFORD FIRE DEPARTMENT

During the 1940's the Richford Fire Department was established. It is currently located at PO Box 70 Bowery Lane. The fire station is volunteer-based with the mission of protecting and serving the Richford locals.

Any emergencies car-related are responded to as well as any "man down" calls. There are different types of fire such as wildfire, interior, and exterior that these firefighters extinguish. There have been times when they've put out brush or wildland fires, as well as, structural and vehicle fires.

For Emergency Medical Services response the Richford Fire Department is contracted through the state of Maine. Basic Life Service is provided until another EMS arrives. CPR and first aid are typically supplied if a person is not breathing or unconscious.

All guidelines are determined through the National Fire Protection Agency(NFPA), including volunteer and paid firefighters. In addition, the Richford Fire Station holds public CPR classes that could potentially save a life. For anyone interested in assisting on any level of fire service, there is local training that can be arranged through the Fire Police, Exterior and Interior Fire Fighting.

A FAMILY TREE WITH DEEP ROOTS— **CELEBRATING 60 YEARS**







CREATURE FEATURE "FALLING" FOR BASS

OR MANY ANGLERS, BASS ARE a favorite fish to target during the summer, but the fun doesn't need to end in fall when bass put on the pre-winter feedbag. Based on the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) fishing regulations, the regular season for Largemouth and Smallmouth Bass wraps up on November 30th. From December 1st through June 14th, bass anglers must practice strict catch and release using only artificial lures.

New to bass fishing? To discern one bass species from the other, use these three basic identification tips. Firstly, look at the jaw. In Largemouth Bass, the jaw extends past the eye, whereas in Smallmouth, it ends at the eye. Next, check out the markings: Largemouth have a dark-colored horizontal band running along their body [see photo], while Smallmouth typically have numerous vertical bars. Lastly, compare the 2-segmented dorsal fin (located on the fish's back) which is more deeply notched on the Largemouth than on the

Bass fishing can be challenging in the fall, especially after the lakes turn over. Downsizing lures is one tip shared by the pros, as well as slowing down your presentation. Some good lure choices for fall include smaller spinnerbaits, square-billed or lipless crankbaits, plastic minnows and jigs. As always, please fish with lead-free tackle to prevent fatally poisoning aquatic birds and other wildlife. Safe and clean natural resources are well worth the extra cost for lead-free alternatives.




