CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

AST TIME, OUR QUESTION FOR you was, what year did the Wickwire Brothers factory close?

The business closed its doors in 1971 after a long and successful run. The business had its start when Chester Wickwire acquired a carpet loom as trade against a debt owed to him at his hardware store on Main Street in Cortland. Chester was an enterprising individual, and he adapted the carpet loom to weave wire screen which he was then able to sell beginning in 1873. He did not invent window screen, but he was able to make it quickly and his business expanded to include other wire products.

At the height of its success, the Wickwire Brothers factory manufactured a quarter of the world's wire cloth. The business helped build the city of Cortland through the employment of immigrant workers. After nearly one hundred years, the business was purchased by Mid-States Steel & Wire Company (1968) but there was an employee strike that same year. In 1969, several buildings within the facility were torn down to modernize the factory. It was announced on February 11, 1971, that the plant would close, and a fire raged through the factory in September of that year, bringing the story of Wickwire Brothers to a close.

The Wickwire family lived in this home from 1890-1973. Within these walls two young boys grew up and Fredrick the younger son then raised his own family here.

The 1890 House is renowned for its Belcher Mosaic Windows, its intricate parquet flooring (which has just been refurbished), and the fact that you can explore 4 floors and the turret while learning about the Wickwire family, life in Victorian times and beyond. The 1890 House also hosts paranormal tours and allows paranormal groups to book the House for their own investigations.

The 1890 House Museum and Carriage House is also a great place to host your family parties as well as small-medium events. New this year we have a new parlor space on the 3rd floor that may be used for book clubs, tarot readings, and even use for the healing arts. The space can be rented out on its own or as part of a rental of the downstairs

I bet you're wondering, "how can that be?" Well...I'll tell you.

But first...did you know that maple trees are the most abundant tree in Central NY. They tower majestically above, branches spread wide as if waiting for an embrace. You've seen their leaves transform every autumn as they turn from green to vibrant shades of red, orange, and yellow. They're

mesmerizing. I admire their beauty, but I equally admire their beauty within.

Their lumber is creamy white with various shades of brown heartwood and is used to make exquisite furniture and wood products. But the forest has a little-known secret. Something special happens when a maple tree dies or is cut and left in the woods. It rots. Now, that's not really that special, or surprising. What is special is what happens from the time it dies or was cut to when it truly rots. Decay fungi colonize the wood and begin the decay process. During the first stage of decay the wood becomes beautifully streaked and discolored. If


you salvage the tree or log at

the right time, saw it into lumber, and dry it, the decay process stops, capturing that beauty - we call it spalting. Timing is the trick. Sawn too soon, it's just stained and spoiled. Sawn too late, it's punky and unusable. But sawn at just the right time... well, see for yourself. The pictures show what spalted maple looks like. Isn't it fantastic?

Now you know... "rotten" wood can be beautiful.

A fellow craftsman once said "If we're going to cut a tree down, then make sure what we make out of it is the very best we can make out of it. Keep the spirit of the tree alive." Amen to that.







CREATURE FEATURE THE GOOD GUYS

ESPITE THEIR OFTEN CREEPY VIBE, we know that many insects are highly beneficial to the environment. Some "bugs" are also helpful to people. $\mbox{\bf Dragonflies}$ (and damselflies) are among the good

Sure, dragonflies can look intimidating, clouding the air in masses and zipping about erratically or hovering on loud, crackling wings. Truth be told, dragonflies are our friends. Consider this: each adult dragonfly eats thirty to hundreds of mosquitoes a day. They also hunt other pests like wasps, midges, and flies, which are caught—and often eaten-on the wing. Dragonflies rarely bite people; so when they hover around you, don't be alarmed. Instead, think of them as your personal body guards, protecting you from blood-thirsty mosquitoes and other nasties that DO bite or sting.

Dragonfly larvae, called nymphs, live in the water before they take to the skies as adults. Each nymph has six jointed legs, prominent eyes, and a large, modified lower jaw that can be extended using hydrostatic pressure to capture unsuspecting prey. In other words, they look sci-fi caliber freaky (they also breathe through their butts, but I digress)! Bizarre appearances aside, these young dragonflies-to-be are also beneficial to their ecosystem and pose no threat-unless you're a mosquito larva or other tiny aquatic organism!

Three cheers for dragonflies!
