



CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

N THE LAST ISSUE OF the CAT, we asked if you knew why the NY Giants came to Truxton to play baseball in 1938—read on to learn the answer!

One of Cortland County's famous sons came from the town of Truxton. John J. McGraw was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1937. He was born in 1873 and had a rough life growing up. As a child, he lost his mother (she had complications after childbirth) and several siblings to diphtheria in the span of a few weeks. He was a rugged individual who beat the odds to become major league baseball player, and he ultimately became the manager for the NY Giants. With McGraw as their manager, the Giants won three

The NY Giants came to town to play against the Truxton Giants to raise the money to place a monument to Truxton's famous son in the center of town. The game was on August 8, 1938, and the crowd numbered over 7,000! (Note: the combined population of Truxton, Homer, Cuyler, Scott, and Preble in 1940 was 7,213 so that was a huge crowd for the John J. McGraw Field in Truxton!) With excitement in the air, the game ended with a victory for the NY Giants, and the money was successfully raised to build the monument to John J. McGraw which is there to this day.

MORAVIA FIRE DEPARTMENT

Established in 1873, the Moravia Fire Department was founded by the S.E. Day Hook and Ladder, and the Tuthill Hose and Fitts Hose Companies. It is a 100 percent volunteer organization that prides itself on the dedication of its members. Overall, the Moravia Fire Department services up to 4,000 locals of Moravia. In addition to their equipment, they also store a high-angle and collapse trailer for the Cayuga County Emergency Services.

As a fire department, they provide; interior and exterior fire rescue, and non-transporting basic life-saving services. Other services include; car accident rescue, flooding assistance like, basement pumping, and hazardous material cleanup. The Moravia Fire Department specializes in aiding with rope, ice, and trench rescue.

Every member is New York State-mandated Fire Certified. Interior Firefighters have to complete Interior Firefighting Operations (IFO) learning. To work on exterior fires, members have to complete Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations (BEFO). Then, every Thursday they conduct inhouse training with State Fire Instructors. It has been noted that a big part of their operations includes the importance of training and education. Open to the public, they reach out to the local elementary school and teach young kids about fire safety and prevention. Moravia Fire Department partnered with the Cayuga County Healthy Neighbors through the

program, Healthy Neighborhoods. The program ensures safer homes in the community and Locke by visiting houses and giving out safety products. For more fire preventative information it is listed on their website at moraviafire.com/fire-prevention.

Another way the Moravia Fire Department has community involvement is through the events and programs they hold. For example, in July, there are the Firemen's Field days, and on Labor Day Weekend, they assist with the nearby car show. Every so often, the firefighters will host a chicken barbecue. A major program they have is called the Moravia Money Mania held annually. During this event, people can buy raffle tickets to win monetary prizes. It has been a tradition for over 20 years and continues to sell out. These dedicated members not only want to keep people safe but also work hard to have a lasting impact and relationship with the community. THE 1890 HOUSE MUSEUM

THE 1890 HOUSE MUSEUM IN Cortland aims to promote and $oldsymbol{\mathsf{L}}$ interpret the historical and cultural significance of the property to the public. The museum seeks to collect, preserve, research, display, and interpret objects that promote local and national history of America's cultural heritage during the late 19th to early 20th centuries.

The house originally belonged to local entrepreneur and inventor Chester F. Wickwire, who created a worldwide wire industry based in Cortland that changed the face of rural life. Through tours at the museum, visitors can experience the world of the Wickwire family, as well as the daily lives of the servants and factory workers who sustained their lavish

Marian Wickwire O'Connor was the last Wickwire to reside at 37 Tompkins Street, and she died there in 1973. Shortly afterward, the residence and its contents were sold at auction. Cortland County leaders, including members of the Wickwire family, successfully campaigned to preserve the house, and it became The 1890 House Museum in 1975.

NEW FOR 2024 & NOT TO BE IGNORED: BENEFICIAL OWNER INFORMATION REPORT

DOYOU OWN OR MANAGE a small LLC or corporation? You will likely have to file a Beneficial Ownership Information (BOI) report with the U.S. Treasury Department's Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FINCEN) by the end of 2024. If you neglect this filing, the penalty is \$500 per day for late filing up to a maximum \$10,000 fine and possible imprisonment if you willfully disregard filing this report.

In 2021 Congress passed the Corporate Transparency Act (CTA) requiring the BOI report that was designed to make it harder for bad actors to benefit from money laundering and other financial crimes by hiding behind these entities. This reporting requirement went into effect on January 1, 2024.

Who is required to file? Most small businesses organized as a LLC or corporation with less than 21 full-time employees and

less than \$5 million of sales or gross receipts are required to file the BOI report. Who is not required to file the BOI report? There are 23 exemptions to filing, but mostly tax-exempt entities, inactive entities and large companies. This also means that if your small business was created by only filing a Doing Business As (DBA) with your county, then you are not considered a reporting entity.

If you create a new LLC or corporation in 2024, you have 90 days to file this report. Once you file your first BOI report, if you have any changes, such as an address change or a renewed driver's license, you will need to file an updated report within 30 days. The penalties are in force if the updated report is late.



The Financial Crimes Enforcement Network has a webpage on all the requirements for this BOI report. It can be accessed at www.fincen.gov/boi. There is a brochure and a Small Business Compliance Guide (57 pages) you can download. The U.S. Treasury Department expects most owners and managers of reporting companies to file this report on their

While no one looks forward to the time and effort in having to file this report, one can see the penalties for ignoring to do so. If you own or manage an LLC or corporation, or multiple LLCs and corporations, if you have not already filed your first BOI reports, make sure to speak with your accountant or attorney this tax season about a timeline in completing the filing of this report for each one of your entities that is required to file.

CREATURE FEATURE WEATHERING THE WINTER

Tot all animals hibernate through winter or escape by

migrating south. Instead, they enter the season with no guarantee of survival, enduring months of freezing rain, biting winds, deep snow, and bone-chilling cold. Some creatures. like beavers, build shelters to shield them from the worst weather, while others must take advantage of what Mother Nature provides in their surroundings.

When they're not hunting, foxes spend time curled up in places offering protection from the elements: under brush piles and shrubs, or in dense thickets. They rely on plush fur to stay warm and will wrap their bushy tail over their face like a cozy scarf. In extreme weather, foxes might dig a shelter or take refuge in an abandoned den excavated by another animal.

In winter, ruffed grouse grow specialized bristly scales on their feet that act as snowshoes and shift to residency in more mature forests. When snow cover is scarce or the ground is icy, they'll roost among densely needled conifers. Grouse will also plunge headfirst into deep, fluffy snow to stay snug and conserve energy, because there, in the subnivean zone, temperatures stay much warmer than the air.

Bobcats often utilize numerous shelters over the winter consisting of one main den and several supporting nooks. The main den is typically a cave or other rocky shelter, inside a hollow log, or under a fallen tree. Secondary refuges fall within less traveled areas of the home range and include brush piles, stumps, and rock ledges. When snow starts to pile up, bobcats must endure confined stretches in their shelters waiting out the worst conditions, since they can't afford to waste energy moving through deep powder.

Fishers have very thick fur which helps keep them cozy as they travel over many miles of frozen landscape in search of prey and suitable cover. They, too, find refuge from extreme conditions inside hollow trees and logs, rock crevices, or within dens dug by other animals.

One has to admire these cold weather warriors and their ability to survive a north country winter!
