

CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY **HISTORICAL SOCIETY**

T N THE LAST ISSUE OF the CAT, we asked if you knew when the ▲ Marine Midland Bank (now Tompkins Trust) was built. Did you know it was built in 1969? Previous to the modern structure you see today, there was an early house on that property which was removed to make way for Orchard Street and the building which would be known as the Calvert Block. The Calvert Block was built in 1873 and home to a variety of businesses over the years, including the Varsity, a popular

The modern looking Marine Midland Bank was built in the Brutalist design and a significant departure from surrounding buildings on Main Street. Brutalist architecture emerged after World War II for a variety of reasons, one of which was the massive reconstruction of Europe post war. Brutalist architecture was simple and modern in aesthetic and relied on concrete and geometric designs. It was a rejection of decorative architecture of the past, such as the Victorian penchant for embellishment.

ITHACA DIRT RIDERS 52ND ANNUAL SPRINT ENDURO SUNDAY, AUGUST 18, 2024

"N THE EARLY 1970'S, A small group of local off-road motorcycle enthusiasts came together to form the Ithaca Dirt Riders (IDR). It was their vision to provide some local trails and events for their club members and other to enjoy. A year later, the club chartered with the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA). With many of its member interested in the AMA sport of enduros, the club sanctioned its first event. This year is the 52nd anniversary of The Ithaca Dirt Riders Enduro! It will be held on Sunday, August 18 at 253 Andersen Hill Road, Berkshire, NY 13736 starting at 10:00 am. You can sign-up for the event from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm on Saturday, July 17, and on Sunday morning, from 7:30 am to 9:00 am. The sprint enduro consists of three "loops" through fields and woods. It is a great experience for riders with many technical challenges for them. Riders can ride as young as 12 years old, if they have a bike with at least a 19" front tire. There are NO spectator fees, but there is lots of chances to see your favorite rider during the event. A food truck will be on hand on Sunday and there is free primitive camping! With the help of many volunteers and supporters, the Ithaca Dirt Riders have not only been able to host this local event, but many AMA national events over the years. IDR not only promote the sport of offroad riding, but also help the local communities.

SO, WHAT IS A SPRINT ENDURO? Enduros are a crosscountry event, which not only requires speed and ability, but also endurance (hence "Enduro").

With a Sprint Enduro, the timekeeping element is not a factor. Fairly new to the enduro world in America, sprint enduros allow competitors to race against the clock on wide, fast-flowing trails and grass track. They ride a small number of special tests multiple times throughout the day, trying to improve their times each ride. There is a time limitation to complete the required test section or tests. The rider with the fastest time to complete the loops wins.

Have you ever run a harescrambles? You may want to try a sprint enduro! You will have more "time in the seat" and less traffic in the woods. Give it a try!

To get a better understanding on enduros, go to: americanmotorcyclist.com/getting-started-in-racing/ You will be amazed at how much the riders have to do (and remember!) as they ride the course. 

CREATURE FEATURE COMMON MERGANSER— MAMA MIA!

DID YOU KNOW THAT COMMON Mergansers sometimes wind up with extra babies that aren't their own? Perhaps you've observed this yourself as a nervous mother merganser swam along, leading a looooong line of adorable ducklings. One photographer captured an image of a single merganser with a burgeoning brood of 50 babies swimming along behind her! While this was an unusually big family even for mergansers, extra ducklings to the tune of 20 or so is not particularly uncommon

The reason for this is two-fold. Firstly, cavity nesting ducks like Common Mergansers often lay some eggs in the nests of other ducks in addition to their own nests. Scientists believe this is a sort of "reproductive insurance policy" that helps prevent losing an entire clutch to predation or some other threat. Secondly, since parent ducks can't distinguish which ducklings are theirs, they will adopt any youngsters that have gotten separated from their real mothers.

Common Mergansers are typically seen along the shorelines of lakes and rivers where they dive beneath the water to catch fish and aquatic invertebrates. The female has a grayish body and a rust-colored head with a jaunty crest... and she just might have a pile of ducklings swimming along behind her!
