



CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

IN THE LAST ISSUE OF the CAT, we asked if you knew the name of a forgotten village in Cortland which also has a street named after it. If you have ever wondered where the name "Port Watson" came from, then you are on the right track. We have a street (and a bridge) that are called Port Watson, but there is certainly no port to be found. Would you believe that there actually was a bustling port on the Tioughnioga River, and the surrounding village was called Port Watson? It is an interesting story that begins around 1800, when we were a part of Onondaga County.

The village of Port Watson was a planned development which roughly covered the area from Port Watson Street to Kennedy Parkway. The area was divided into lots, and streets were laid out and named. By 1810 there were 25 houses and stores in Port Watson while there were 10-12 in the village of Cortland and 70 in Homer.

Positioned at the confluence of the east and west branches of the Tioughnioga River, Port Watson was full of promise. River navigation was the best way to transport goods over long distances, and the layout of the village was important to the success of the growing village. Docks and warehouses were built, and goods were brought in the winter via sleds and stored in warehouses until spring and better navigation weather. A sawmill was built in 1808, and a paper mill was built in 1820. A tannery was started in 1824, and a grand hotel was built which housed the post office.

The village flourished briefly, but the demise of Port Watson was slow and sure. As more dams were built further up the river, the flow was more and more restricted, and as such, river transportation was not as reliable as it had been. The opening of the Erie Canal in 1825, better roads, and the arrival of the railroad all contributed to the collapse of Port Watson. Eventually the village was absorbed into Cortland Village which became the City of Cortland in 1900.

MAIN STREET FARMS

L OCATED AT 3320 NY-215, IN Cortland, Main Street Farms began its operations in 2010. The Owner, Allen Gandelman, purchased the old Smith Gardens in Homer with plans to start a plant nursery and aquaponics farm. After pairing up with an old college roommate, Bobcat, they quickly expanded their business to the Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program in 2013 with only 12 families. Today, Main Street Farms has 20 workers plus farmers who work on 60 acres of land and feed up to 400 families through the CSA program.

In total, more than 40 vegetable crops are planted, as well as cannabis that is used to produce both CBD and THC products. All vegetables are sold at the farmer's market in Ithaca, Syracuse, and Binghamton. Most of the CBD products are available for sale at local retail stores and online at <u>headandheal.com</u>. The adult-use cannabis brands are Florist Farms, Blotter, and Tune. These brands are only available at legal NY dispensaries.

Being a first-generation group of farmers and friends means they are not a traditional farm but one built from the ground up. Their mission statement includes selling the best quality certified organic products. Regenerative farming is another significant goal, strongly pushing for biodiversity, water cycle improvement, and strengthening the resistance in the soil. However, Main Street Farms is most proud of the customer service they provide.

Equally, in the past, they have hosted farm tours to interested individuals. Anyone interested in joining Main Street Farms can buy a share through the CSA program to enjoy fresh veggies all season. 


CREATURE FEATURE DETERRING DEER


