

BLOOMIN' FACTS BY JACKIE

SPRING IS A WONDERFUL TIME of year. We begin to hear the Birds chirping. Daffodils and tulips start popping out of the ground. The grass changes to a shade of green. And bursting buds on many trees and shrubs begin to show the promise of a new season of color.

Gardeners know it's spring when it becomes apparent that the gardens and the lawns have had little maintenance over the winter. And a SPRING CLEANUP is definitely on the To-Do list!

Spring cleanup suggestions:

- 1. Pick up any debris that has collected over the winter. Trash from neighboring disposal containers. The lost glove. Leaves that have blown back into the gardens.
- 2. The first chance you get, take a few minutes to walk through any planting beds, tree beds. Look for plants that may need attention. A perennial that has heaved out of the ground. Broken branches on a tree. Chewing by mice or rabbits and even deer browsing.
- 3. Pluck as many weeds that have established themselves over the winter as possible. This can

be done with a herbicide application or the old-fashioned way of pulling or digging.

- 4. Now is a great time to prune. Do some of the plants look overgrown? Maybe they are too tall and beginning to hamper your view. Any plants growing so close to the house restricting air movement and even scraping on your siding? Is any plant growing so wide that it is encroaching on another plant's space? Do any of the plants have branches that are crossing and literally rubbing a sore on both branches? Some plants may have what we call "straight-ups"....ie smaller branches either growing "straight up" from the base of the plant or a new shoot on a branch but headed for the stars! All of the above are signs to PRUNE!
- 5. Some plants like Magnolia and Rhododendron have already set their buds for the season. It's best to prune these as little as possible, being careful not to take away from this year's floral outburst.
- 6. Get out any leaves that blew back into the gardens late fall early winter. Cut back or pull out any dried perennial foliage remaining from last season. If you have pansies still growing from last year, they should pop back into color soon. Let's leave them! However, other annuals that provided you so much color last season will not come back and now is the time to discard their remains.
- 7. If you deer protected some plants with burlap, those can be uncovered as soon as possible to help get light and circulation to the plant. Remember the deer are still looking for food anywhere. If you uncover too early, your plants could be their next midnight snack!
- 8. Wait until you see some new growth before starting to fertilize.

CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Do YOU KNOW FOR WHOM Tinelli's Hathaway House was built? This is the question we asked you in the last issue of the CAT—how did you do? It was built for early Cortland County settler Samuel Gilbert Hatheway. Hatheway was born in Freetown, Massachusetts and came to this part of the state soon after the Military Tract was opened, moving to Cincinnatus in 1805. Hatheway owned thousands of acress of land and was quite influential in Cortland County. He was active in politics and served as a member of the New York State Assembly, a senator in the New York State Senate, and a congressman in the United States House of Representatives. Hatheway was a Major General in the New York Militia from 1823-1858, and he served as a justice of the peace in Solon for 48 years.

Major General Hatheway built his stone house in 1844 after a fire destroyed his existing home. The Hatheway Homestead was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1978.

CREATURE FEATURE ANGRY BIRDS

COMETIMES, WHEN A BIRD COLLIDES with one of our windows Dit's not by accident, especially during spring and early summer. Rather, the birds are attacking their own reflection which they think is an intruder in their territory. As much as I love our feathered friends, this behavior seems to support the term, "bird brain."

According to the avian experts at Audubon, robins and cardinals are especially notorious for attacking their reflections. I can vouch for this, because last spring there was a robin that repeatedly bonked one of our windows; and this year we had a cardinal picking fights in the same window. While this territorial behavior is not directly harmful, it does distract birds from other necessary behaviors such as feeding and nesting and also wastes precious energy. As well, the constant *thump-bump* noises are annoying for us to hear.

To deter birds from banging at your windows or car mirrors, you need to block or minimize the reflection. Installing screens helps, as does directing a bright light out the window. Temporarily soaping the window with bar soap works too, or you can simply apply window decals to the *outer surface* of the glass. For cars, hang a plastic bag or a hand towel over the side mirrors -- just don't forget to remove them before you drive off! Rest assured, this type of bird behavior is temporary and typically wanes in 3-4 weeks.

And what about my cranky cardinal? I drew an owl face on a paper plate and taped it to the window. So far, it's working to stop the feathered fisticuffs!

is a skilled mason who retired from his 40 year career doing brick, block, concrete and stone work.

Twenty two beautiful hand laid cobblestone or brick cooking fireplaces, some with warming ovens, were built in the park back in 1950. Through the years they had deteriorated to the point where 9 of them were unusable and the rest were in extremely poor condition. Harry made it his mission to rebuild them all at no cost to the county taxpayers. Dwyer Park is county owned. It has been a daunting task consisting of hard labor, honed skills, imagination, devotion and perseverance.

Each fireplace is unique with no two being the same. Harry has torn them down one by one and has reconstructed them using as much of the original stones as possible and filling in with stones found by volunteers. He has all but two of them completed and will work on those this season along with the brick base of the flagpole. He has also repaired all the laid stone bases to the park lights.

One can find Harry at the park most mornings working his magic. People love to stop and talk with him, bring him a cup of coffee or a cold drink and marvel at his skill. While keeping them close to original he has replaced all with new flues and added firebrick, to the interior cooking areas, bluestone on the top sides and small patio stones in the front.





Q & A WITH THE 1812 SHOPPE **CUSTOM WOODWORKS**

RAIG VOLLMER IS A CRAFTSMAN and the owner of The 1812 Shoppe located in Marathon, NY, who recently relocated his business to Cortland County.

Q: What does 1812 stand for?

A: The War of 1812. My dad started The 1812 Shoppe in 1970 in Sackets Harbor NY, where a historic fort from the war is located. He refinished, repaired, and reupholstered furniture, but always dreamed of building furniture. That dream went unfilled before his untimely death. I kept the name to honor his legacy, while creating my own.

Q: How long have you been a woodworker?

A: About 30 years, but if you count the early years tinkering as a kid it's more like 45.

Q: Did you go to school for woodworking?

A: I am mostly self-taught, learning a lot from my dad and from wood shop class in high school. When my real passion started, I feverishly read every magazine or book I could find



and watched every show on television, learning from other experts and a lot of practice. I have since learned to develop my own designs and plans and now study more about historic styles, architecture, form, and composition to help inspire my designs.

Q: What kind of products do you make?

A: I make a wide range of products that includes bedroom furniture, dining tables, accent tables, shelving, cabinets, chests; home goods/decor like cutting boards, candle décor, clocks, wall art, lamps; and novelty items like Bluetooth speakers, memorial urns, keepsake boxes, and chess boards. I also take old salvaged, vintage, or odd items and repurpose or incorporate them into a unique wood product.

Q: What kind of wood do you use?

A: I mostly use domestic hardwood lumber-walnut, maple, cherry, oak, ash, butternut, elm, beech, birch, and hickory, including figured exotics in those species, but I can get softwoods like pine or imported species if a customer wants it for their project. Much of my lumber comes from sustainably harvested or salvaged logs and trees that I selected and had sawn to my specifications, that are dried for many years before use.

Q: How do you manage quality in your work?

A: Wood is a tricky medium. It has natural inherent flaws and is sensitive to moisture and temperature. I go to great lengths to minimize the chances of product or part failure. I select the right lumber, stabilize it, and meticulously mill it. I employ the most appropriate joinery and techniques and make sure my client understands the options and their pros and cons. I use a range of finishes to bring out the color, grain and character of the wood. My goal is for most of my products to last forever.

Q: Do you sell retail or just do custom work?

A: Both. I build custom pieces, but I also design and build my own products that I sell retail locally, at craft shows, over the internet from my website, and ship to customers.

Q: Will you build custom projects from pictures people present to you?

A: Yes and no. I get these requests frequently. Sometimes it helps the customer communicate their style preferences and what they are looking for. Some products are common, and I am glad to build them as is. But, if it is something that is clearly unique, I will not steal someone else's design and take credit for it – whether for my own products or for a custom piece. Instead, I will use it, or an element of it, for inspiration and work together with my customer to design a different version of it.

Shute's WATER SYSTEM AND WELL Drilling has been a familyoperated business since 1963, when Howard Shute and his brother-in-law, Warren Shetler, first opened the business. Originally named Lafayette Well Drilling, Howard Shute carried the business alongside his sons; Mark, Neil, and Scott, and its reputation for many years until Howard Shute officially retired at almost 80 years. Scott Shute and Matt Farkas continue the effort of providing safe and clean water. The office is run by Scott's wife, Becky, and Mark Shute's daughter, Jill. Satisfied customer recommendations and glowing reviews are attributed to Shute's Water Systems and Well Drilling's success.

Now serving the CNY's areas, including Syracuse, Baldwinsville, Cortland, Cazenovia, Chittenango, Canastota, Fayetteville, Auburn, Tully, Lafayette, Marcellus, Manilus, Camillus, and Skaneateles. 




