

TIME WILL FALL BACK TO standard time again on Sunday, ▲ November 3 at 2am, when daylight saving time ends. History of Daylight Time in the U.S. Although standard time in time zones was instituted in the U.S. and Canada by the railroads in 1883, it was not established in U.S. law until the Act of March 19, 1918, sometimes called the Standard Time Act. The act also established daylight saving time, a contentious idea then. Daylight saving time was repealed in 1919, but standard time in time zones remained in law. Daylight time became a local matter. It was re-established nationally early in World War II, and was continuously observed from 9 February 1942 to 30 September 1945. After the war its use varied among states and localities. The Uniform Time Act of 1966 provided standardization in the dates of beginning and end of daylight time in the U.S. but allowed for local exemptions from its observance. The act provided that daylight time begin on the last Sunday in April and end on the last Sunday in October, with the changeover to occur at 2 a.m. local time. During the "energy crisis" years, Congress enacted earlier starting dates for daylight time. In 1974, daylight time began on 6 January and in 1975 it began on 23 February. After those two years the starting date reverted back to the last Sunday in April. In 1986, a law was passed that shifted the starting date of daylight time to the first Sunday in April, beginning in 1987. The ending date of daylight time was not subject to such changes, and remained the last Sunday in October. The Energy Policy Act of 2005 changed both the starting and ending dates. Beginning in 2007, daylight time started on the second Sunday in March and ends on the first Sunday in November.







CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

IN THE LAST ISSUE OF the CAT, we asked if you knew what country music artist had a weekly radio show on local station WKRT?

John F. Robarge, also known as Tex Roe, was a local country music legend who hosted a weekly radio show on WKRT for over twenty years. Music was his passion, and he started on that path when he formed his first band at fifteen. He married Leona Mae Baker, one of the Baker Sisters, after seeing her perform for the USO at the Marine Corps training center at Parris Island, South Carolina. Tex and Leona had five children and were married for fifty years.

Tex was not just a local music legend, his career included highlights like a thirteen-week stint on the Grand Ole Opry and a television show of his own out of Syracuse. Over the course of his long career, he shared the stage with country greats such as Loretta Lynn, Roy Clark, and Pee Wee King. Tex was inducted into the New York State Country Music Hall of Fame in 1981.

While his music was widely known, Tex Roe was a normal guy who was admired by many in the community. He was a US Marine Corps veteran who served in both WWII and the Korean War. He retired from Smith Corona after thirty years.

CREATURE FEATURE GOIN' LOONY THIS FALL

While we don't see A lot of common loons hanging around our region over the summer, chances to observe them are better in fall when these beautiful icons of the north are migrating to the Atlantic Ocean, where they'll spend the winter. As they travel southward, loons may stopover on our area lakes and ponds to rest and recharge.

According to the Loon Preservation Committee, the timing of fall migration can vary between individuals. Adults that remained "single" or had failed nests this past breeding season might leave the lakes for the ocean as early as late summer, since they don't have chicks to care for. Meanwhile, pairs that raised chicks may remain on their lakes into October. Loon pairs usually migrate separately and won't spend the winter together. Typically, one parent leaves for migration first; the remaining parent hangs around for another week or two, but eventually leaves their chick(s) behind. The good news is that by this time, youngsters are ready to fend for themselves, including catching their own food.

While scientists aren't sure how they do it, juvenile common loons are able to navigate their maiden journey in the fall. Incredible! It is crucial, however, that they leave their natal lake before it ices over, or else they can get stranded. Sometimes, young loons will congregate on lakes in social groups as they prepare to migrate to their wintering grounds. Juvenile loonies can be identified from adult birds by their scalloped plumage pattern and brown eyes.
